The emails are disguised to look like they were sent by government agencies, social welfare providers and public health centers to gain the victim's trust. In reality, the attackers spread malicious code through email attachments. In other words, malware will be integrated in document files (PDF, DOCX), video (MP4) and especially malicious links attached in emails. If the victim clicks the link or downloads the file to their computer, their system will be infected with malware.



These include botnets, ransomware, spying malware that steal personal information, or even Trojans and Worms that can destroy, block, modify or copy data, as well as interfere with the operation of the system or computer network.

In fact, the type of attacks that take advantage of international events that are being cared for are not new. Major international events such as Christmas or Black Friday are the favorite factors for hackers to take advantage of 'stealing' from the gullibility of internet users. This form of attack is not new, but it always works because not everyone has enough knowledge to protect themselves against malicious acts on cyberspace.

Instead of waiting for the entry of cyber security organizations, the safest security measure you should take is not to click on unauthenticated links, or download the files sent from unknown sources. determined.
