Languages ??that Google is supporting include Armenian, Bengali, Georgian, Gujarati, Khmer, Latvian, Sinhala, Tamil and Urdu. In an effort to make the Internet world more comprehensive, Google also supports Swahili and Amharic, two of the most widely used languages ??in Africa.



Google has added new languages ??to Cloud Speech API, meaning they will soon be available on many other Google applications and services. In the meantime, you will have to install Gboard on Android and choose your language in the Settings section.
