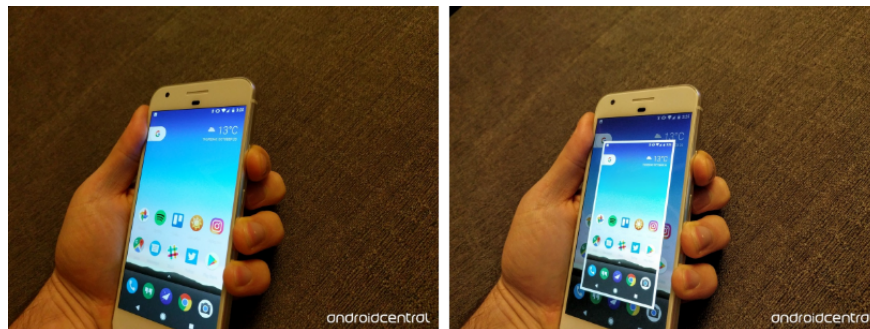

1. Take photos of Google Pixel phone screen

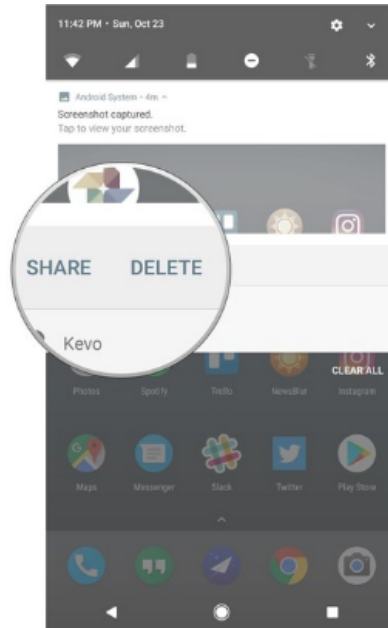
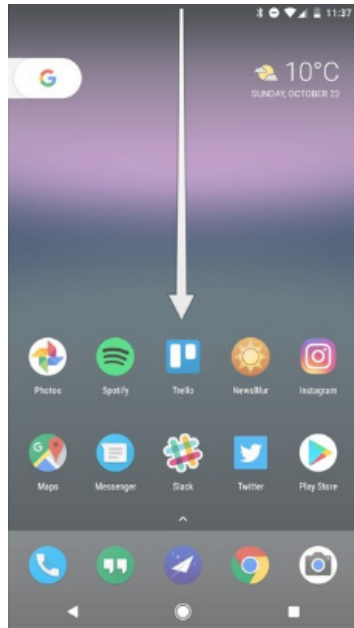
1. Press and hold simultaneously **the Power button** on the right side and **the Volume down button** at the same time.
2. Then release your hands from the 2 buttons at once.



2. Open the screenshot

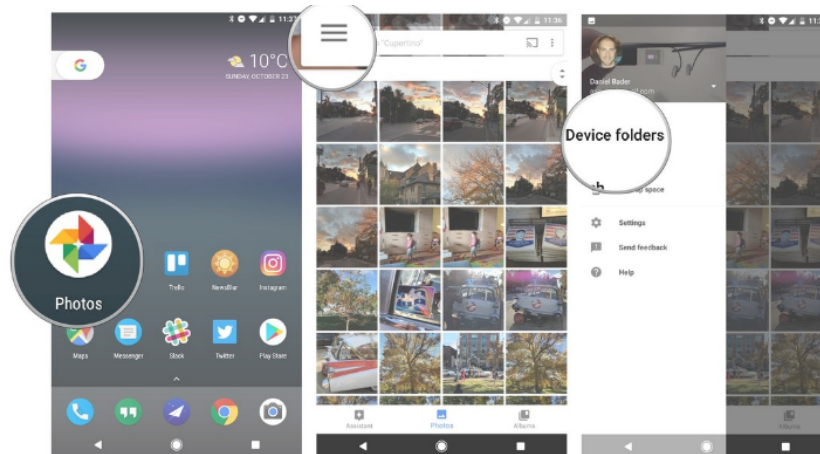
On Google Pixel, screenshots are stored in a specific folder on the photo application (photo).

1. Swipe down **the system** tray .
2. Click on **Screenshot** to open the screenshot.
3. Click **Share** or **Delete** to share or delete the screen image you have taken.

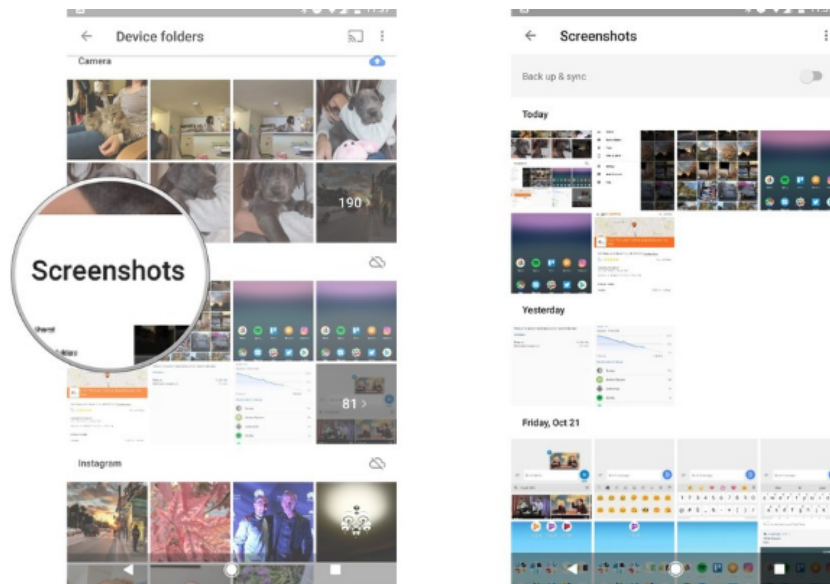


3. Open and view all screenshots

1. Open the **Google Photos** app.
2. Click the **3 dash line** icon in the top left corner of the screen.
3. Click to select **Device folders** .



4. Click on **Screenshots folder** .
5. Open or share the screenshot you want.



4. Use Google Assistant to take a screenshot

Currently Google Assistant does not allow users to take voice screen shots, however sooner or later this feature will be integrated.

This feature is available on Google Now on Tap on previous versions of Android.
