

How long does it take to change cards, redeem ATM cards, or lose money?

What documents do you need to redo and exchange ATM cards?

When we lose many cards, we are often confused about the loss of our account, and what documents we need to prepare to get a new card.

So when you lose or tear your bank card, if you want to be re-issued, you just need to prepare the original identity card, or your original ID card.

In case you lose your ID card or ID card and need to remake your ATM card right away, you can use the original household registration card or a certified copy of the bank to redeem the lost ATM card.

How long does it take to retake the card?

When unfortunately losing your card or damage, you must go to the bank to change your card.

Depending on the bank, the time to re-issue the card is long or short. There is a bank that takes only 1 week, some places are 10 days, even longer is 2 weeks.

Does it cost money to redeem an ATM card?

Depending on the bank, the user will charge a fee. But most are free when re-issuing the card.

If the ATM card is redone, will the card number and account number be changed, will the money in the account be withdrawn?

When you redo the card, your card number and your old account number will not be changed, you will retain all the information you previously provided. ATM cards are just a form of transaction, so when you redo the card, you don't worry about losing money or having to withdraw money, because they are still in your card.



What happens during the card redemption process?

During card redemption, if you want to withdraw money, you just need to hold your ID or identification card to the bank's transaction points to withdraw money, usually you will come to the counter and write down the withdrawal slip later. give to bank staff.

In addition, if you use a Techcombank card, you can also withdraw money without a card.

Lost ID card but need to withdraw money quickly?

In this case, there is only one way: if you use internet banking on your phone, you can transfer to another account to withdraw. Or go over and redeem your identity card so you can withdraw money.
