

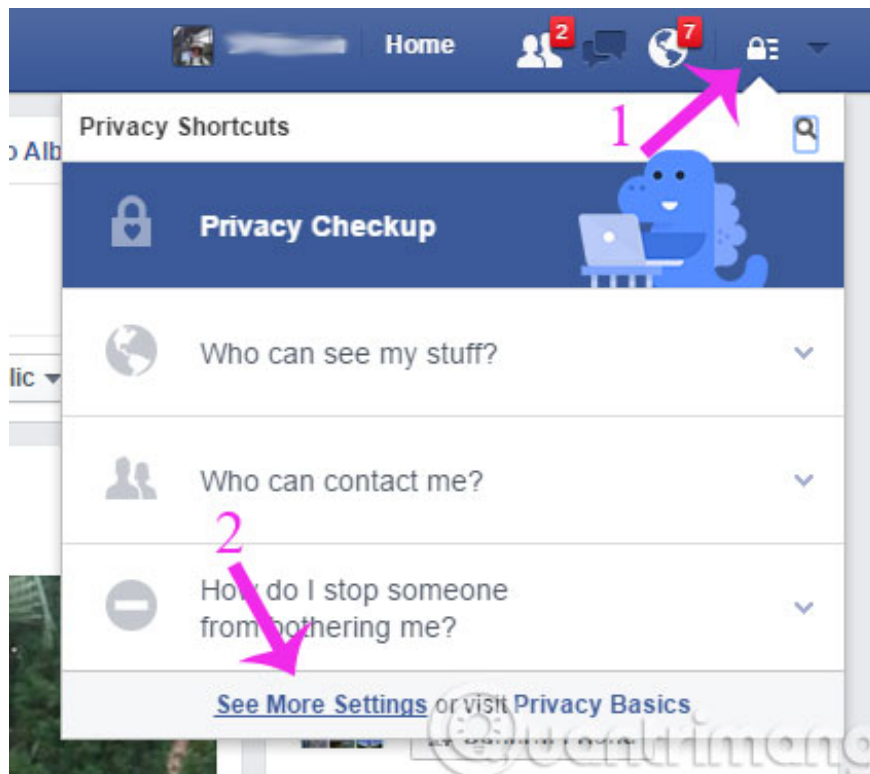
How to back up Facebook data to your computer

You may want to save personal data on Facebook to your computer before deleting your account, or simply to keep away. Facebook warns users to save data to a safe place on a computer because it contains a lot of personal information. Here's how.

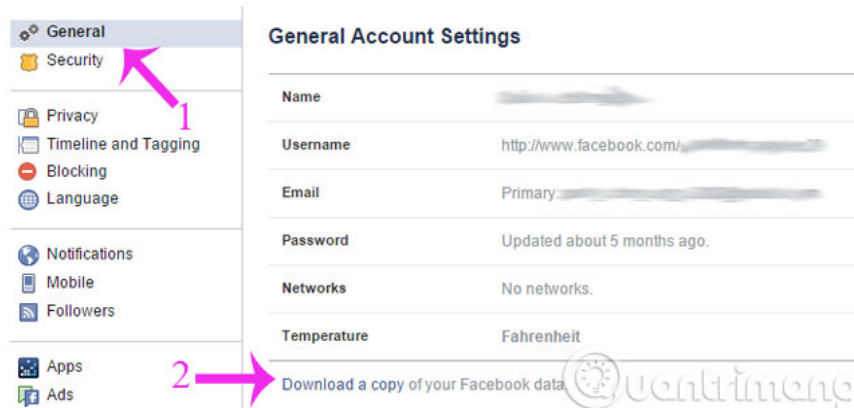
It would be bad if one day, you could not log into your Facebook account due to hacked or infected virus. So how much data including photos, videos, article links you share, archives will be lost. To avoid falling into a situation where no one wants this, it is best to back up your data to your computer after a period of use (maybe weekly or monthly depending on your usage level).

If you do not know how to back up, you can follow the step instructions below of TipsMake.com.

Step 1 : From the main interface of **Facebook** , click on the **lock** icon on the upper right corner and select **See More Settings**



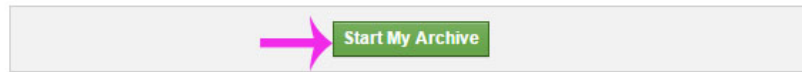
Step 2 : In the **Settings** page, select the **General** menu in the left column and click **Download a copy your Facebook data** .



Step 3 : At this time, the interface will appear information that you will download, click **Start My Archive**

Get a copy of what you've shared on Facebook.

