

Instructions to turn off Hardware Acceleration Chrome to speed up your computer

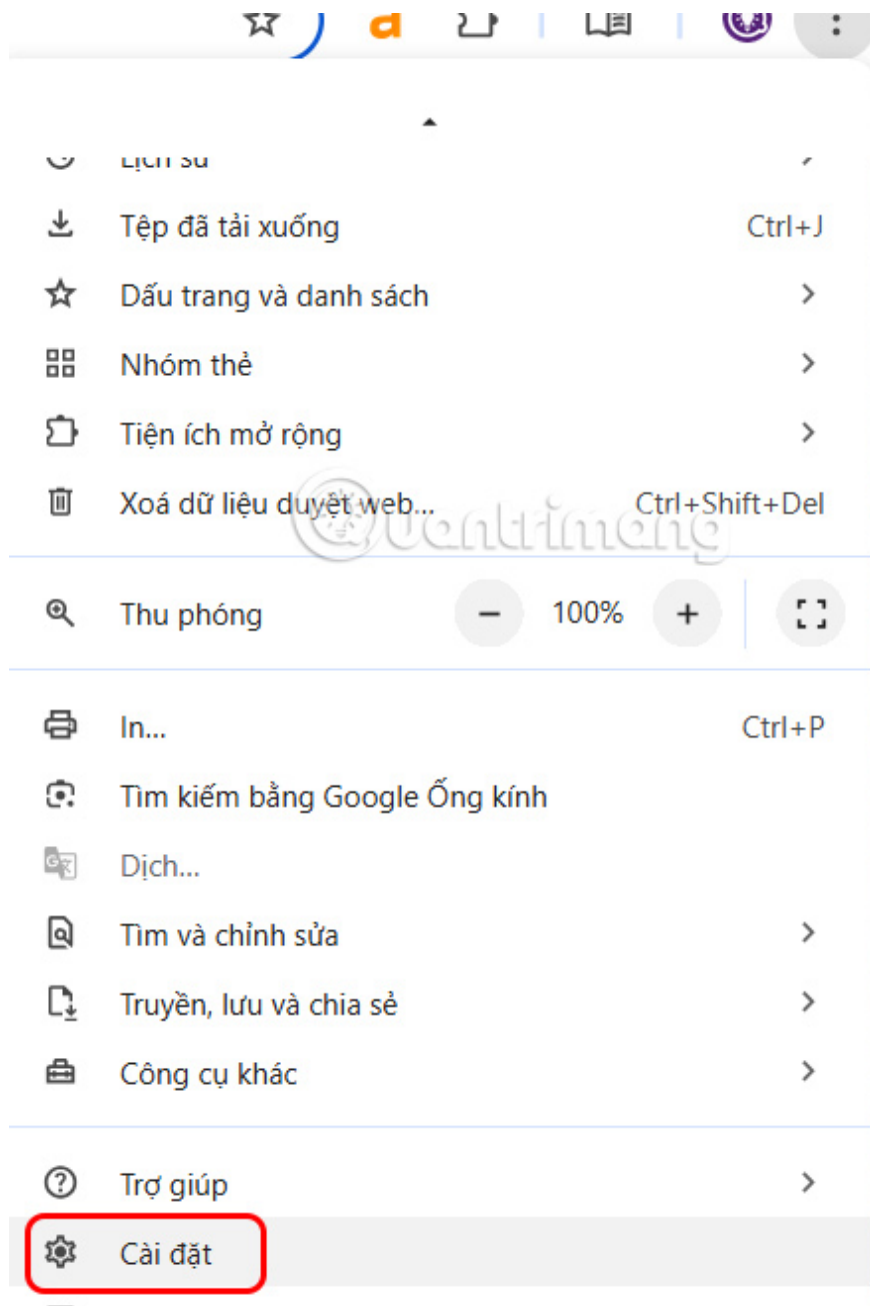
Hardware Acceleration in Chrome helps smoothen all operations on the browser. If Chrome is having trouble using it, you can turn off Hardware Acceleration.

