

Great way to drive cars safely for women

Should or should not do anything while using cars for women. In this article, we will give you more information to increase your driving knowledge.

Not only is the playground reserved for men, women can also own their own cars and join the road. In particular, in today's modern society, the number of women driving cars is increasing. To help you have a safe driving knowledge, in this article we will introduce you some useful experiences that female drivers should have for themselves.

1. How to avoid being mistaken for "brake pedal and accelerator"?

1. Limit using high heels when driving cars

It's not too much to say that high-heeled shoes are the never-ending hobby of most women. However, if you are planning to drive a car, you should keep your heels high and replace them with flat shoes or soft-soled shoes. Wearing high heels will greatly hinder the operation of the accelerator and brake pedal, leading to dangerous situations. It won't be too difficult when you always put a pair of flat shoes in the car, and use them every time you drive a car.



This is also an interesting solution if you always want to be respectful when you step out of the car with high heels, but still ensure safety when participating in traffic. Of course, pedaling / braking with bare feet is not recommended to ensure the softness of the legs, as well as avoid the pain of moving for long periods of time.

2. Check the car carefully before moving

Checking gasoline before joining is something you always have to do first, especially for long-distance rides. Also, notice the indicator light on the central clock to see if there are any unusual signs. Normally, when the car is turned on the key, the electronic system will check all sensors (all indicator lights are on) before turning off all "safe" components.



If any strange lights appear, you should check the documentation or call the technical experts immediately (usually the tire pressure lamp, engine or brake light indicator). Note that safety factors such as lights, pressure tires, horns, brakes . should be periodically maintained as well as repaired immediately when problems occur.

3. Actions to take care of when getting on the car

After blocking the "companion" that can join the traffic, check your seat position.

The first thing you need to do is to adjust the seat so that it is at eye level and the steering wheel. A secret that experts tell you to lean your back close to the chair, put your hands up on the top of the steering wheel so that the palm touches and adjusts the other components (inside and out rearview mirrors, invisible position) steering wheel, seat positions .) in such a standard position.



Make sure the rearview mirror in the car only has your image without seeing any obstacles behind. Finally, never forget to buckle up, release your handbrake and gently touch the throttle.

4. Focus on the control process

When taking the traffic, put most of the time to observe the road and the types of vehicles moving around. Do not lose focus on other thoughts, or engage in debate with the person sitting next to you, but lose flexible reflexes along the way.



Another mistake women often encounter is eating when driving a car. Situations such as holding a food and driving a car, failing to brake when a bottle of water stuck under the brake pedal can cause unintended consequences.

When you put your foot on the brake and throttle on the automatic vehicle, always ride with only one right foot to get a fulcrum (left leg) and absolutely avoid the wrong footing - braking phenomenon is very dangerous. Some comments also suggested that the driver should fix the heel on the floor, only move the feet and nose to brake, gas and taper, avoid lifting the foot off the floor and pedal, easily losing control of the brake and gas .

5. Keep yourself and your driver safe

In the process of traveling on the road, women also need to note the absolute door lock (modern cars often have the function of locking the door when it reaches a certain speed). If there is a problem on the road and you need to get off, make sure you lock the door before you focus on other things.



It is not unusual for the villain to collide and when the owner opens the front door, a fellow will open the back door to retrieve or even blatantly rob it. Regardless of the situation, when someone knocks on a car window to ask for directions or ask for help when your car is slowing or stopping, always remember to look around to see if there is only one or more "suspicious" people.

Before getting off the bus, no matter how rushed you are, you should observe it later. Once you've made sure you don't happen to hit a pedestrian, open the door slowly, open the door for 5 seconds to make sure everyone knows you are about to step down, to avoid potential collisions.



Even when parked, always pay close attention to closing windows when getting off, like closing doors when leaving the house. For cars with sunroof, you need to make sure it is closed if you don't want "strange objects" or rain to get inside. In case you need to clear the glass to avoid heat, you should make sure the car is parked in a safe position, with caregivers to avoid bad mention of taking advantage of stolen furniture.
