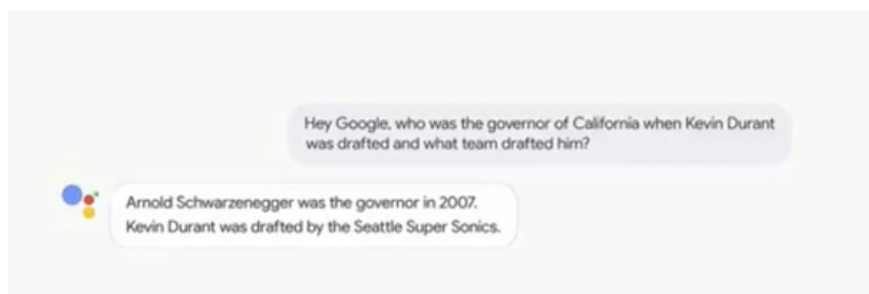


Google Photos turns black and white photos into color photos.

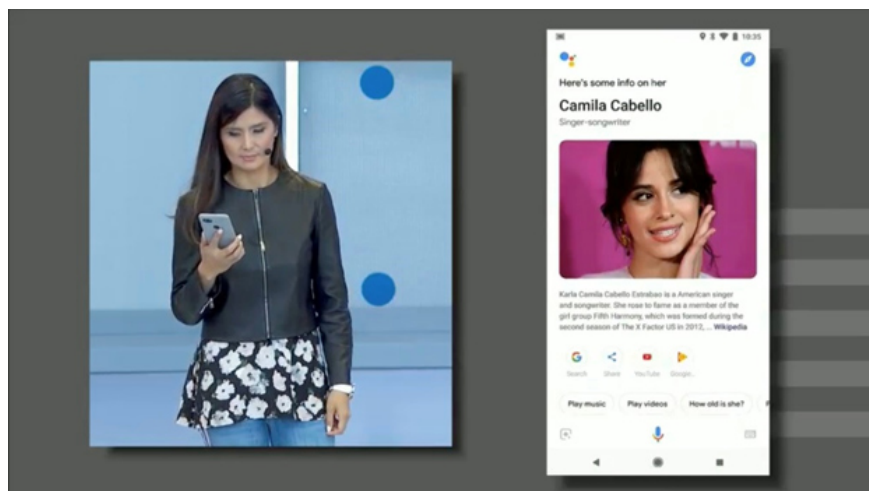


Google Assistant will be able to process multiple commands at once.

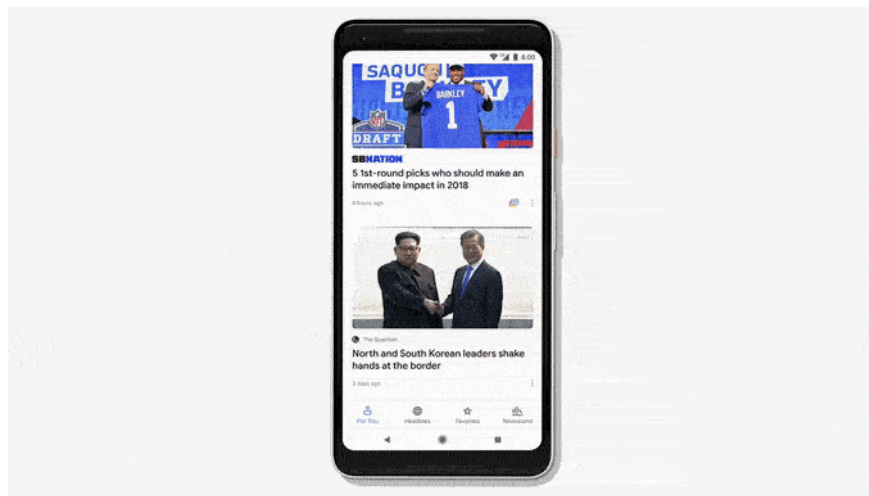
### **Google Duplex: molting for virtual assistants**

The outstanding features of Android P:

Adaptive Battery: helps identify the applications you frequently open and those that are rarely touched to limit background processes for these "inefficient" applications to save battery power.

Adaptive Brightness: provides a reasonable level of brightness for users depending on different circumstances.

App Action: predict actions based on user usage habits to help them get faster operations.

Slice: allows developers to use a small portion of their applications to display in different places.

How to navigate on Android P has been redone: To open the new application switch, users just need to swipe up on the small home button at the bottom, perform the operation to swipe up again to open the drawer application.

Android P brings some important changes focusing on personalization: users can know the exact history of using their phone and can limit the time on a certain app, such as surfing only. Facebook 2 hours a day.

With "Do not disturb" mode, all vibration and sound notifications will be stopped. To activate this mode, users simply place the phone facing the table. Important contacts will still be able to call when this mode is on.

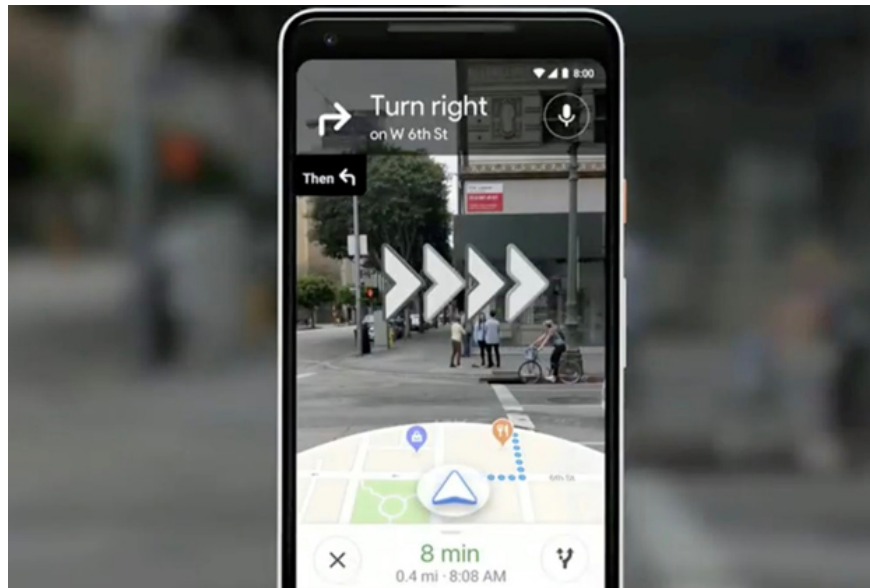
## **Google Maps**

In the next version of Google Maps, there will be a 'For You' tab, displaying locations on the road that you frequently travel. These suggestions are based on AI's analysis results through your personal habits and preferences.

If you have trouble selecting a restaurant with your group, Google Maps will provide a short list based on the review system combined with end-user preferences and habits. New features will be released on Maps this summer.

## **Upgrade Google Lens**

Google wants to turn Google Lens into a visual browser for users' world view by combining cameras with Google Maps Street View.



In addition, Google Lens will also have some new features such as recognizing text in photos by using optical character recognition technology, scanning clothes images to find similar models of clothes and accessories. Style Match feature.
