

# How to back up automatically on Windows 10

To automatically backup Windows 10 computers, we can immediately use the Windows Backup feature available on the system to back up data.

Data backup is a necessary operation to be able to recover data, in case of computer problems. When creating a backup, all important data in the computer will be retained. And when necessary, users only need to use that backup to finish.

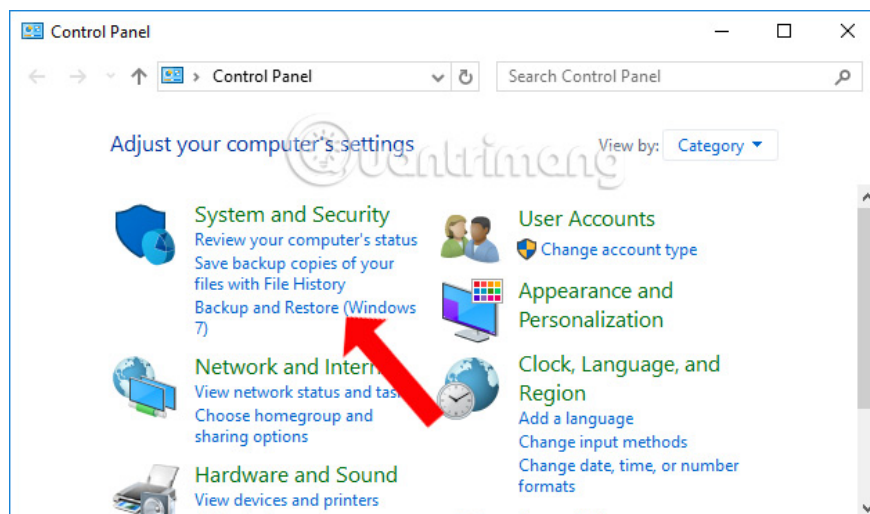
Currently there are many tools to support users to backup and restore data. For example, the File History tool to backup data is available on the computer, OneDrive backs up data on Windows 10, or System Image, . ## Instructions for scheduling backup and recovery on Windows 10

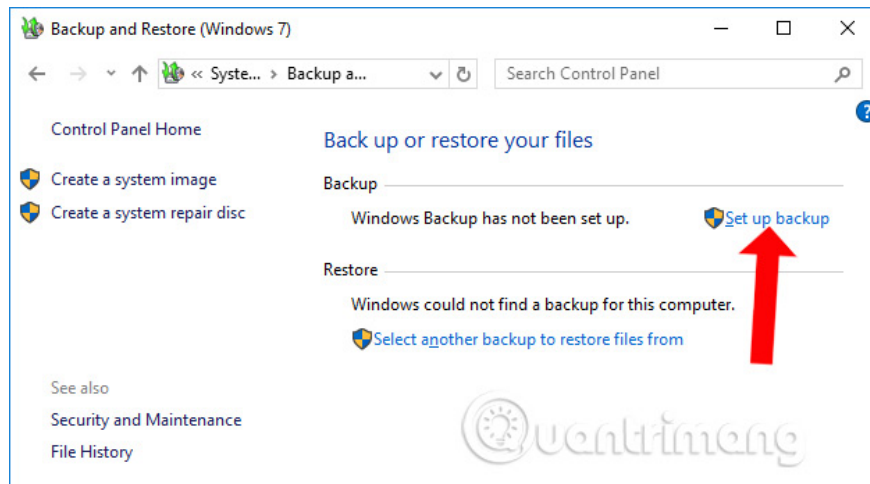
### Step 1:

First we open the Control Panel on the computer. Then, in this interface in the System and Security section, select **Backup and Restore (Windows 7)** .

