We access `chrome://flags`, then find the `Android pinned tabs` flag to activate it and restart the browser.

Immediately after, the tab pinning option on Chrome Android is enabled for you to use. To pin a tab to the top, press and hold the tab and **select "Tag"** from the menu that appears. Unpinning a tab is done similarly with the "Unpin tab" option.
