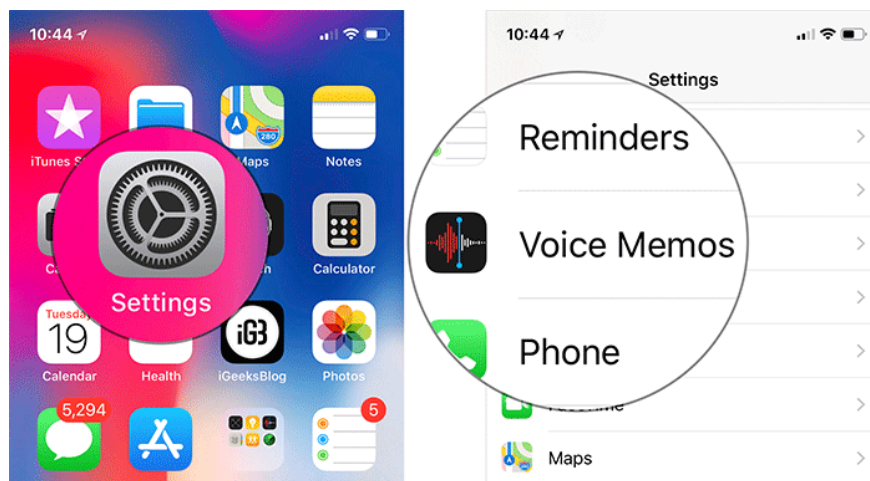

If you often find it difficult to handle recordings, you will really love this feature. iOS offers you two options are AAC and Uncompressed. And depending on your needs, you can switch between them.

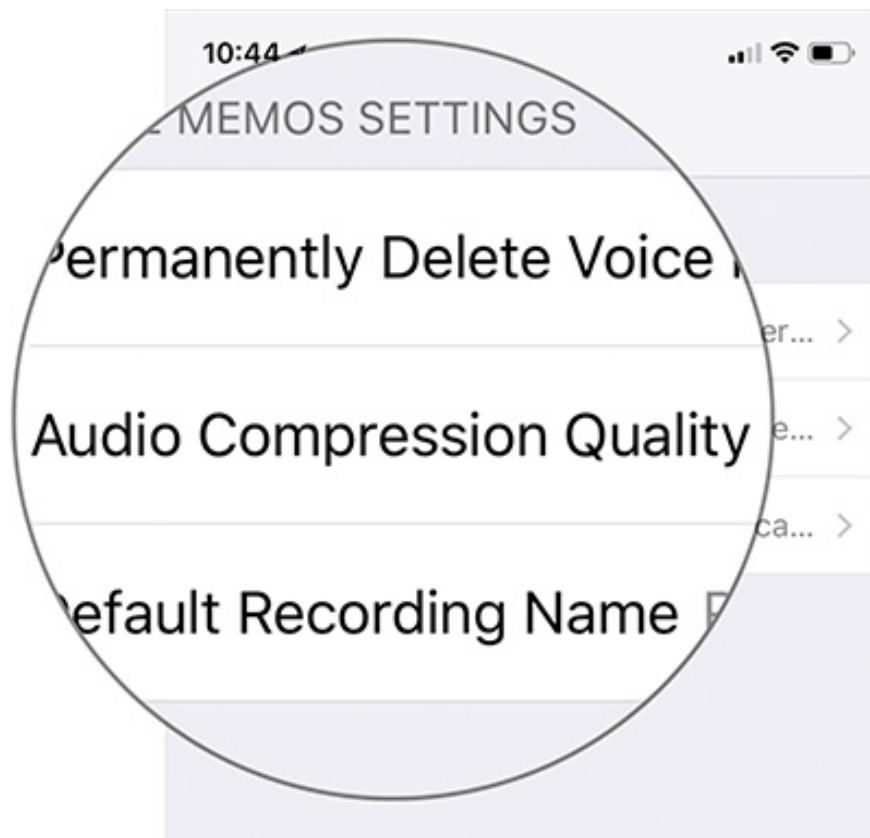
How to adjust the quality of Voice Memos recording files in iOS 12 on iPhone / iPad

Step 1. Go to Settings on iPhone, iPad.

Step 2. Now, scroll down and click **Voice Memos** .

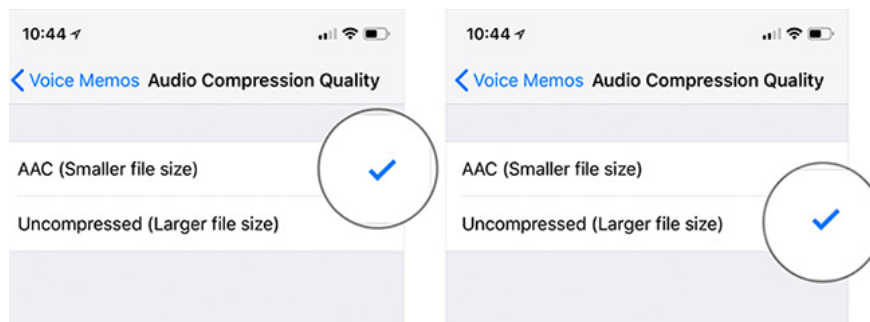


Step 3. Next, click **Audio Compression Quality** .



Step 4. Here you will have two options.

1. AAC: Select it if you want a small file size.
2. Uncompressed: Select it if you want to keep the file size large and can't be changed.
