

## How much does the iPhone version cost?

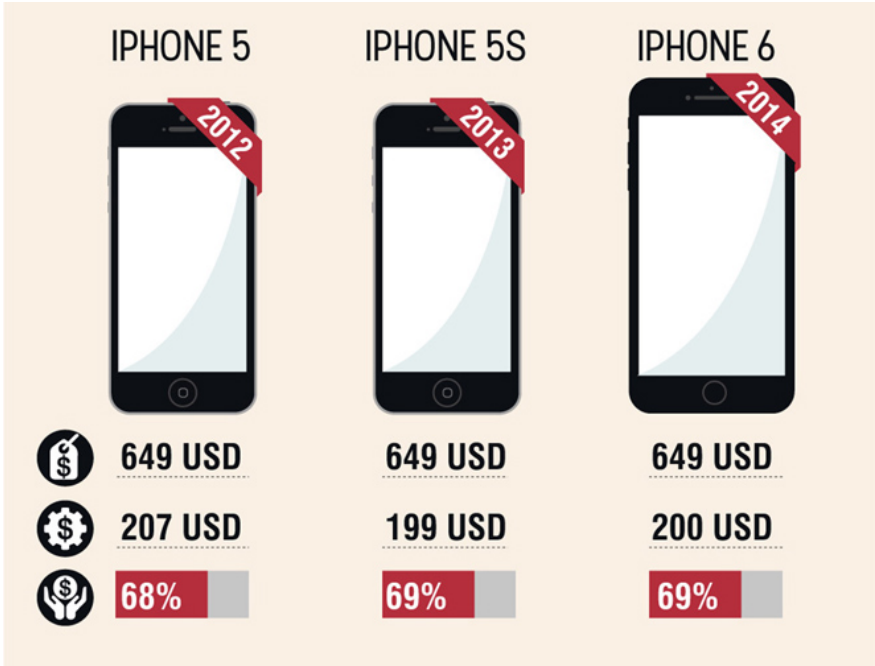
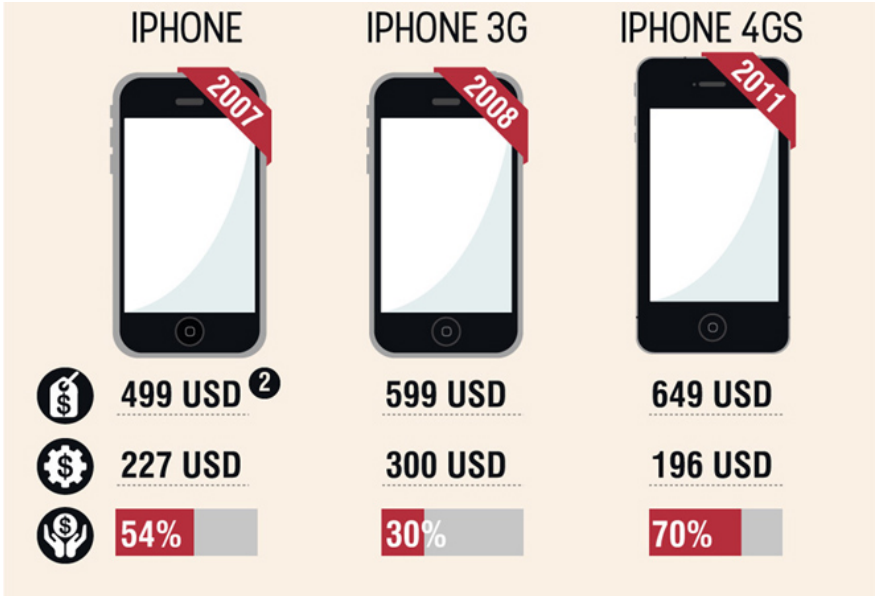
Many people have come up with the production costs that Apple has to pay for each iPhone version as well as the profits that the company earns based on estimated component prices.