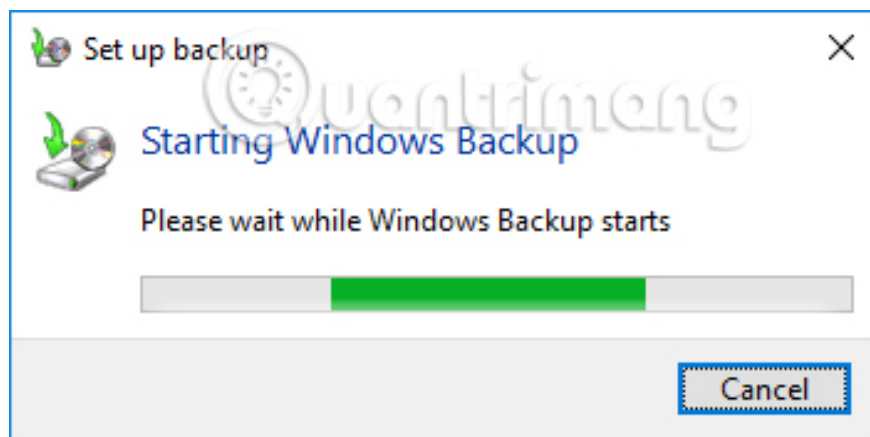


### Step 2:

Switch to the new interface and click on **Set up backup** .

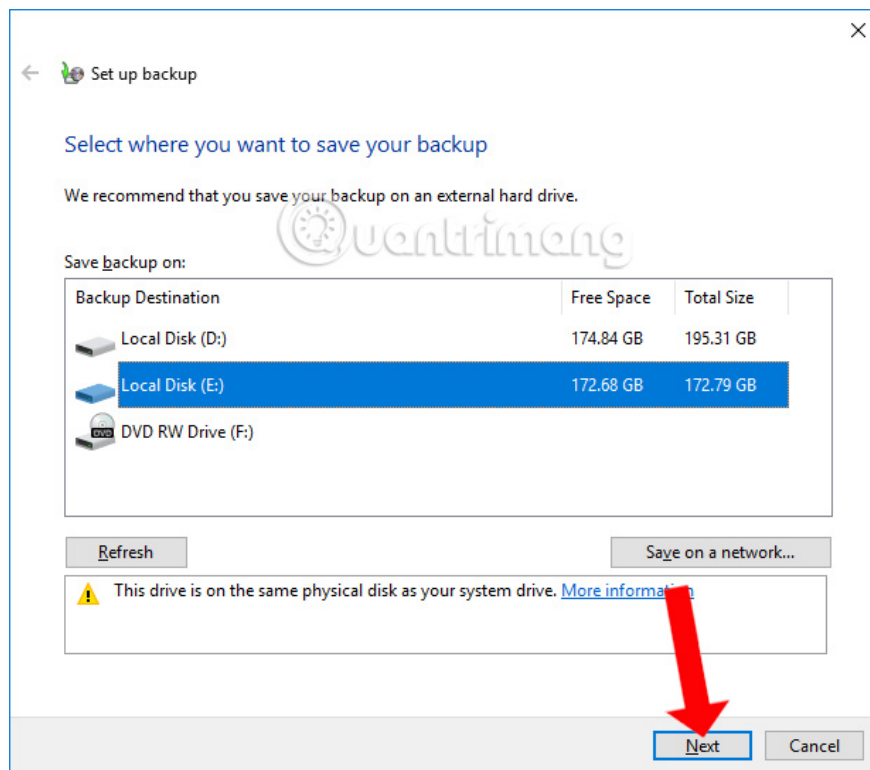


You wait for Windows Backups to work on your computer.



