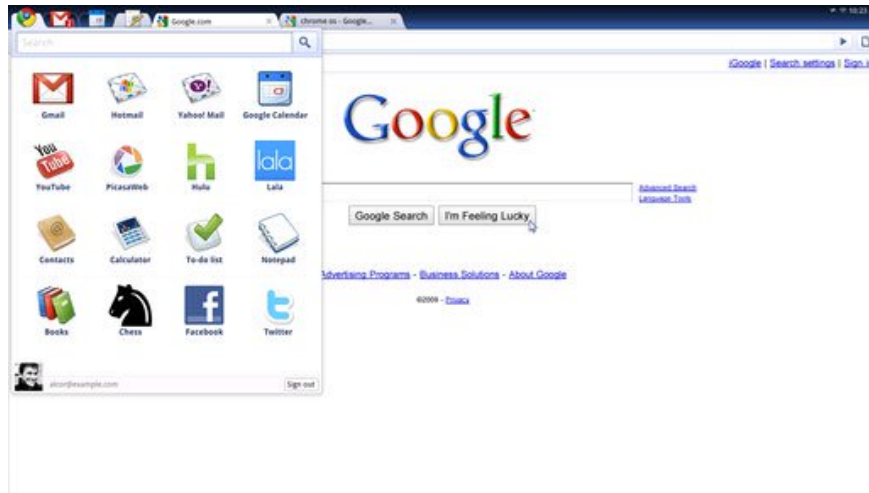


# Google extended the life of the Chrome OS device by 1 year
