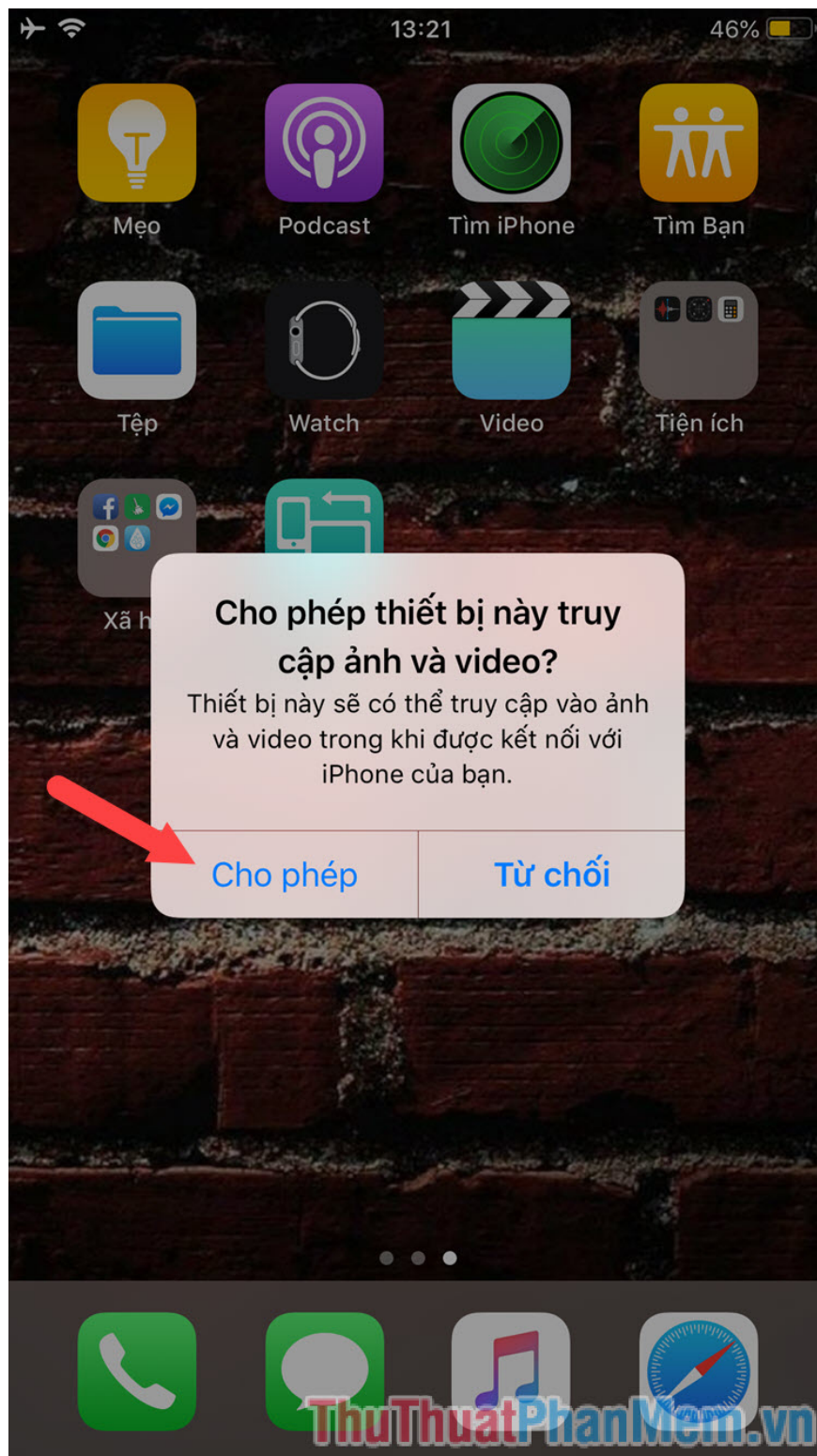

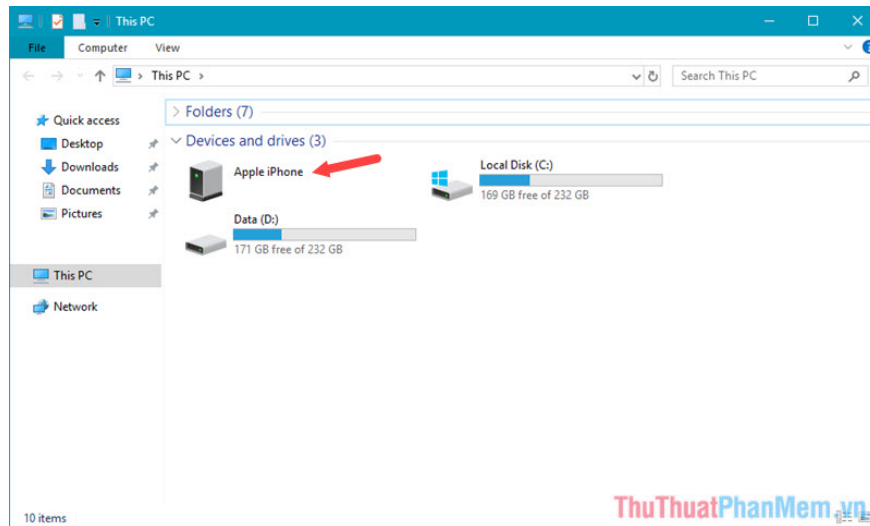


Backing up photos on iPhone seems difficult but really very easy, follow the instructions below!

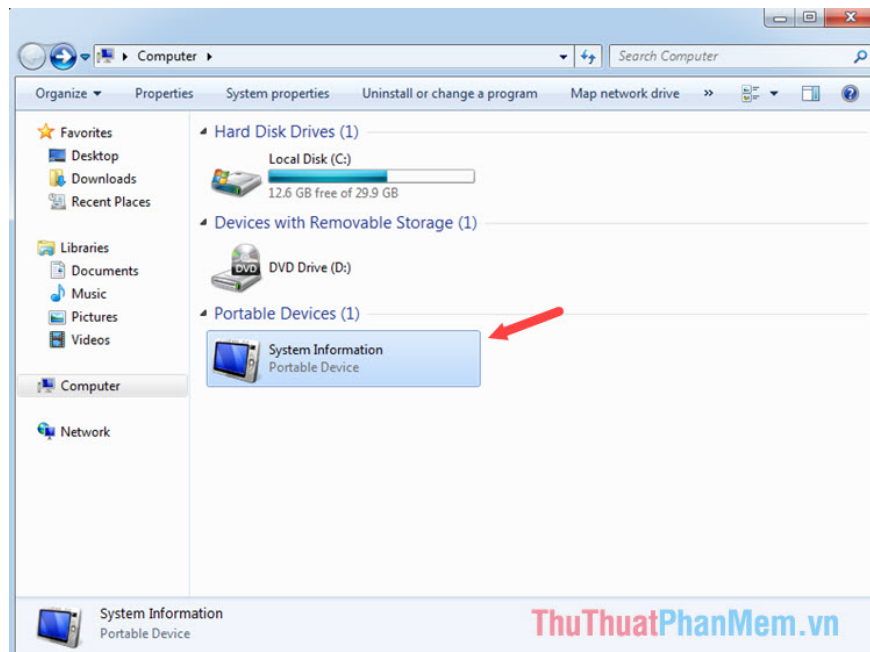