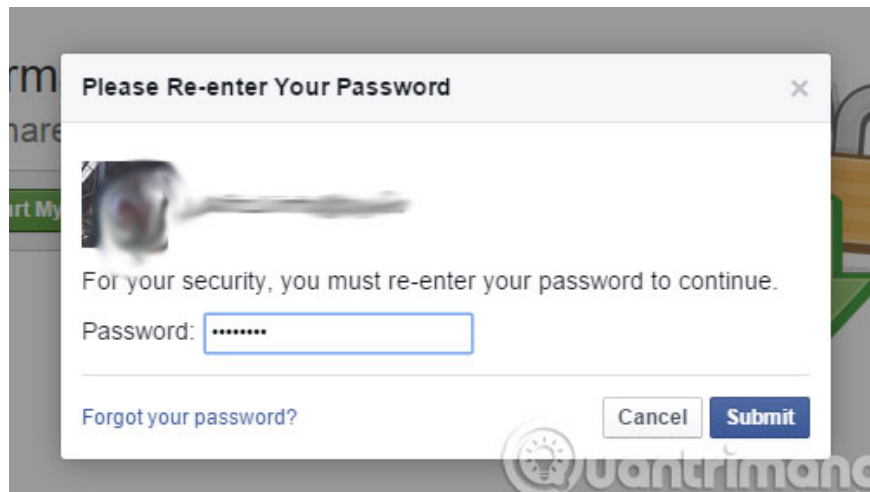


What's included?

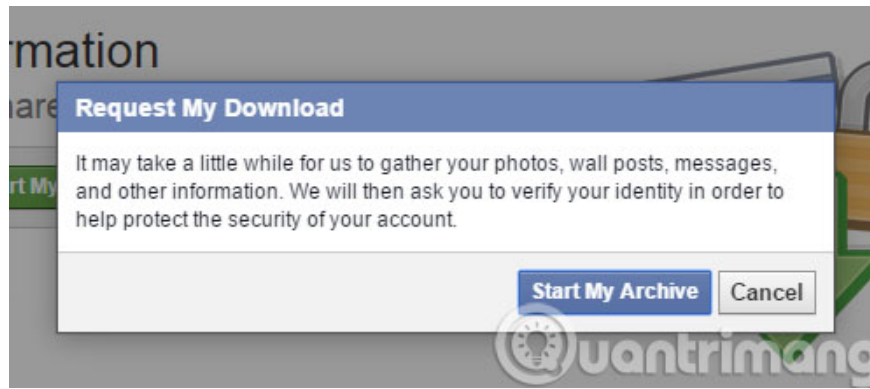
- Posts, photos and videos you've shared

Step 4 : Enter your account password and click **Submit**



Step 5 : Please confirm again

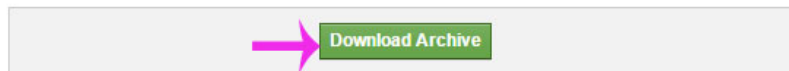


Step 6 : Finally, just click **Download Archive** and wait for a few minutes to download the data to your computer as a **Zip** file

Get a copy of what you've shared on Facebook.

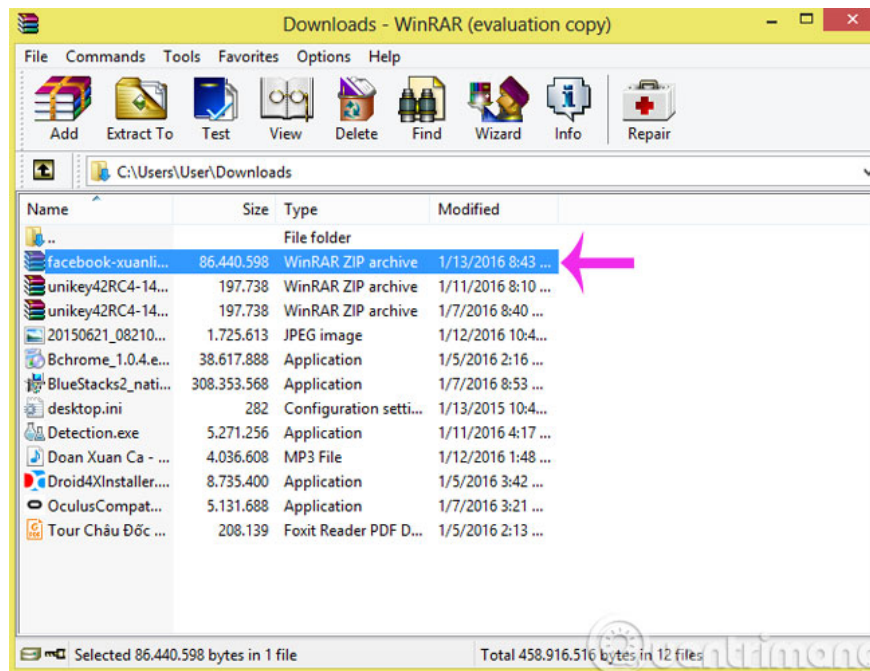
This is a copy of personal information you've shared on Facebook. To protect your info, we'll ask you to re-enter your password to confirm that this is your account.



Caution: Protect your archive

Your Facebook archive includes sensitive info like your private Wall posts, photos and profile information. Please keep this in mind before storing or sending your archive.

So with just a few simple steps above, you have backed up your Facebook account data to your computer already.
