+ Access BIOS: Press ESC or Del (Delete) key

+ Access Boot Menu: Press F2, F8, or Esc key

+ Access BIOS: Press F2 or Del (Delete) key

+ Access Boot Menu: Press F12, F9, or Esc.

Note: To access the Boot Menu on Acer laptops, follow these steps: Press F2 to access the BIOS first, then press F12 to access the Boot Menu.

+ Access BIOS: Press F10 or ESC key, or F1 key

+ Access Boot Menu: Press F9 or Esc key

+ Access Recovery: Press F11 key

+ Access BIOS: Press F2

+ Access Boot Menu: Press F12

+ Access Recovery: Press F8 and select Repair your Computer

+ Access BIOS: Press ESC key

+ Access Boot Menu: Press F2 or Esc key

+ Access BIOS: Press F1 or F2

+ Access Boot Menu: Press F12, F8, F10, or Fn+F11

+ Access Recovery: Press ThinkVantage key

+ Access BIOS: Press F2

+ Access Recovery: Press F10

+ Access BIOS: Press the Dell (Delete) key

+ Access Boot Option: Press the F11 key

+ Access BIOS: Press F1, F2, or ESC depending on the model.

+ Access Boot Menu: Press F12.

+ Access BIOS: Press ESC key

+ Access Boot Menu: Press F2 or F12 key

ASRock Mainboard: Press and hold the F2 key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

Foxconn Mainboard: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

GIGABYTE Mainboard: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

Intel Mainboard: Press and hold the F2 key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

ASUS Mainboard: You can press one of the three keys DEL, Print, or F10 during computer startup to access the BIOS.

BFG Mainboard: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

MSI (Micro-Star) Mainboard: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

PCChips Mainboard: You can press one of the two keys F1 or DEL during computer startup to access the BIOS.

DFI Mainboard: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

ECS Elitegroup Mainboard: You can press one of the two keys F1 or DEL during computer startup to access the BIOS.

EVGA Mainboard: Press and hold the DEL key. Hold down the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

For FREESCALE motherboards: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.
For

Abit motherboards: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS. For

JetWay motherboards: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

For Mach Speed ??motherboards: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

For SAPHIRE motherboards: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS. For

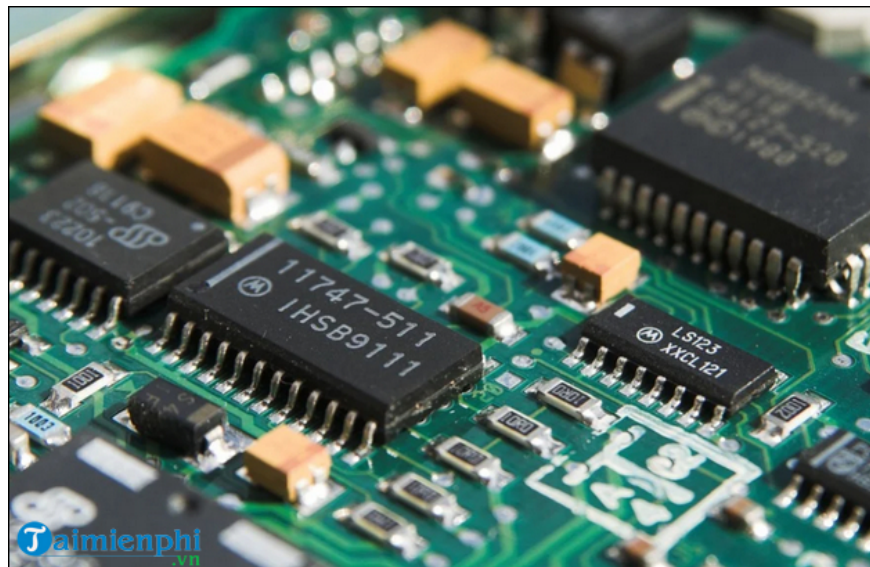
Shuttle motherboards: Press and hold the DEL key or the Ctrl + Alt + Esc key combination during computer startup to access the BIOS. For

Soyo motherboards: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

For Super Micro motherboards: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

For TYAN motherboards: Press either the F4 or DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.

For XFX motherboards: Press and hold the DEL key during computer startup to access the BIOS.



Adjusting BIOS settings will also help speed up your device.

A few other laptop models have different access methods than the shortcuts above. You can try the following shortcuts to access the BIOS: the F2 to F12 keys, or the Esc key, or the Del (Delete) key.
