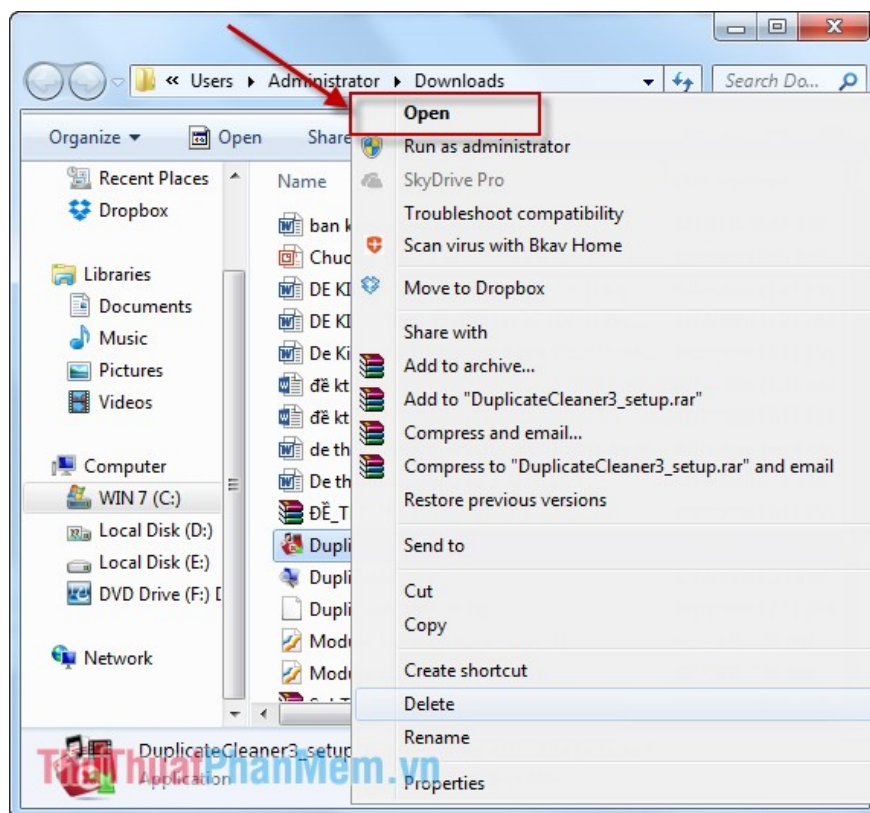
In this article, I will show you how to delete duplicate photos using **Duplicate Images Finder** software - tool to help find and delete duplicates.

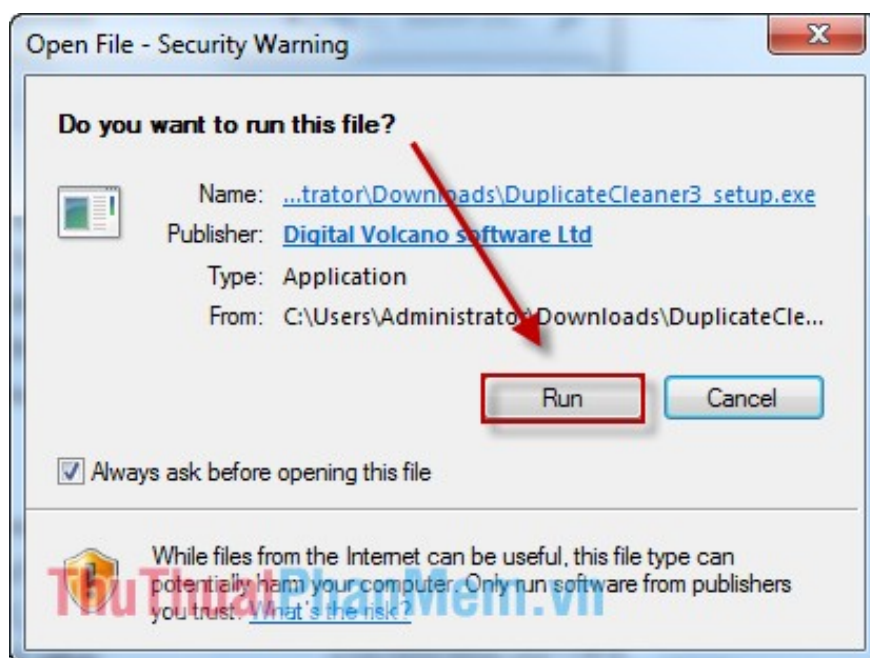
After downloading the software, install.

