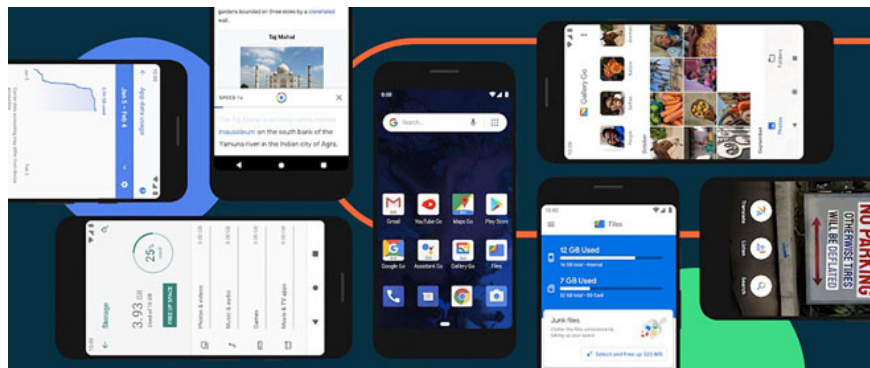


# Google launches Android 10 Go Edition, improving speed and increasing security for low-cost phones
