According to authentic sources, Harry Potter: Wizards Unite, the latest virtual reality game of Pokémon GO Niantic developer, will begin to be released worldwide on Friday, June 21 here.

According to authentic sources, Harry Potter: Wizards Unite, the latest virtual reality game of developer GO Niantic, will begin to be released worldwide on Friday, June 21. Previously, Niantic also released a beta version of Harry Potter: Wizards Unite in Australia and New Zealand markets.

It is still unclear whether this highly experienced game will be released globally or locally according to specific areas. The brief information from the developer Niantic's official tweet is simply to announce that this AR game will be officially released on June 21 and 'follow up for more information, because of Harry Potter. : Wizards Unite will be available soon in your area. '

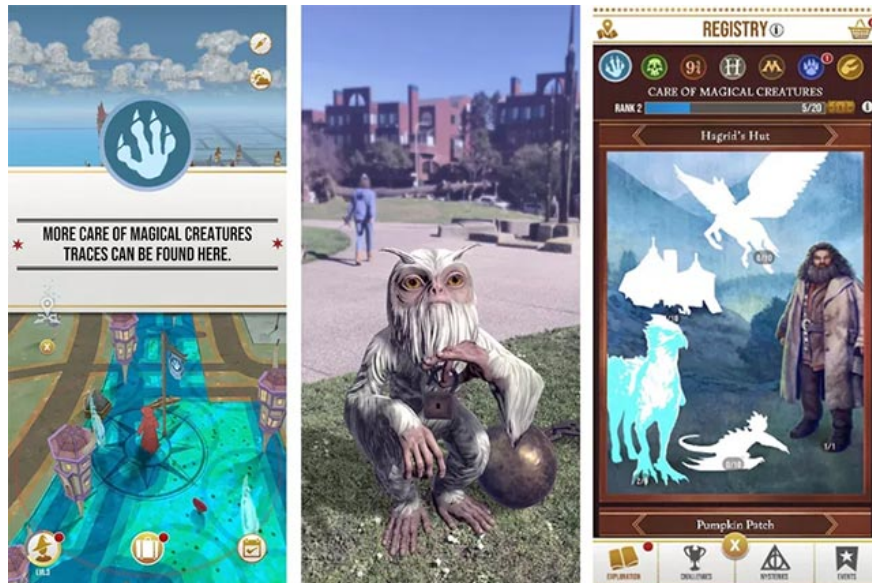

Another popular Niantic AR game, Pokémon GO, also took a relatively long time to "be allowed" to debut in some countries like Japan. So the 21/06 timeline that the publisher gave to Harry Potter: Wizards Unite is probably only reference.

If you don't know, Harry Potter: Unite Wizards is basically a virtual reality game similar to Pokémon GO, but will have a more complex play mechanism. Specifically, Wizards Unite is similar to Pokémon GO in that the player will have to go to the real world and interact with the area where he or she lives through the screen of smartphones and tablets. However, the difference (and also more complicated) is that the player will have to perform a variety of different actions such as chanting, using magic, interacting with strange magic events, and

even seeing magical creatures from Harry Potter, instead of just having to catch Pokémon like before.

In addition to fighting against the mythical monsters that appeared in the Harry Potter and Fantastic Beasts series, players can also choose their own witch house, wand and career: Professor, Auror (the god of light) or Magizoologist (who studies miracles).

In terms of gameplay, after creating the game account, the player will choose a representative picture, and their position in the game will depend on the geographical location of the device in real life. After that, the player will go around the area where they live to find and catch magical creatures, as well as go to the inns (to add magic power), greenhouses (to get materials medicine) and fortress (to fight more creatures). When players move in real world surroundings, their avatar moves in the corresponding map of the game.
