Especially when you set Safari to open all links in new tabs, users may forget which tabs they opened. Safari has a feature that automatically closes all old tabs that are open after a certain period of time, reducing the amount of space Safari uses. Here are instructions for automatically closing old tabs in Safari

How to automatically close old tabs on Safari iPhone

Step 1:


Users access the Settings application on the iPhone then tap on **the Safari application** to adjust. Switch to the browser settings interface, users tap on **the Close tabs setting** to adjust.

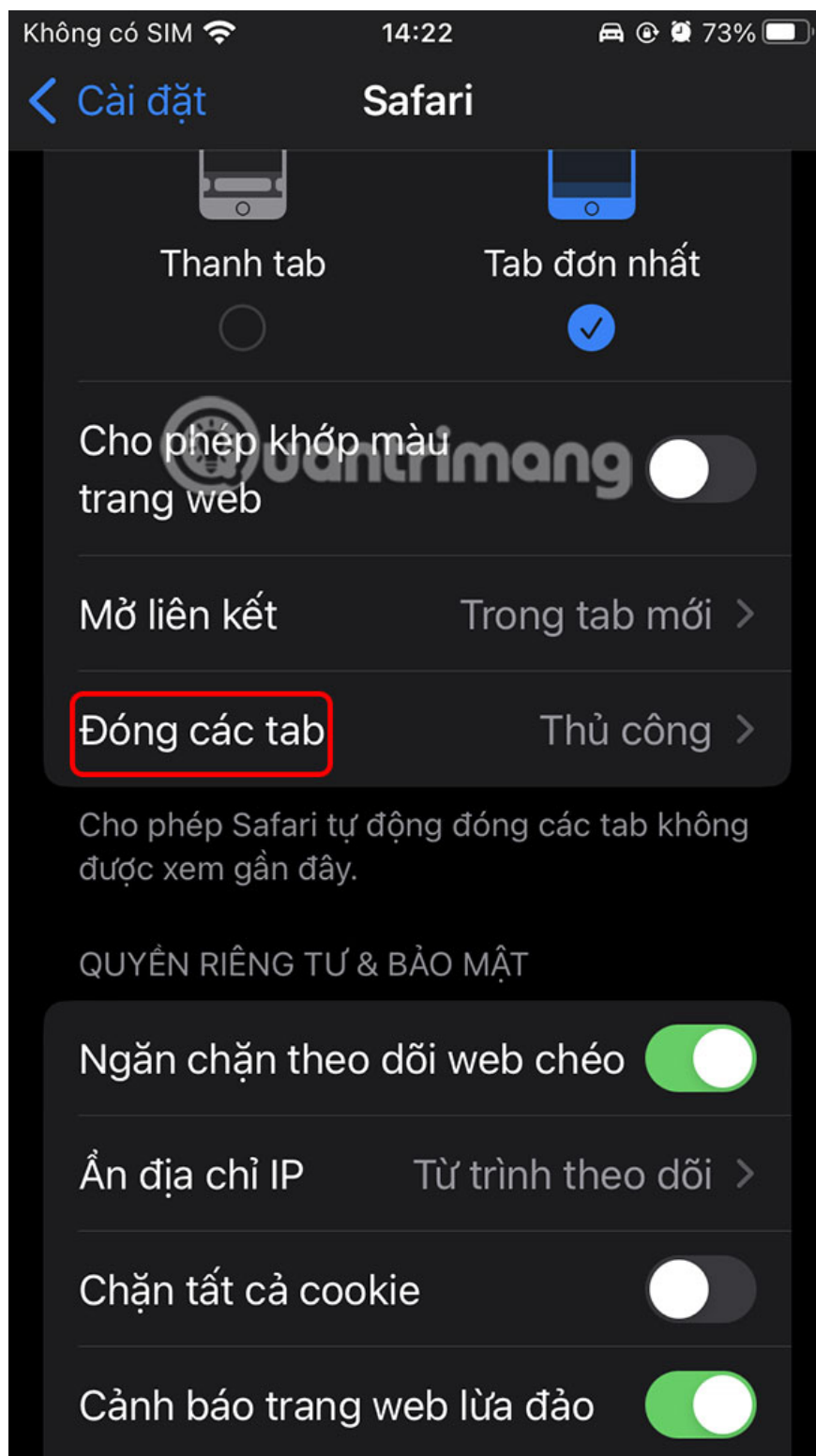

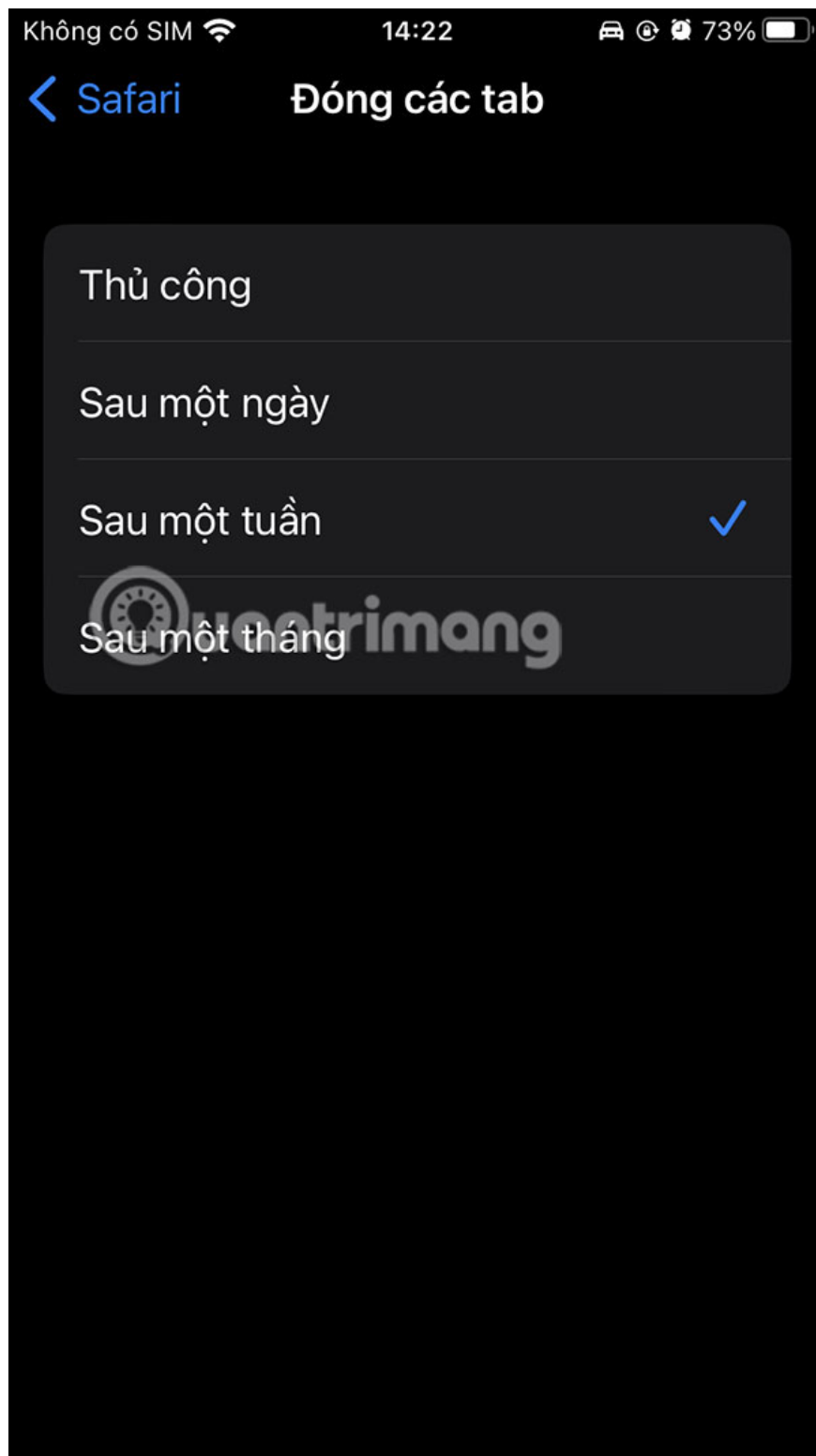

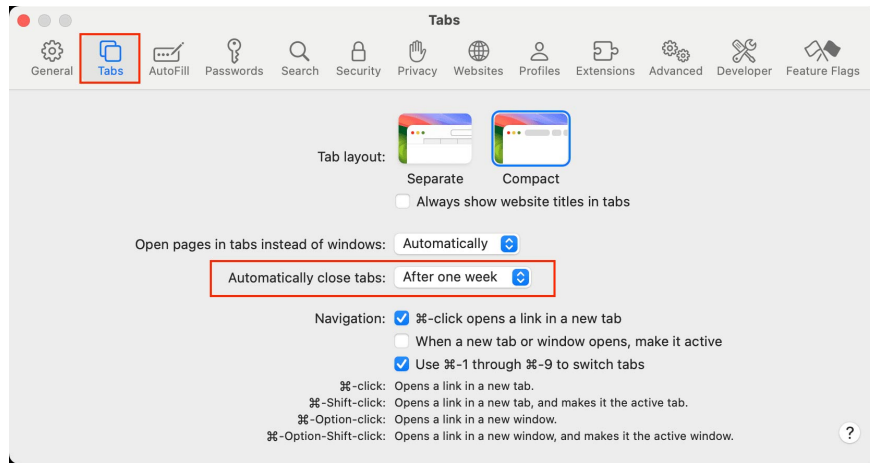
