Places on Google Maps can pronounce themselves in the local language when the user presses the speaker button on the side.

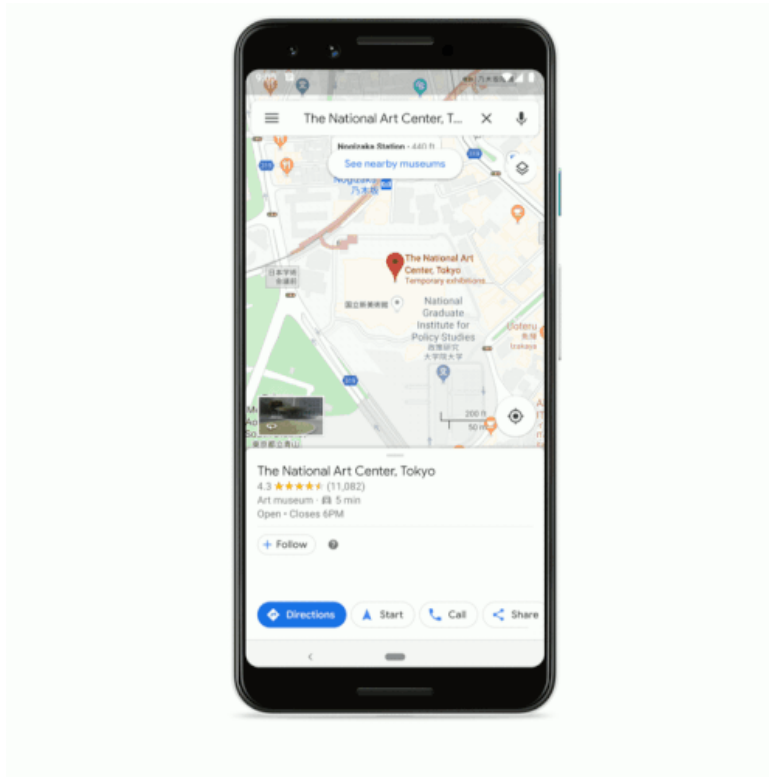
The new Google Maps has been added with a new translation feature that can pronounce itself in the local language and quickly switch to dialogue translation mode, which is very useful for users traveling abroad.
