When adding background colors to portrait photos and products in Photoshop, there are many different techniques for you to cut an object out of their background. Depending on the image you perform various techniques, including:

If the subject is photographed on a simple background, you should use the Magic Wand - a tool to create a selection based on the tone and color of pixel pixels, to save time.

If the subject is photographed on a complex background, you should use the Pen tool, Selection Tool to create precise selections that cover the selected object.