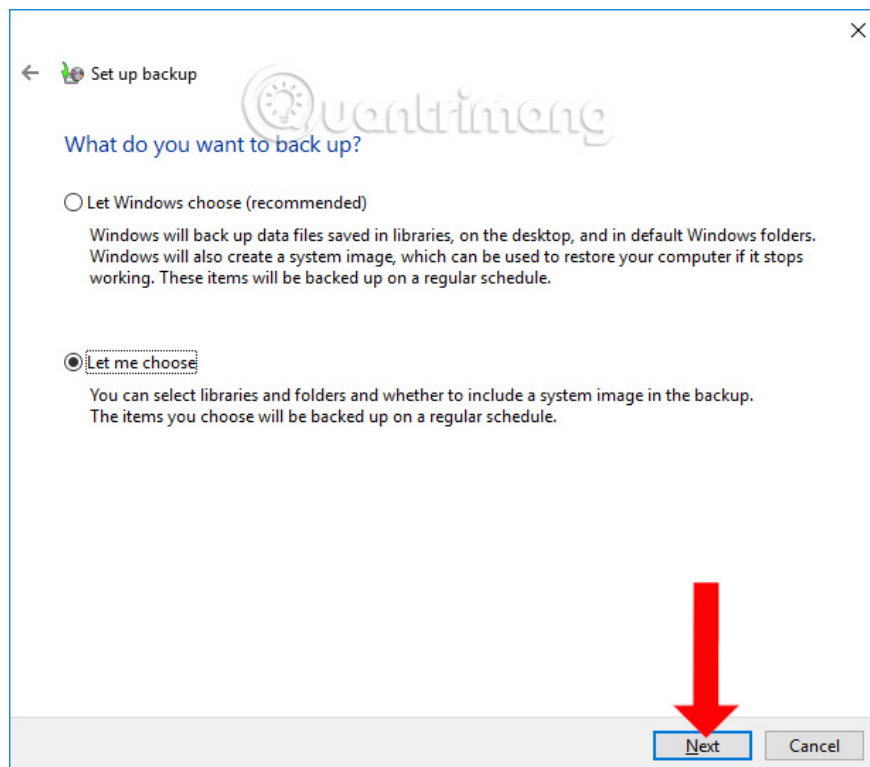
### Step 3:

The Set up backup interface appears. Here we will **select the external drive we** want to use to store the backup and then click **Next** .



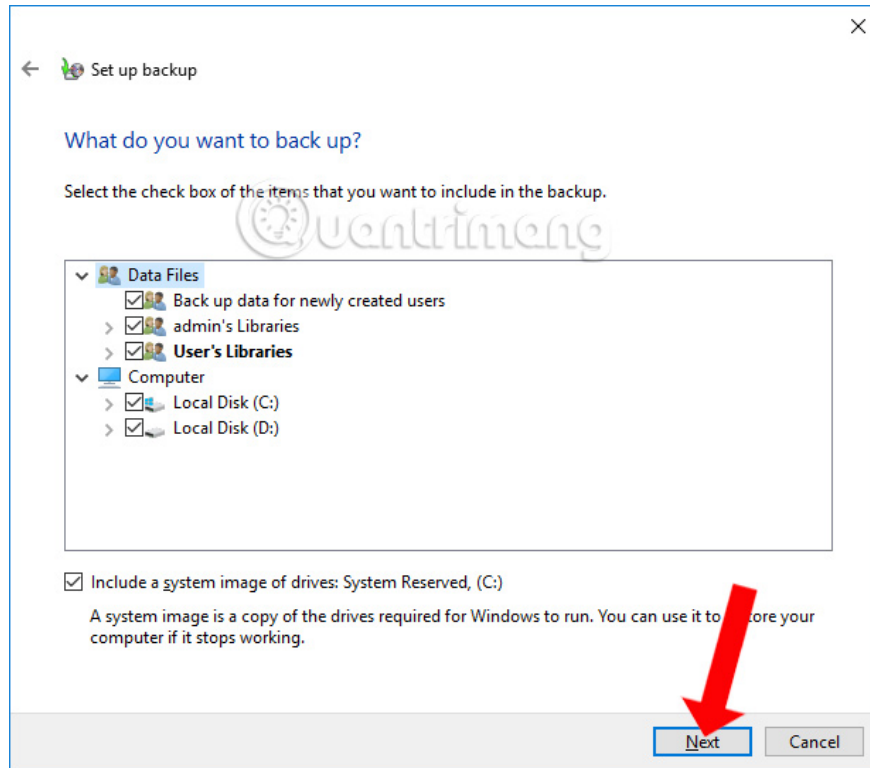
#### Step 4:

In the interface 'What do you want to backup?', Check in **Let me choose** to make sure all data is backed up according to the user.



