Choose, print and cut the snowflakes you like from white paper. Then use glue or nail polish to scan the snowflake and quickly sprinkle the needle on it. Finally, attach the snowflakes to the folded cardboard and add a nice daisy.

With similar methods and different patterns of snowflakes you can create your own unique Christmas cards.

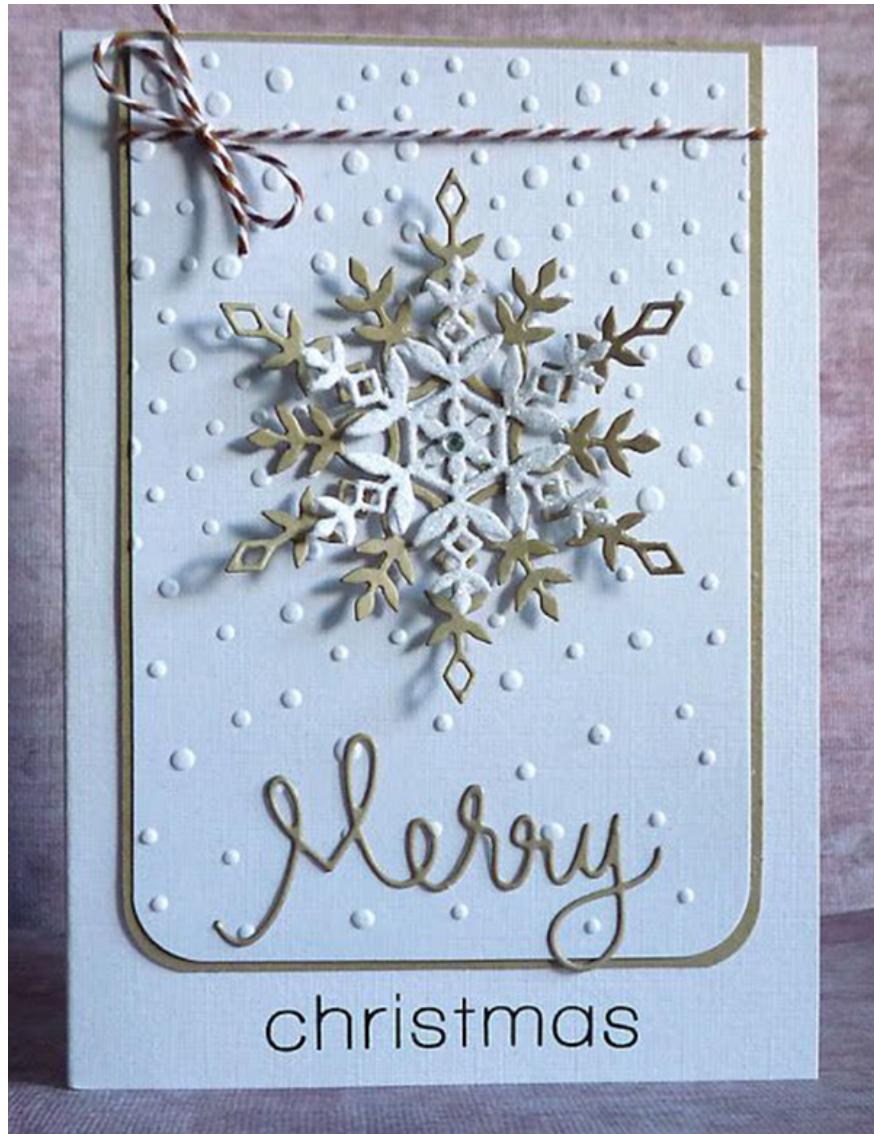

2. How to make Christmas tree pictures



Double the cardboard to get a basic card. You cut a piece of cardboard with contrasting colors and about half the size of an existing card and stuck it on the back of the card. Draw and cut a blue cardboard Christmas tree and paste it on the card. Finally, you tie a piece of ribbon around the card and you're done.



Cut and lay out colored paper sheets of different colors and sizes in a fan-folding fashion. Then, stack them on each other in the form of pine trees and decorate them according to your preferences. Simple but still beautiful?



You like to be unique, you can make 3D cards with your own creations. Surely the recipient will be very happy to receive your exclusive, 1-0-2 card. You can see how to make 3D Christmas tree cards here .



With this luxurious card template, you just need to use the curled white pieces of paper and put them together to create a white snow Christmas tree. A few more decorative motifs you have already completed this Christmas card template.



Choose a sample of laser cutting paper that is satisfactory and then paste it on the basic card that has been affixed with delicate pattern, you have a luxurious and delicate Christmas card.



Taking advantage of old newspapers, you can also create extremely lovely pine trees to attach to the basic cards.



Scraps of paper removed when cut and pasted in pine trees can help you get lovely cards.

3. How to make Christmas cards with specific icons



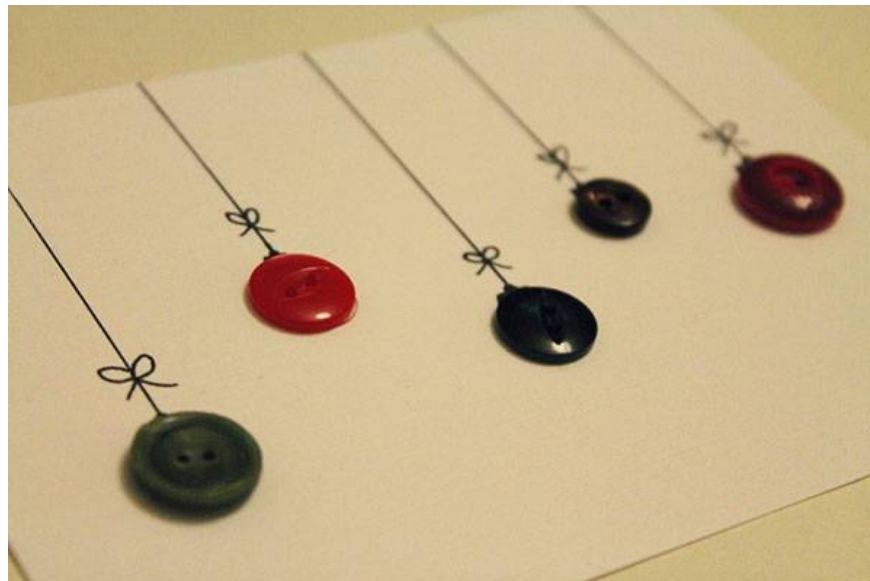
Cut different sized circles from colorful sheets, then staggered on the basic card. You use a black marker connected from spheres to the nape of the horizontal card. Finally, you draw more bows and the ring of the bell is done.



This is a very meaningful card to give to your lover on Christmas day. You just need to embed your fingers in the water color and print them on the basic card. Using colored markers to draw more ears, eyes, horns, nose, you can write meaningful, loving wishes to that person.



Things can't be simpler with this Christmas card template. Draw colorful dots to form a multicolored sphere on the middle of the basic card, then paste the ribbon tied from the top edge of the card to the sphere. You can also use colorful circular pieces of paper to make the sphere more unique.





Similar to the above method, you just need to choose the color and size buttons, you can get a warm card.
