10. Blend smokers live next door to cat owners.
11. The man who raises a horse lives next to the one who smokes Dunhill.
12. Bluemaster smokers love to drink beer.
13. German man smoking Prince.
14. The Norwegian man lives next to the blue house.
15. Blend smokers know a neighbor drinking water.

So who is raising fish?

1. Norwegian men live in yellow houses, drink water, smoke Dunhill and have a cat.
2. The Danish man lives in a blue house, drinking tea, smoking Blends and having a horse.
3. The British man lives in a red house, drinks milk, smokes Pall Mall and has a bird.
4. The German man lives in a green house, drinks coffee, smokes Prince and has a fish.
5. Swedish men live in white houses, drink beer, smoke BlueMaster and have a dog.
