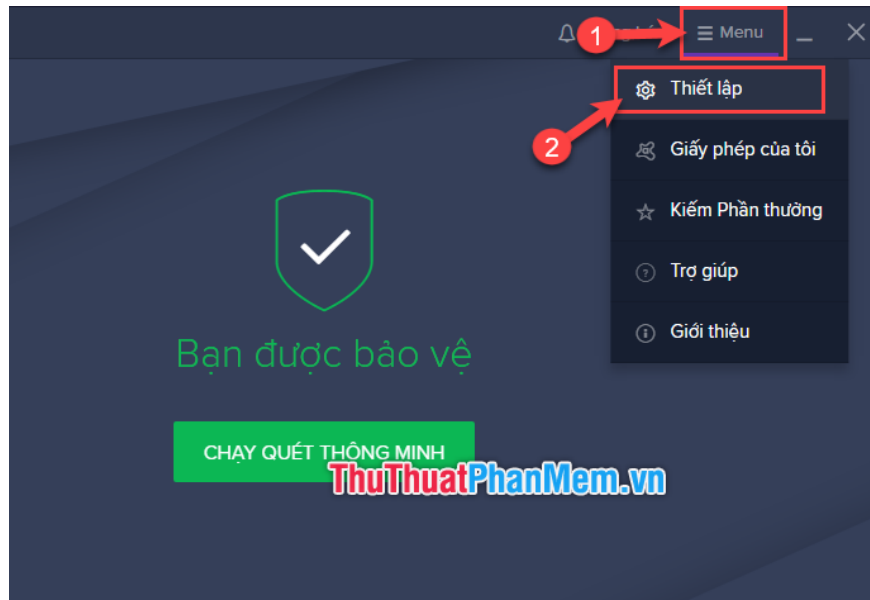

**Step 1** : You open antivirus software *Avast* .

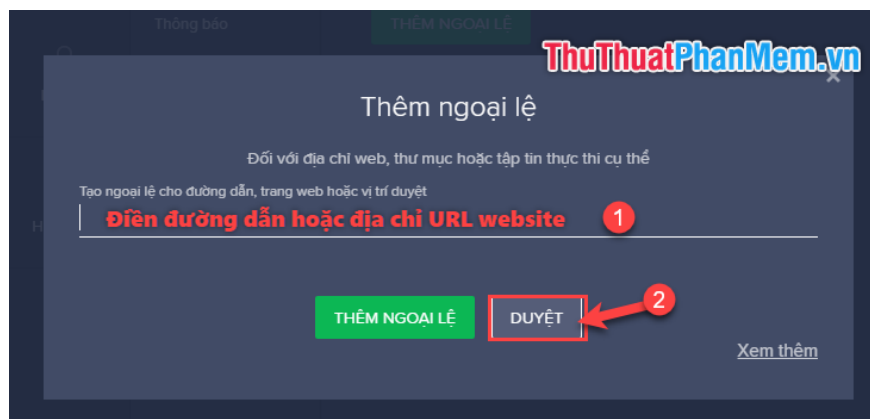
**Step 2** : Then you press *Menu (1)* in the right corner of the software interface -> Select *Settings (2)* .



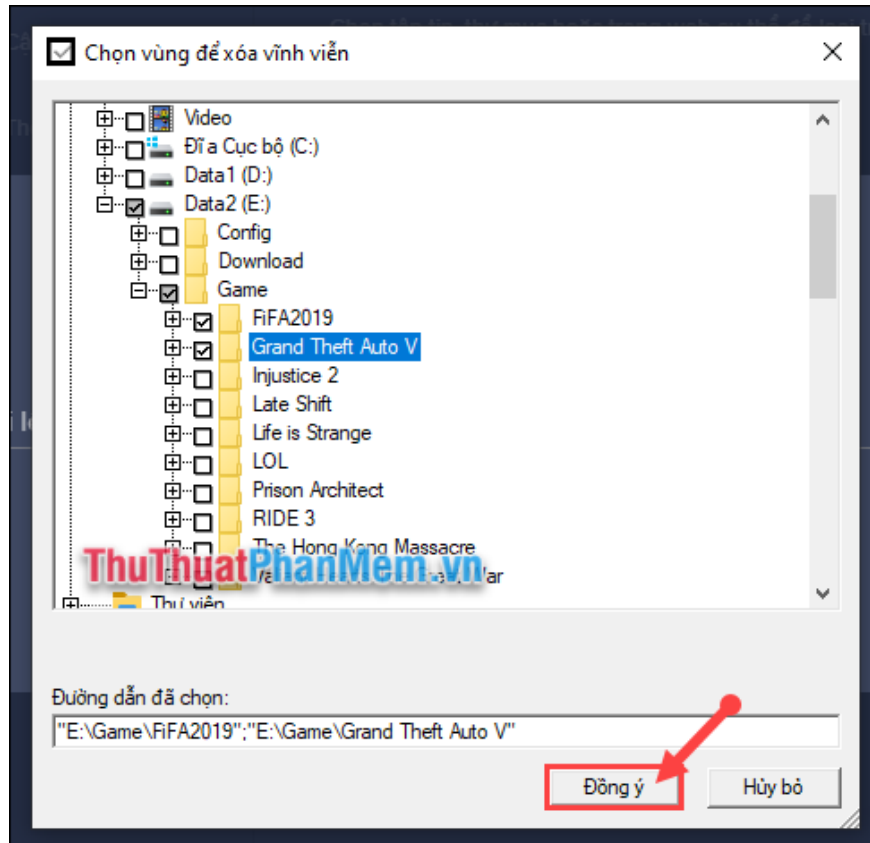
**Step 3** : Then you take turns: Select *General* (1) -> *Exceptions* (2) -> *Add exceptions* (3) .



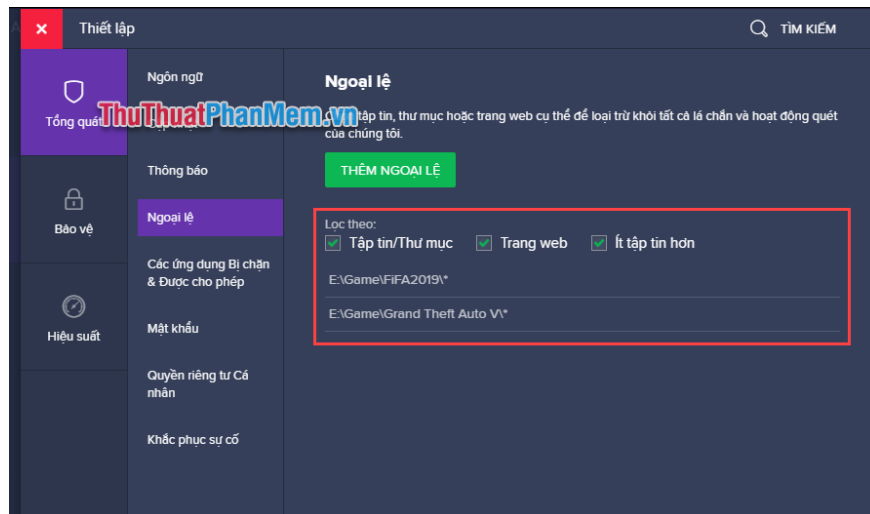
**Step 4**: Then you can Copy the path of the protected directory or website address and Paste into box (1) .



Or choose **Browse** (2) and then locate the folder, the file you want to exclude and select Avast **Agreed** .



Then the Exceptions file will be displayed all outside.