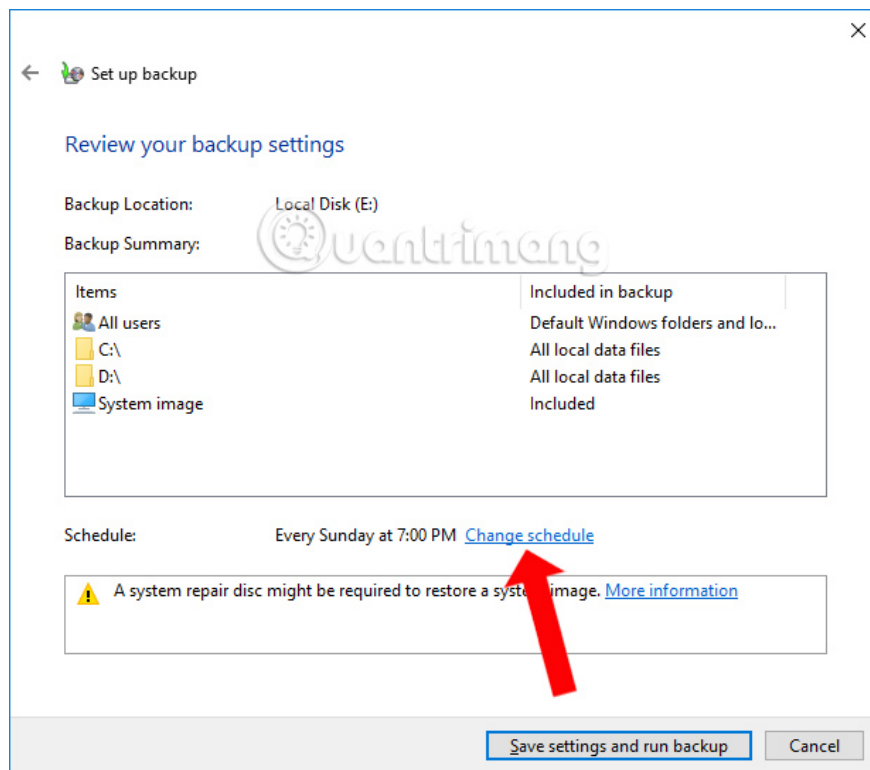
## Step 5:

Next to the user check and check the information you want to back up. You should select the full Data Files and Computer section. Click Options Include a system of drives: System Reserved, (C :) and then click **Next** .