1. Install the software

Step 1: After downloading the software, right click on the software and select **Open** .



Step 2: Click the **Run** button to begin the installation process.



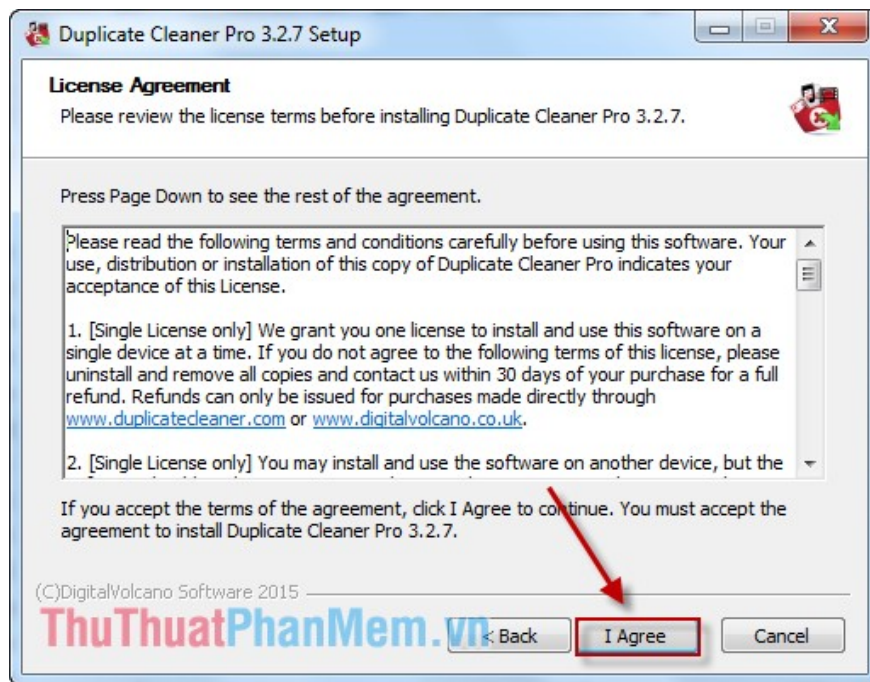
Step 3: Select **English** language -> click **OK** .



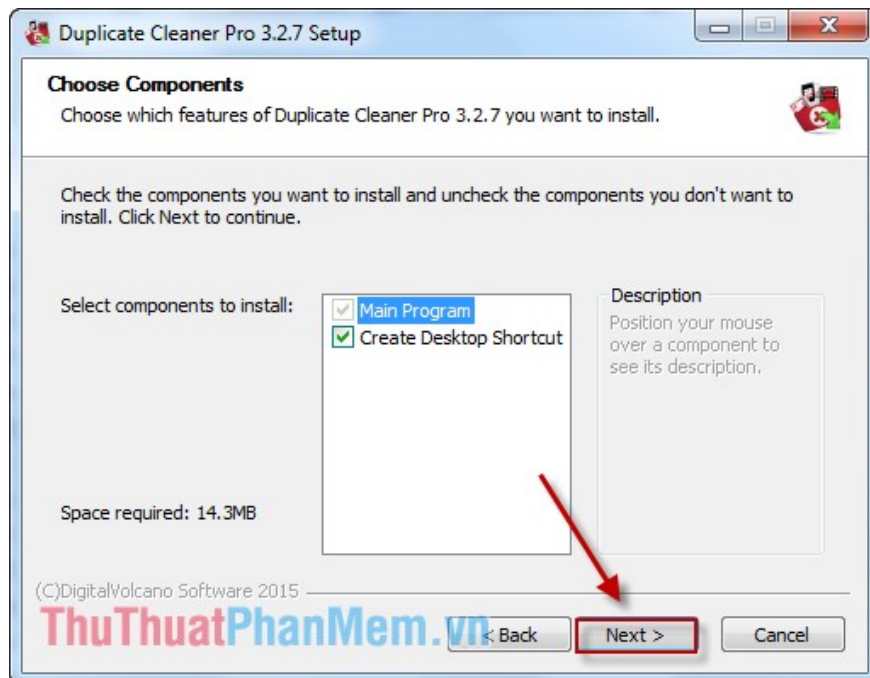
Step 4: Click the **Next** button to continue the installation process.



