

How do I know if my old iPhone has been repaired or replaced?

With how to check if the critical components of the device have been replaced, repaired or not will help you evaluate this iPhone device more comprehensively. Join the Network Administrator to check whether your iPhone has been replaced with these devices!

How to check if the old iPhone has been replaced or not?

Step 1:

Performing to check whether iPhone has been repaired, replaced components, you need to use the support tool named iTunes. Click the link below to proceed to download and install iTunes for your device.

1. Download: iTunes for Windows

Step 2:

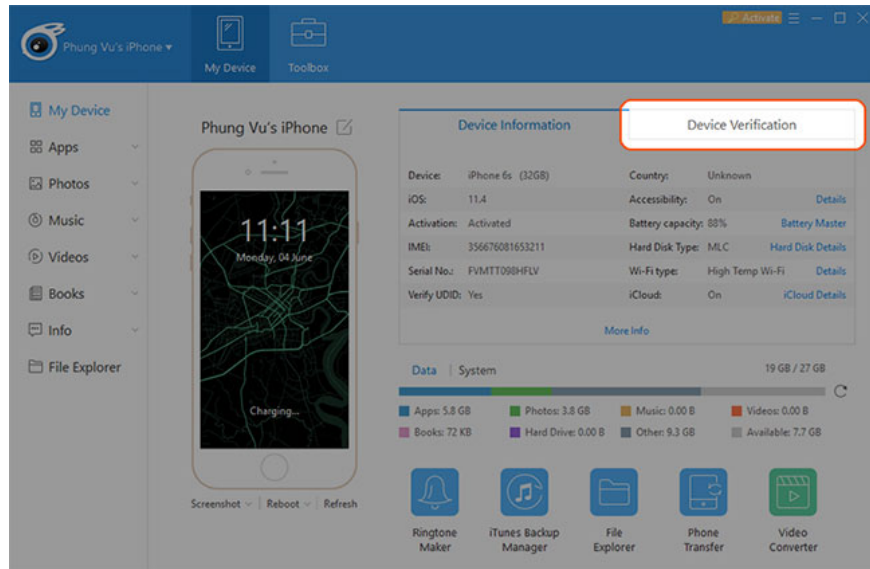
You start the iTunes application. Then, **connect iPhone to computer** via charging cable as required at this application interface screen.

Note: In case the application does not accept the iPhone, please unlock the iPhone screen and select **Trust** if the notice board is displayed. Otherwise, the application will display a notice board on your computer to update your compatible device to identify iPhone.

Step 3:

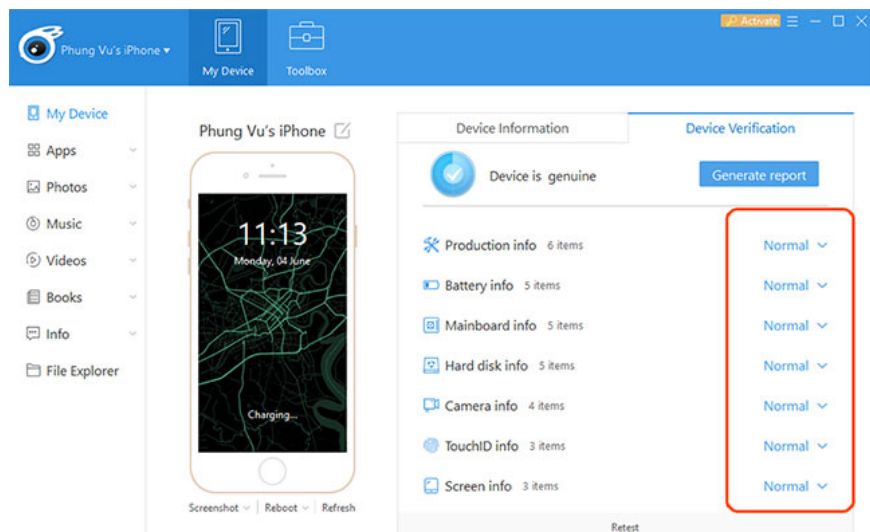
iTunes system will proceed to confirm your iPhone device, if successful identification at the main interface of iTunes will display all information of that iPhone device. You go to **Device Verification** to check whether the

iPhone has been repaired instead.

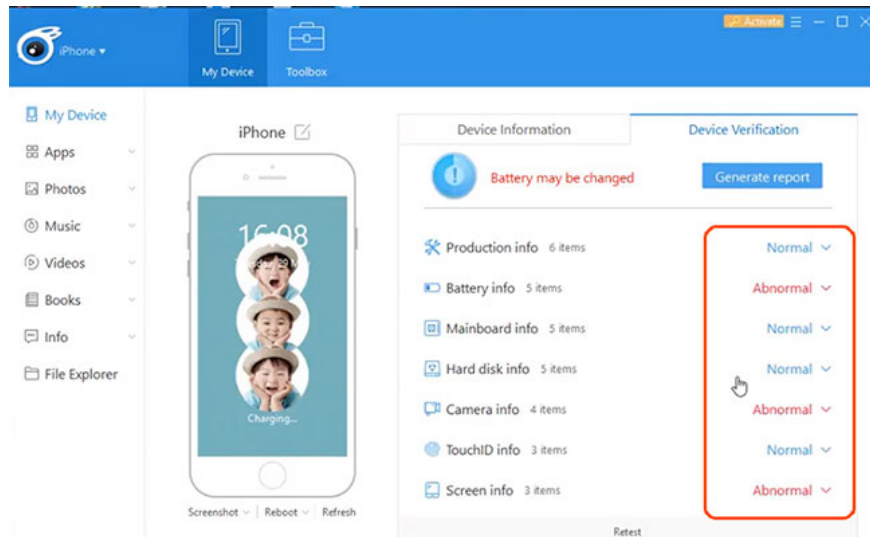


Step 4:

At this time, the program will evaluate and check the component information in the iPhone at the same time. If all components show the **Normal** message as shown below, congratulations, this indicates that the components are good and have not been repaired.



Conversely, if you see a component that displays an **Abnormal** status, it is likely that the component has been repaired or replaced.



And to check the details, you can **click on this component information** , the program will immediately appear information that you can compare on the device being used on iPhone.

Thus, with just a few simple steps, we know how to identify whether the iPhone has been repaired or not, although it is not 100% accurate, but this is also a useful trick to check and More information about the phone we want to buy.