Step 1: You connect the iPhone to the computer. On the iPhone will display a message to allow the device to access photo albums, you click **Allow** to grant access.



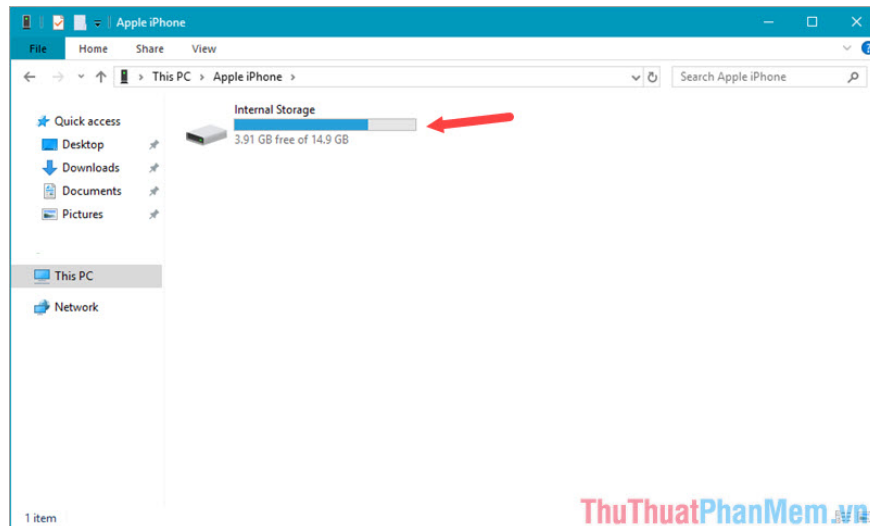
Step 2: Open My Computer and find the Apple iPhone icon (with Win 10)



