

Guide to capturing Android device screen scrolls to capture the entire web page

Instead of 'attacking' your friends' messages with dozens of screenshots, you can capture the screen and send it.

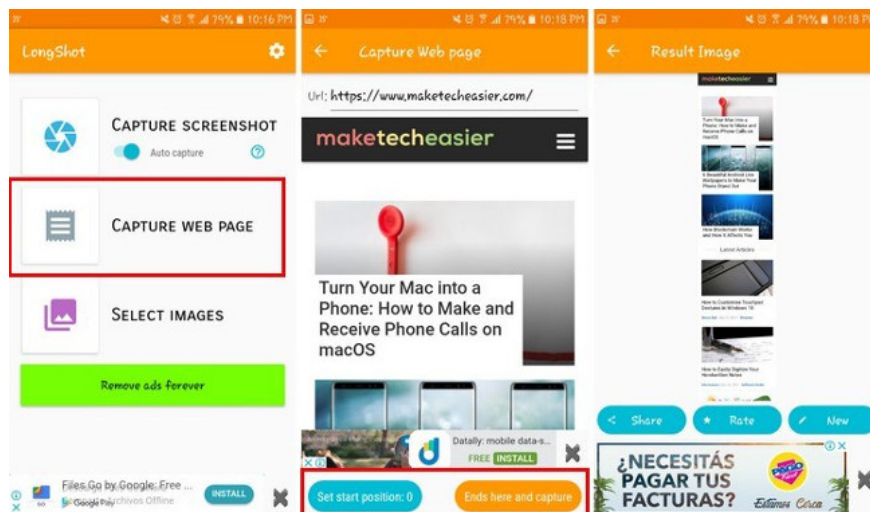
While using your phone, you can always find interesting conversations and images to share with your friends. This is easy with 1 or 2 screenshots. However, what do you do if you want to send a friend a long conversation, or an entire web site?

Instead of "attacking" your friends' messages with dozens of screenshots, you can capture the screen and send it. Scrolling the screen captures a long image like many screenshots. It may seem hard, but the way to capture this screen is easier than you think. It will help you save time and energy.

LongShot for Long Screenshot application

A great application to capture screen scrolls is LongShot for Long Screenshot. It is completely free and easy to use. When you open the application, you will see the Select Images, Capture Web Page, and Capture Screenshot options.

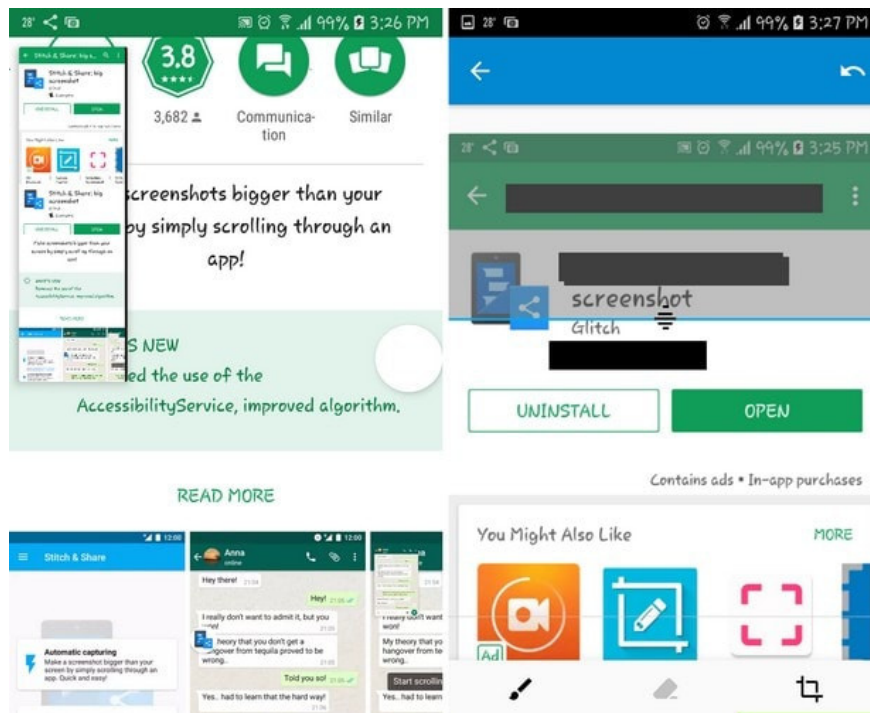
With the " **Capture Screenshot** " option, the application will capture all the websites you visit. As for the " **Capture Web Page** " option, you need to enter the URL of the website you want to capture the screen of.