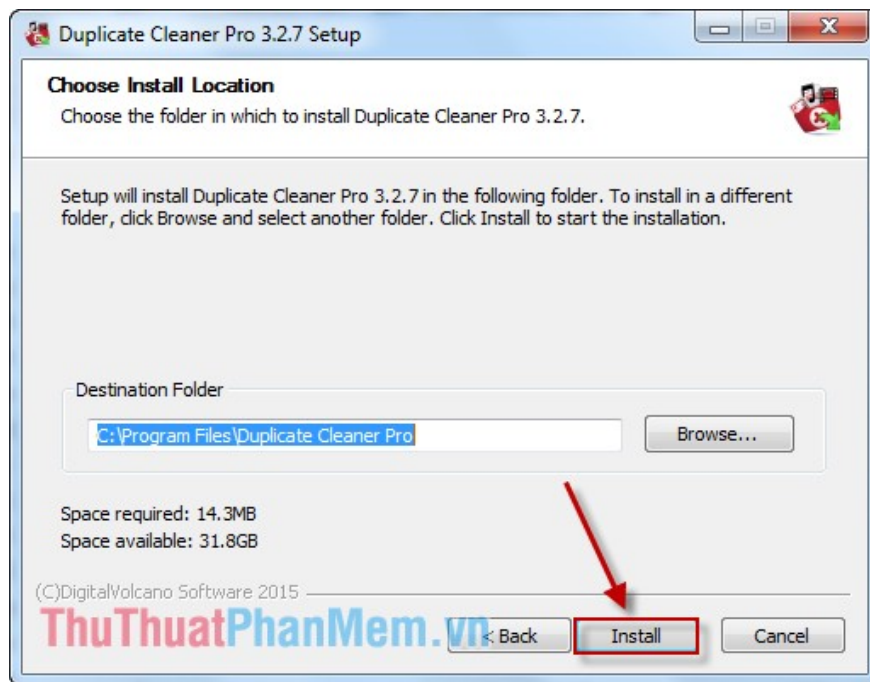
Step 5: Click **I Agree** to agree to the above setting and begin the process.



Step 6: Integrate choose **Create Desktop Shortcut** to create software icon on the Desktop -> click on **Next** .



Step 7: Click **Install** to install the software on your computer.