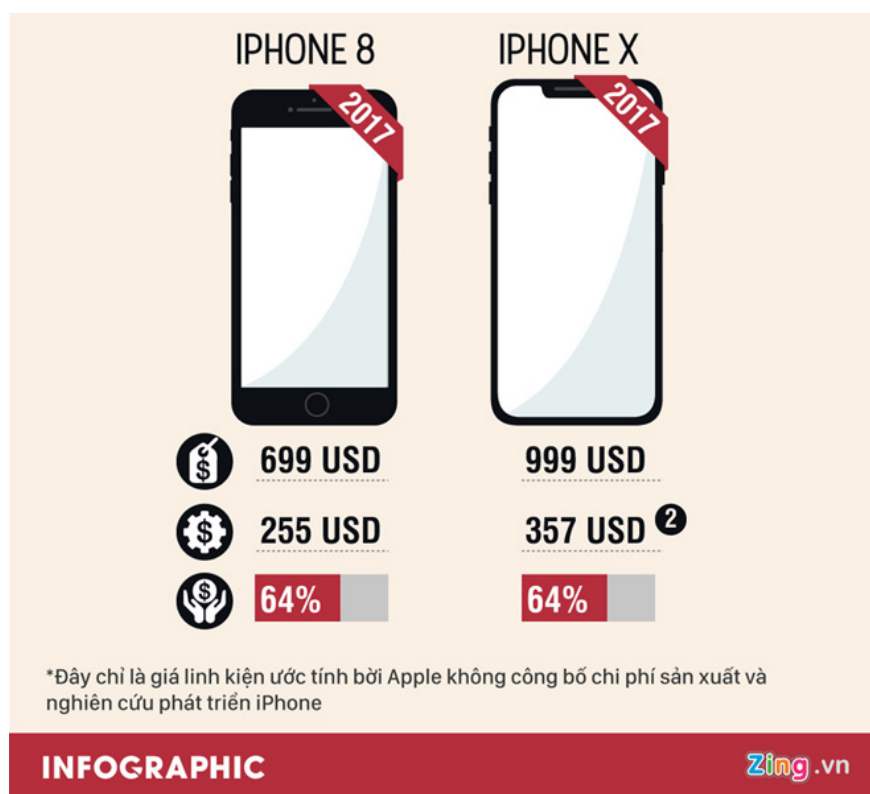
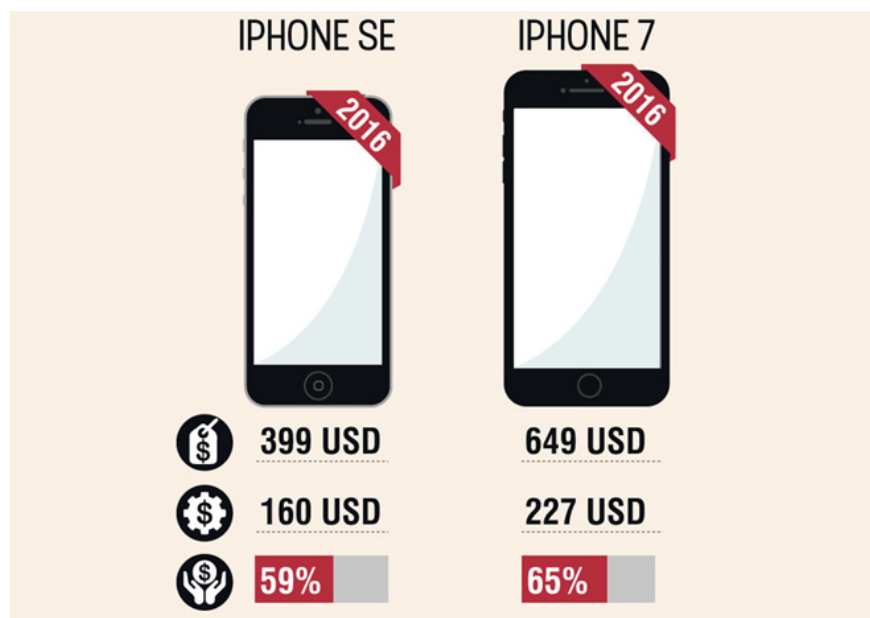
Since the first version of the iPhone launched in 2007, Apple has sold 1.42 billion iPhones on a global scale. The revenue generated by the iPhone for Apple is \$ 920.7 billion. Until now, Apple has not yet announced production costs and researched any iPhone development.

However, many people have come up with the production costs that Apple has to pay for each iPhone version as well as the profits that the company earns based on estimated component prices. Accordingly, the iPhone X is the most expensive phone that Apple produces at a cost of up to 357 USD. The most expensive part on the iPhone X is an OLED screen with \$ 65.50, which is much more expensive than an LCD screen on an iPhone 8.