After entering the page address, you can select the start and end points for the image you want to capture. Select the ' **Set Start Position** ' button to start and select ' **Ends Here and Capture** ' to finish and take a picture. After that, the application will display a preview of the image along with options to **share** (share images) and **new** (new capture). When finished, you can go to the library and view the captured image.

Apply Stitch & Share: Big Screenshot

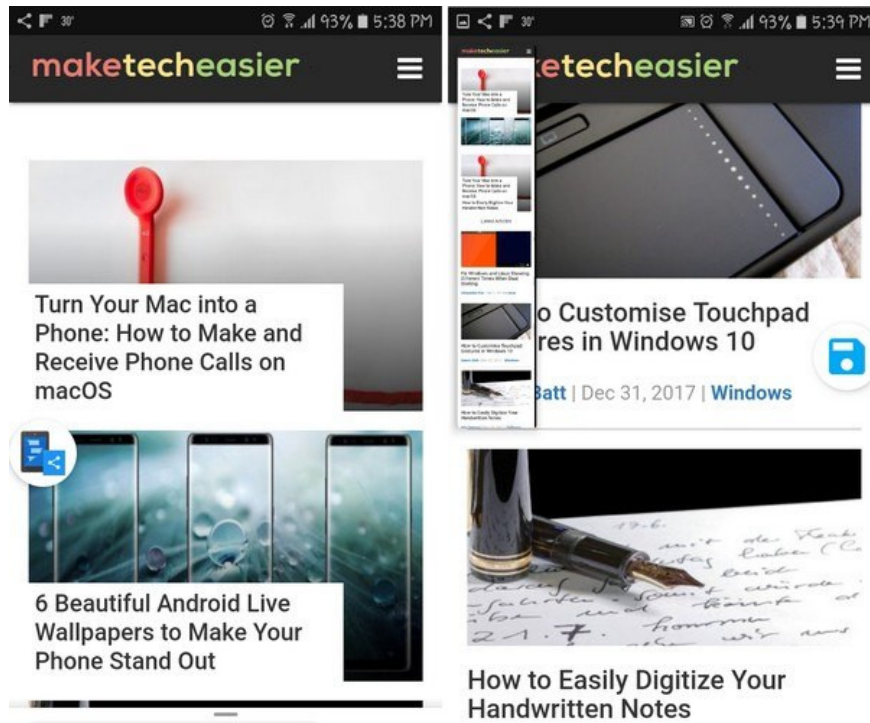
Stitch & Share: Big Screenshot has more features than LongShot for Long Screenshot. In addition to having a beautiful design, it also allows you to cut and draw on images before sharing them to others. If you use the free version, you only have two colors to paint. To use more colors, you need to upgrade your account to Premium.



The application allows you to create lines to cut out any information from the captured image. However, its disadvantage is that only horizontal lines can be created and you can only draw on the image when you combine the previously captured images together.

When the images have been stitched together, you will see the pen brush icon on the top right with two default color options: black and gold. Black is suitable for deleting sensitive information, while yellow is used to highlight highlights.

Stitch & Share allows you to combine multiple images, multiple screenshots into a single image. The application can stitch multiple GIFs together, but will display them as images. To take photos of websites, select **Automatic Capturing** and open any page you want to capture.



When you open the website, click the floating button icon on the screen then slowly scroll the web page. The preview of the photo will appear in the top left corner of the screen. When done, press ' Save ' and the image will be saved automatically in the device's library.

Conclude

Screen capture is very useful in saving your device capacity. It also saves you time watching everything on an image without having to swipe multiple times.
