Now that you've prepared almost all the essentials for buying a laptop, you can also narrow down your choices to several models after viewing user reviews of specific laptops. . This is the time to go shopping! However before you pay, you should consider some of the tips we recommend below.

Try before you buy

Many people choose to purchase online, in this way, buyers can choose the right laptop for themselves and can easily compare prices. However, you should not buy a new computer without previewing it. It's best to write down the names of some models that interest you, along with some notes why they're eye-catching and head straight to the nearest computer store. See if this store has the laptop you are interested in, or at least have the same models of the same manufacturer you wrote. Try typing to feel the keyboard - is this keyboard easy to type? Mouse sensor (touchpad) how? What does the screen look like? If the laptop you want to buy has a mirror screen (glossy), look at other models that also have a mirror screen and determine if you really like it more than anti-glare (non-mirror) displays.

Select the laptop you want to buy and evaluate it yourself. Fold the laptop screen and see if its size is suitable for the bag you have selected (no need to put it in the bag here). It should be noted that many netbooks displayed in stores are removed from the battery, which will make its weight significantly lighter than the battery weight.

When you have a crush on the notebook you want (or something very similar), you can go home and be confident to buy online. You can also use your phone or network to check prices to get the best price.

Need more RAM? Please force yourself further



Suppose the laptop you want to buy has only 2GB of RAM but can support up to 4GB. You can then save money by manually adding more RAM to your laptop. Just a little more time, you can completely upgrade your laptop's RAM, but what you benefit will be the low cost. Try comparing a laptop with 4GB of RAM compared to a laptop with 2GB of RAM and you buy 2GB of RAM to install it to see this clearly.

Of course, adding more RAM will have to do some work. But the most important thing is that you need to make sure that the laptop still has empty slots so you can plug in more RAM (ask the clerk for more information if you're not sure), specify the type and speed of RAM you need. If all this seems to scare you, then buy a system that has enough RAM before.

Know what accessories to buy

If you want an extra battery, you should choose the battery that is manufactured in accordance with the specific model of the notebook. It is not bad if you buy the correct battery that comes with your computer - especially if you make an online purchase, then the backup battery can be provided as an option. Use note if you buy the main out-of-band battery manufactured for your laptop: some of these batteries may cost less, but the time it takes to maintain the laptop is also shorter. Refer to user reviews and battery comments from these third-party companies carefully to make sure you don't sacrifice battery life to save a bit of money.

If you need an external optical drive, do not force to buy this drive from the laptop manufacturer. Optical drives connected via USB are often very popular, so finding a drive of this type at an affordable price is possible.



Among many other laptop accessories, consider buying you a convenient and small-sized wireless mouse. Since the touchpad mouse is good, it will annoy you a lot, so choose from a multitude of wireless mice specifically designed for your mobile and laptop. However, if you want to use a laptop mouse on an airplane, you need to know that wireless versions are prohibited - in this case you will need a wired model to use on the plane. It is possible to avoid expensive money in a dedicated laptop bag, these bags are often sold at very high prices by stores. Unless you have a deal (reduce the price in a promotion or free way when buying a laptop), choose carefully. Buying a good bag is an entirely different process - do not choose bags that you don't like just because it's convenient and convenient.

If the salesperson tries to press your hand with things like a screen cleaner box, a white disc, an extension cable, then say 'no'. These components are also quite expensive in computer stores, you can buy them more easily online if you don't think you need them right away.

When in doubt, boldly decide

If after practicing with some laptops you still can't be sure whether you need a faster processor, dedicated graphics or more RAM, be bold. No one complains that their laptops are too fast, but taking the next two years to work on a laptop makes you feel frustrated with poor performance that could make you faster. Software will consume more and more resources over time; Then the applications you use next year will also require a bit more than you use today. If you have an HDTV or are considering buying it in the future, then the HDMI output on your laptop may be useful.

Review of extended warranty

Most groups advocate for customers will tell you not to receive extended warranty; Such an arrangement is often beneficial for manufacturers and retailers, most users will not use this extended warranty issue. Because of these benefits, salespeople often introduce you to the need for some laptop protection programs or extended warranty issues.

Laptops differ slightly from most desktop computers and consumer electronics in that they can be easily moved. Users can easily throw them into bags, put them somewhere, put them on the table, . however this advantage sometimes harms you. So you need to know yourself and the environment where you will use your laptop. If you think you are capable of damaging your laptop for about two years, then consider an extended warranty. Besides laptop theft protection plans are also a good idea for college students, who are most likely to lose laptops.