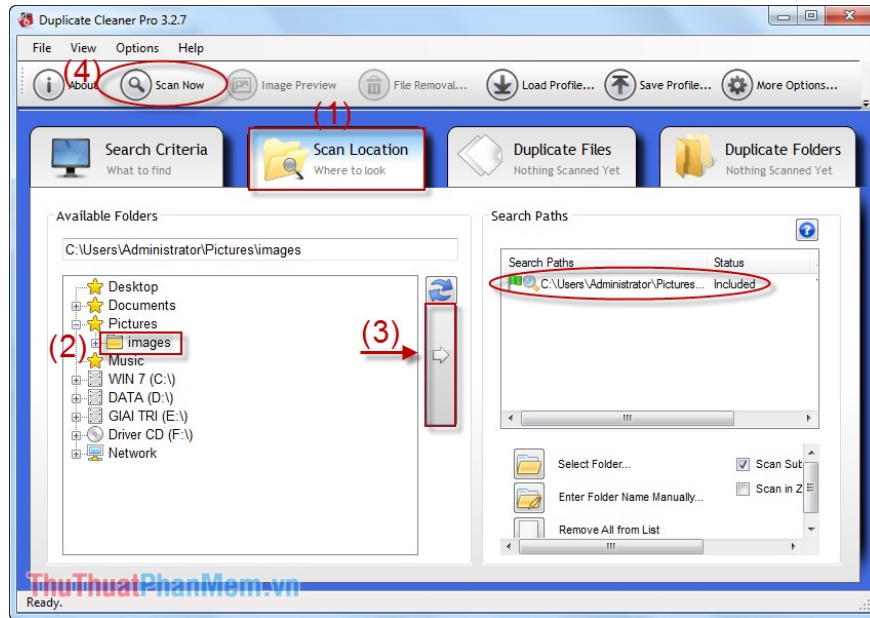
Step 8: Click **Finish** to complete the installation process.



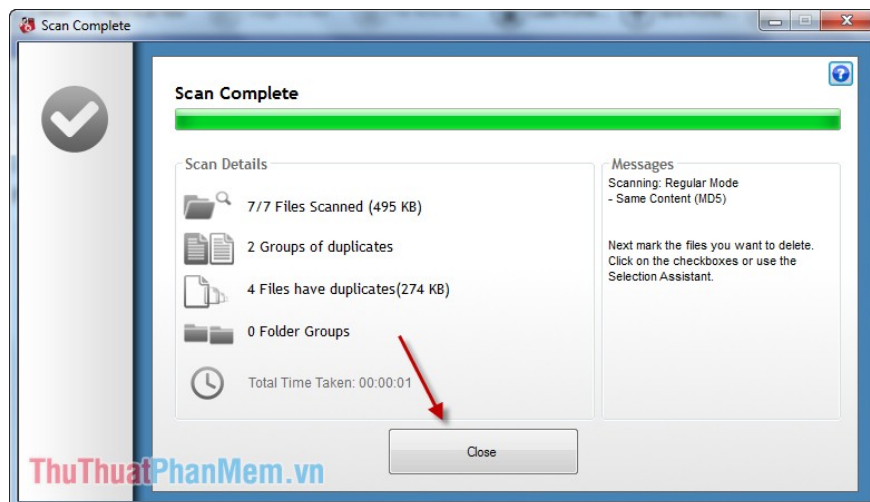
So you have completed the software installation process.

2. Find and delete duplicate photos on your computer

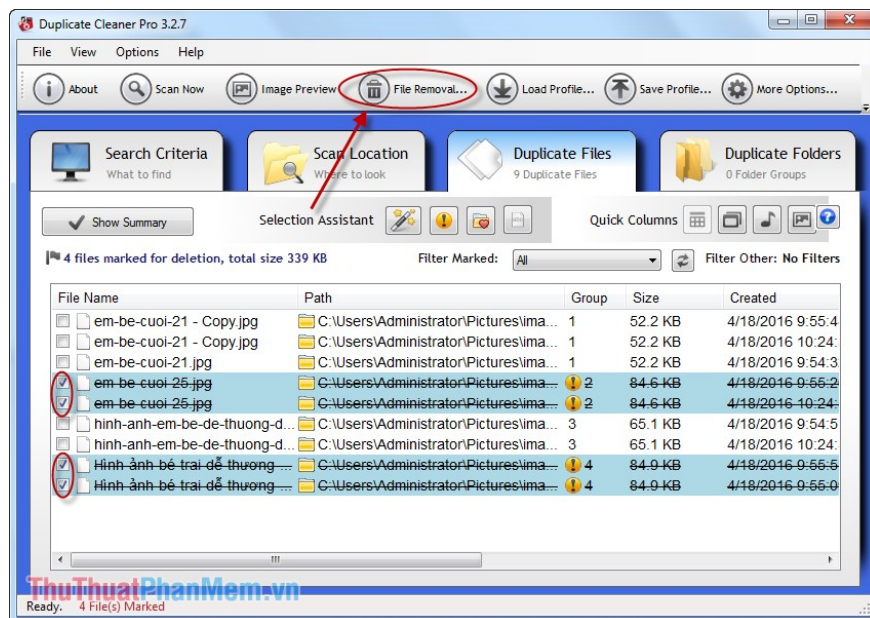
Step 1: Open the **Duplicate Cleaner** software -> click **Scan Location** -> Select the folder containing the data files to scan for duplicate photos -> click the arrow icon to move the desired folder to **Search Paths** -> click **Scan Now** to search for duplicate images.



