A Portuguese application store *Aptoide* with more than 200,000 applications and 6 million users submitted to the European Commission a complaint about Google seeking to prevent users from accessing their app store.

Aptoide found that it could not create features similar to the Google Play Store to serve users due to Google restrictions due to clauses. Moreover, the company also said that Google has made it difficult for users of new operating system versions when they want to download applications from outside stores.

Aptoide said that starting with Android 4.0, only about 20% of users could find a way to set up and download external applications compared to 80% of users can find this way on Android 2.1 before. here.

Aptoide also complained about Google's restrictive policy that forced device manufacturers to install many of its applications on one device even though users only used a few of them. Finally, Aptoide alleges that Google's Chrome browser prevented users from searching Aptoide store apps for containing malware, although the company tried to contact Google about it and prove that their site does not have any kind of malware.

These allegations have further raised concerns that Android will one day become Google's proprietary operating system and it will no longer be open.