Instructions to turn off Hardware Acceleration Chrome

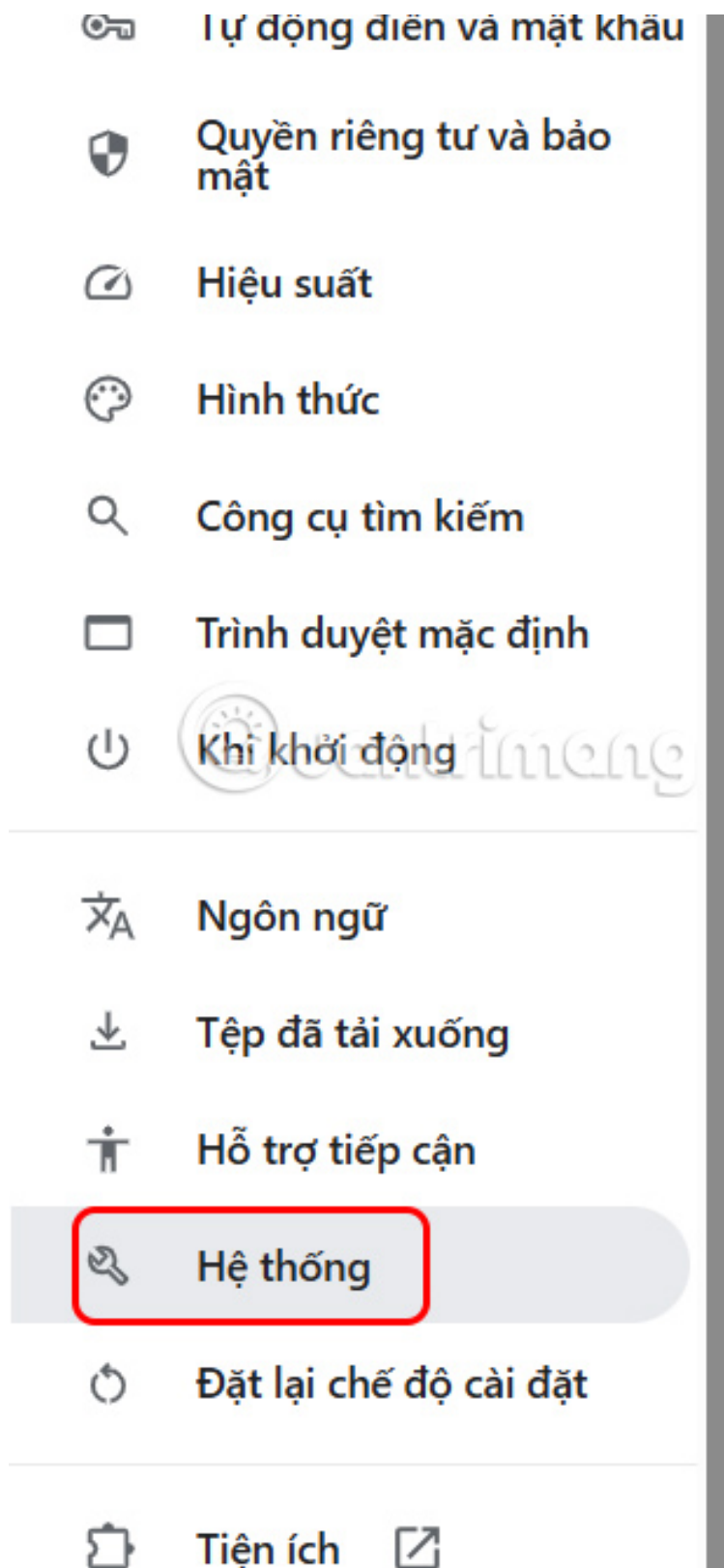
Step 1:

We click on **the 3 dots icon** and select **Settings** in the displayed list.



Step 2:

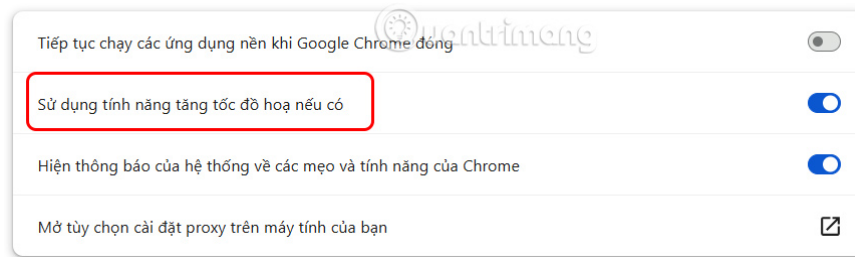
Switch to the new interface, the user clicks on **the System item** in the customization list on the left of the interface.



Step 3:

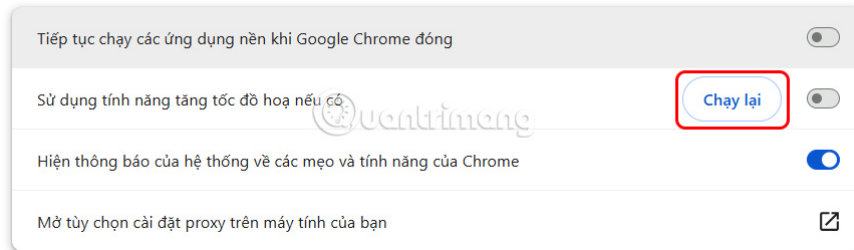
