

# Google pauses to deploy Chrome OS v75

Google has just announced a suspension of the deployment of this new ChromeOS update.

In line with the roadmap, Google recently started rolling out ChromeOS v75 for users. This new update is expected to bring a host of interesting new features, especially support for third-party cloud services.

But Mountain View has just announced a halt to deploying this new ChromeOS update. Under the plan, Google usually maintains a two-week period between new updates for Chrome and ChromeOS, which means that the company is already behind schedule with ChromeOS v75 version. And with the decision to postpone the implementation of this new update, users will continue to wait a while longer to experience the features that Google has been promoting aggressively on ChromeOS v75 version.

Up to now, the company has not made any official statements to confirm and justify this decision. However, posts on many reputable international technology forums have confirmed that the deployment halt originates from the stability issues of the new update. According to reports of users who have been "lucky" to receive updates during the first phase of development, this version of ChromeOS v75 controls their system from sudden freezing without losing every million The 'warning', along with the phenomenon of natural symbols disappear (sometimes), as well as some problems with internet connection.

As mentioned, since the Google side has not yet made any comment on the above issues, we cannot know exactly why they stopped implementing the update. Is there any other issue hidden behind or merely a pause to fix the error - something that Microsoft often applies to its Windows updates.

It is normal for new updates to crash (maybe even with serious security holes) after a short time of deployment and is a frequent problem. Therefore, we recommend that you wait a few days before installing a major update instead of installing it as soon as an update is available. If you are one of the unfortunate users having problems with ChromeOS v75, please uninstall this update and temporarily return to using the v74 version.
