Bell also said Intel is aiming at a combination of people and research from computer companies to create the next generation of technology.

*' About 10 to 20 years from now, I think in many cases we will be almost unable to think of it as a computer anymore, it will become part of what you usually do everyday'*

He also noted that the social network will attract much attention. *"In a few years, social connections for business purposes have become very familiar."*

*' Many applications will be added ' Vara said ' I think any software will have an impact on society. We are creating a lot of more useful tools for customers and you will find it more and more in business'.*
