

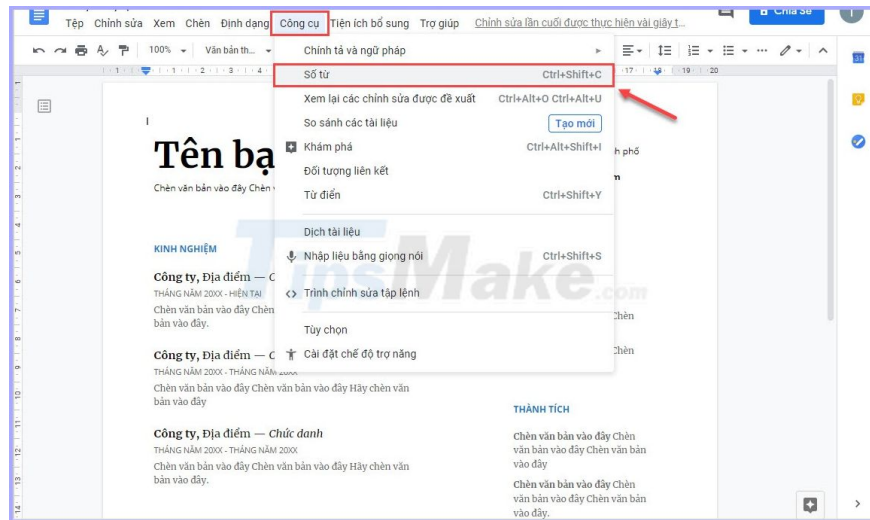
How to always show the number of words while typing in Google Docs

When we work on Google Docs, the number of words is very important because they help us to control the amount and number of words in an article. However, when we use Google Docs with the default settings, we will not be able to see the number of words on the display interface.

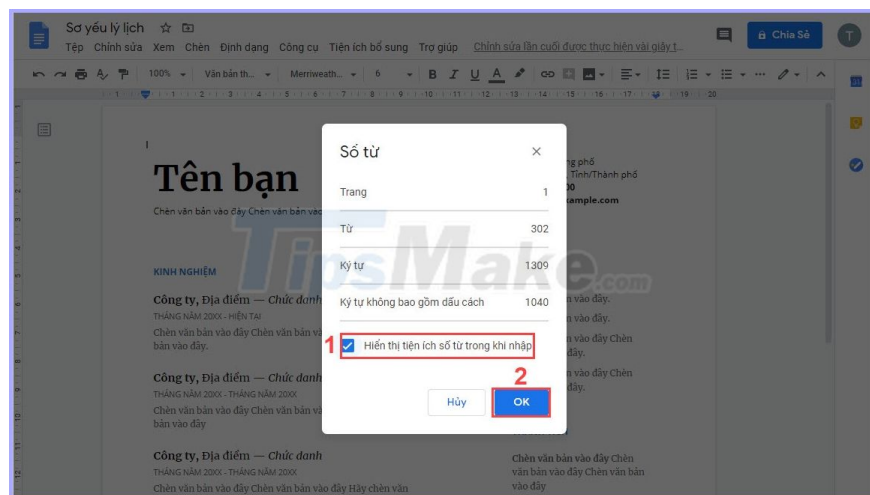
The problem with word count is that Google Docs has pressed it and you need to reactivate. In this article, Software Tips will guide you how to always display number of words as you type in Google Docs.



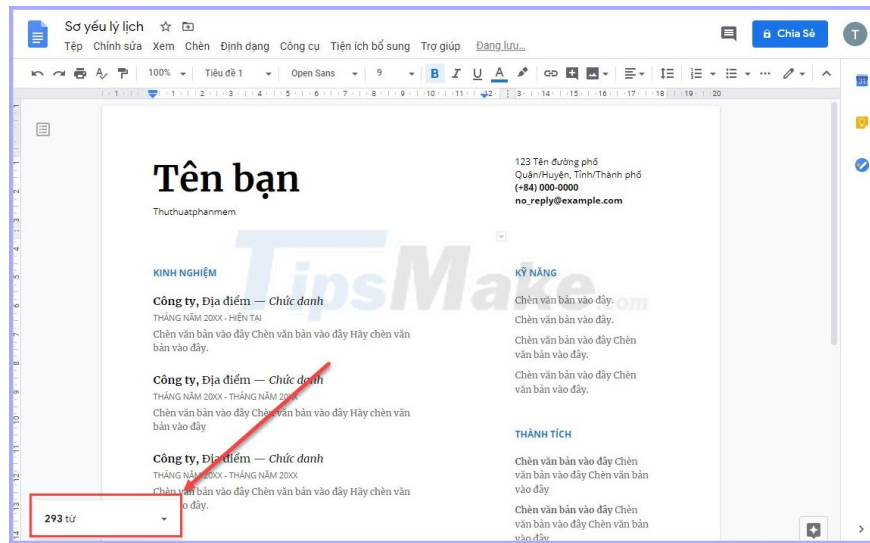
Step 1: First, you proceed to open the document with Google Docs. Next, you select **Tools (Tools)** and select **Word (Word count)** or pressing **Ctrl + Shift + C** .



Step 2: When the **Word count** window appears, tick the **"Display word count while typing"** utility . When you are done setting up, select **OK** to complete the installation.



Immediately after, on the interface of Google Docs will appear word count for your control. The number of words in Google Docs is counted in real time similar to Word, so you can be assured.