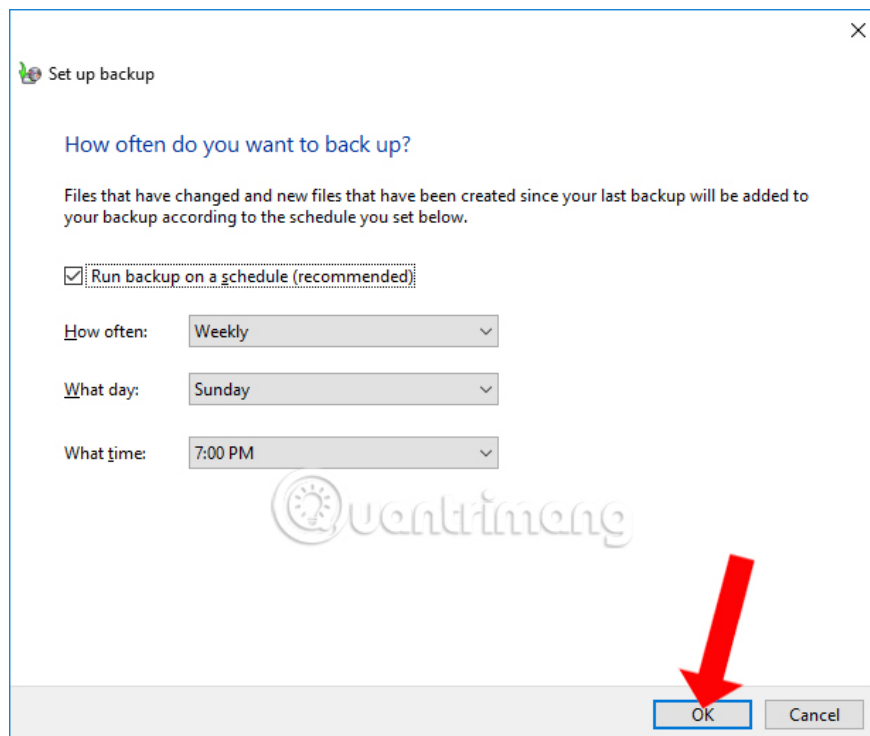


## Step 6:

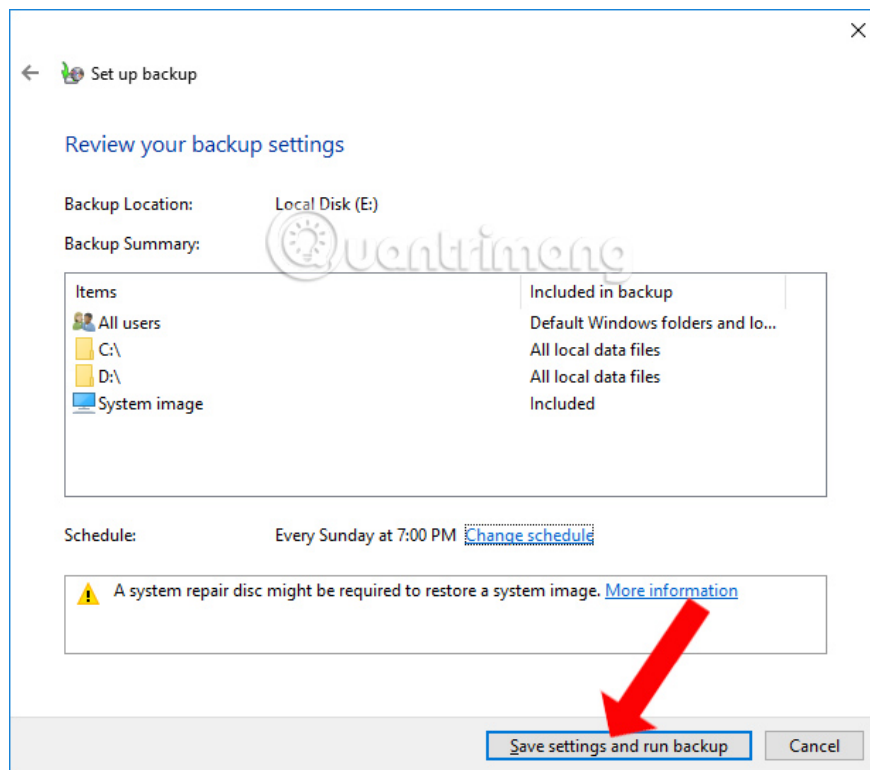
Users review all selected data backup information. Next, in the **Schedule** section, click **Change schedule** to change the time the system starts the automatic backup process.



Select the time you want to perform the backup and click **OK**.



Finally **Save settings and exit** to proceed to create backups.



After the setup is completed at that time, the system will automatically proceed to create a backup and restore of Windows 10 system, which users do not need to proceed to perform manually. This Windows Backup feature will back up the data that we have previously set up according to the selected time frame.