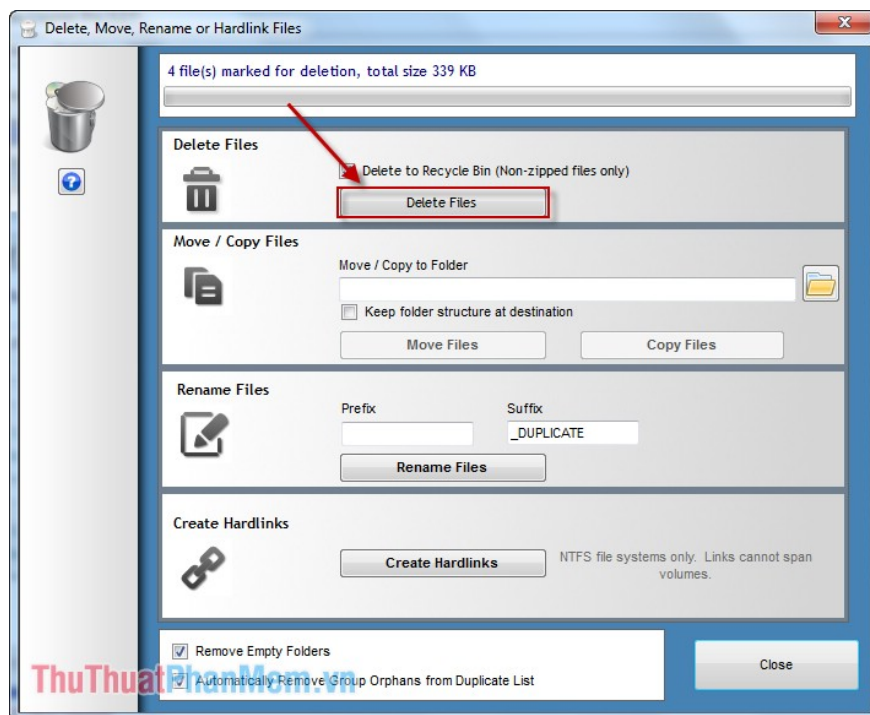
Step 2: After the search process displays the total number of duplicate files, click **Close** .



