

How to add more customizations to Quick Settings on Android

From Android 7.0 Nougat version to Android 8.0 Oreo, users can intervene in the Quick Settings area to add more options for the device.

Starting with Android 7.0 Nougat up to Android 8.0 Oreo, users have been able to interfere more deeply into the Quick Settings system, but only stop at some familiar features. If so, you can install the Nougat / Oreo Quick Settings application to add more options like screen capture, volume control, screen lock .

Quick Settings is where we can quickly access system settings, by swiping twice from the top edge. Normally you can only add, or edit basic settings like mobile network, WiFi, airplane mode, flash . only. However, when installing additional Nougat / Oreo Quick Settings, we can add some customizations such as volume, screen capture, screen lock, .

The following article will guide you how to use Nougat / Oreo Quick Settings, add more customizations in Quick Settings from Android 7.0 and above.

How to use Nougat / Oreo Quick Settings on Android

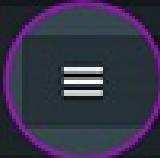
1. Download Nougat / Oreo Quick Settings

Step 1:

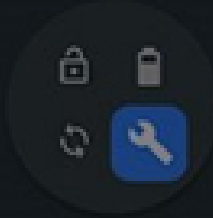
First download the Nougat / Oreo Quick Settings application according to the link above and then start the application. In the main interface of the application, we click on **the 3 dash icon** and select **List all** .

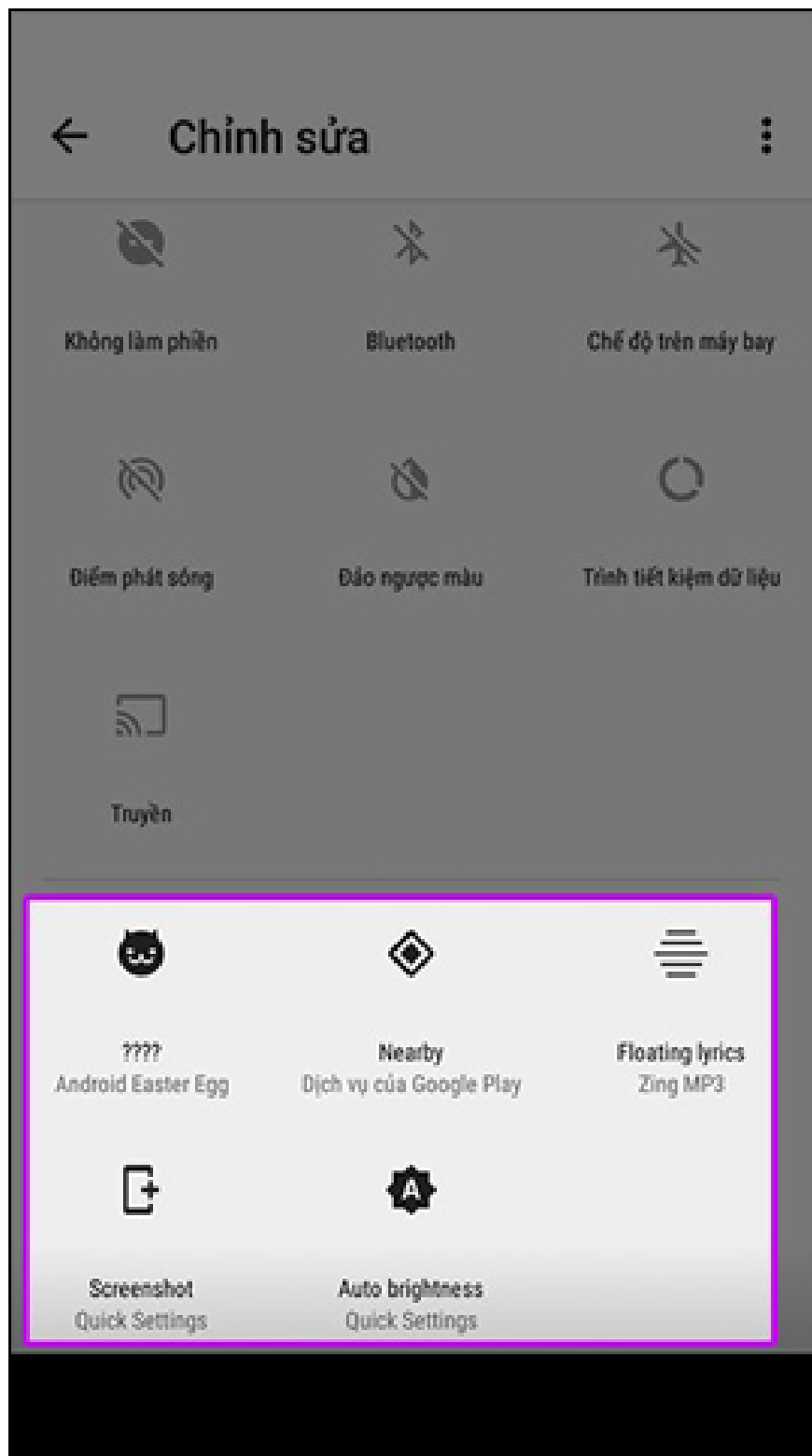


Step 3:

Click on the custom user wants to add. Next go back to the main interface on the screen. To bring selected features to the screen, open the Quick Settings interface and click **the pen icon** . Appearance Edit interface. You

just need to drag the added features from the Nougat / Oreo Quick Settings application to bring it into Quick Settings.