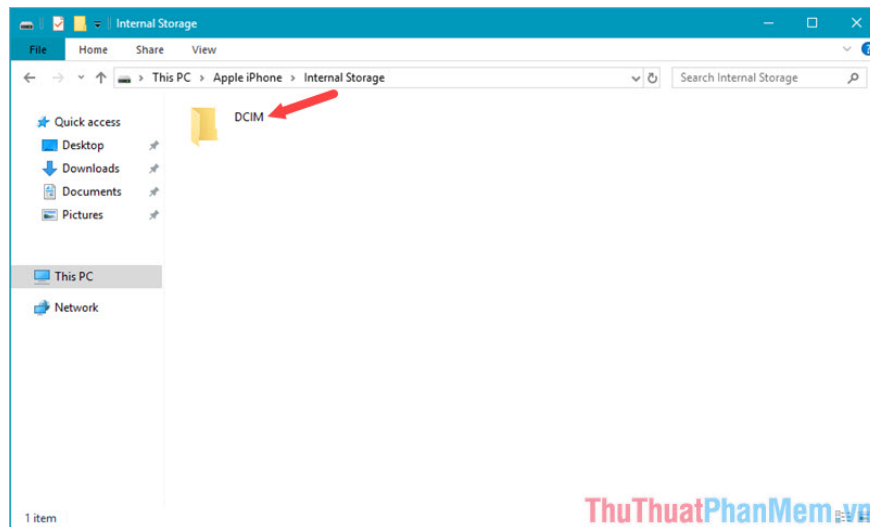
Or the device name with the Portable Device icon (Win 7)



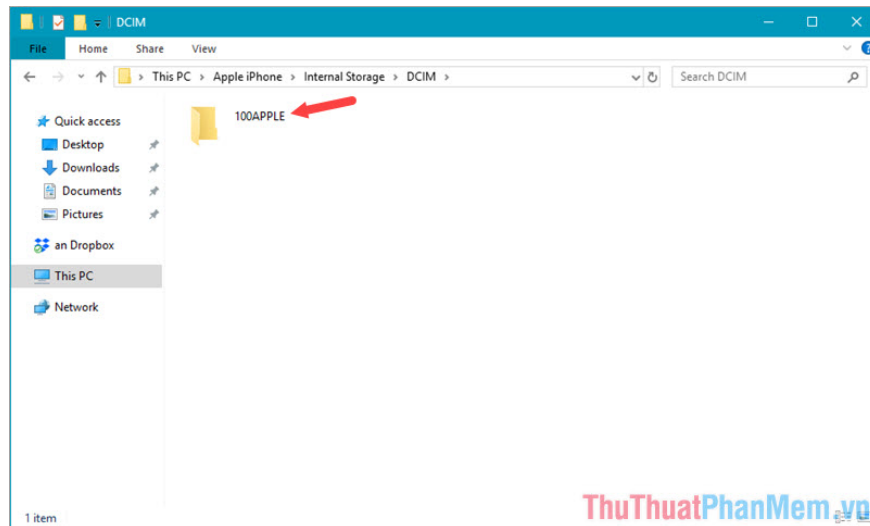
Step 3: Here displays the iPhone's memory, you click on the **Internal Storage** drive .



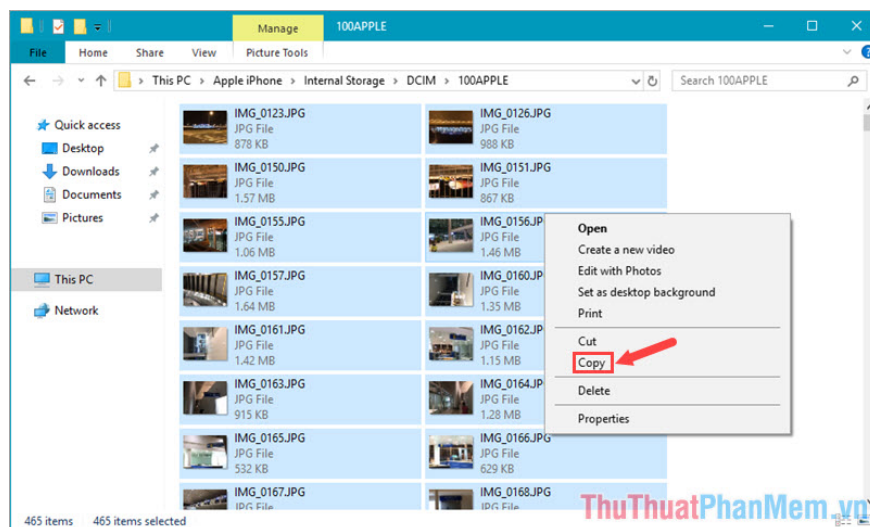
Step 4: Click on the **DCIM** folder .