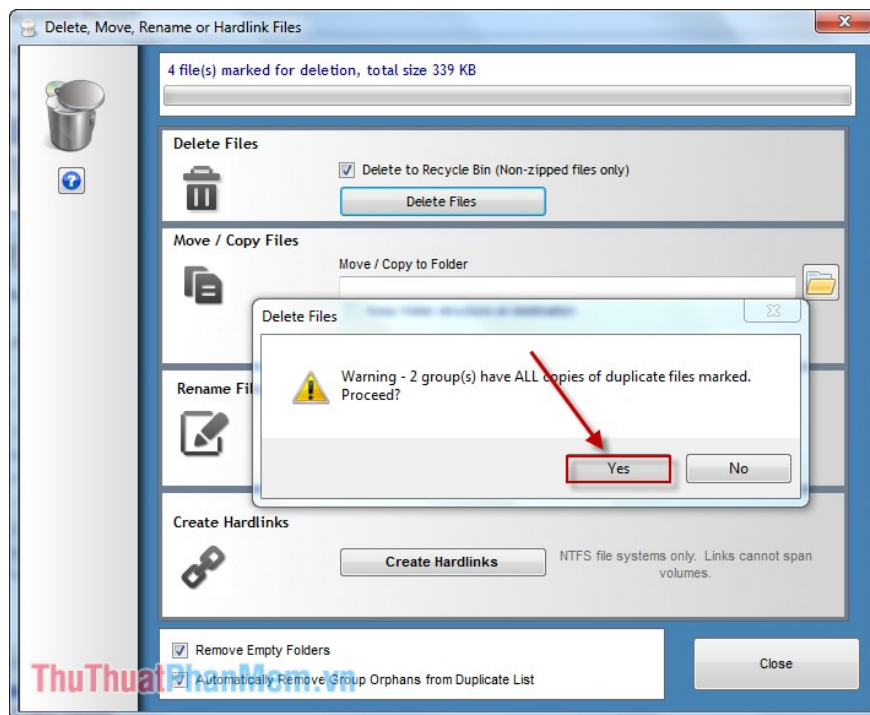
Step 3: The search process ends the selected files (in green) are duplicate files -> select those files -> move the mouse up to select **File Removal** .



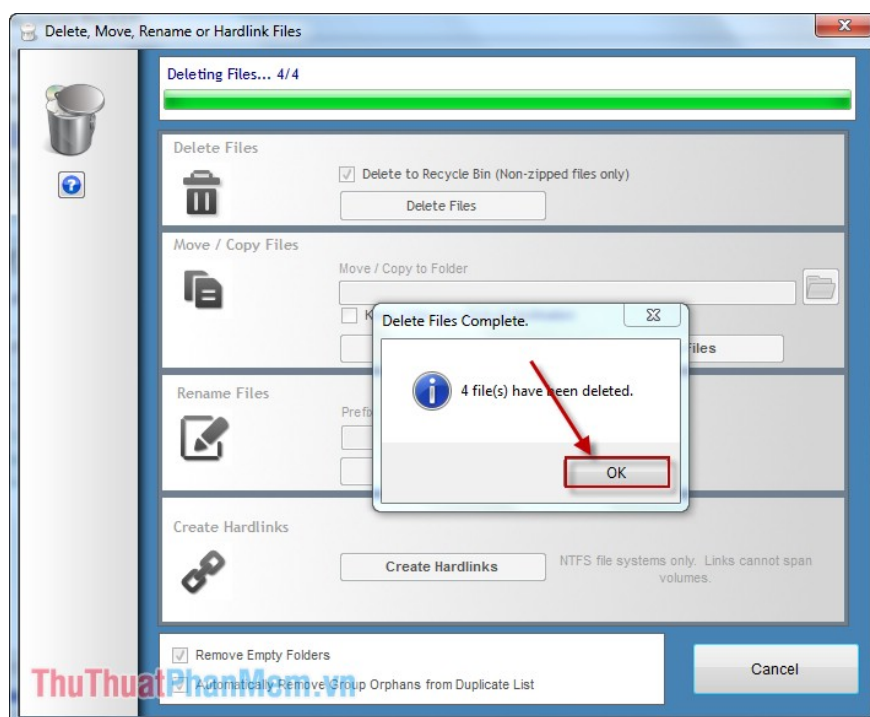
Step 4: A dialog box appears and select **Delete Files** .



Step 5: Before deleting the file, a dialog box appears, click **Yes** to start the process of deleting duplicate data files.



After the **Delete** process completes, a dialog box appears and click **OK** .



So you have found and deleted duplicate image files, contributing to saving memory space.
