Amit Sood added: ' A year ago, we decided to start this work by recording the images of street art works in Sao Paolo, then getting the attention of many Internet users and users '.

The street art gallery set up by Google is a great tool for art lovers, who regret that it was not born sooner to save many works before disappearing in many countries. Google has used many applications available to search for works like *Google Map, Google StreetView* , then send partners in the nearest location to access and record and then import into the library, in which there are many works at Big buildings were demolished, as the imprints in the building named Tower 13 in France were destroyed in April this year.
