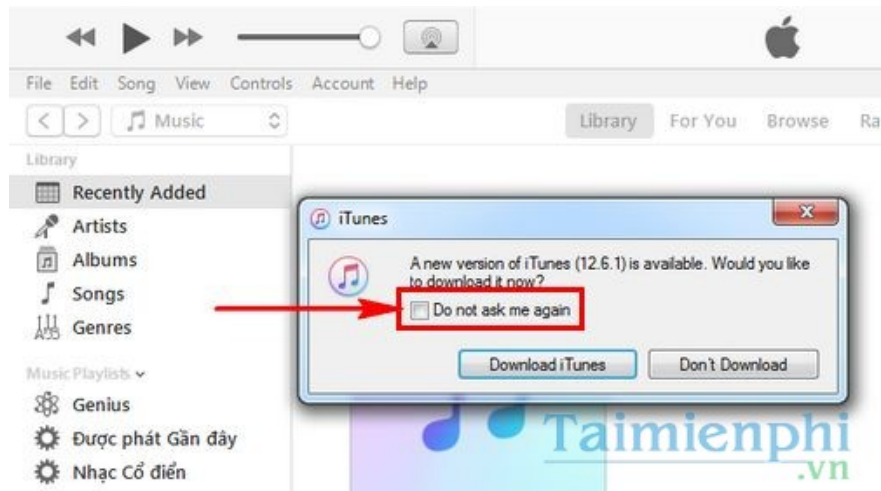

How to block iTunes from asking for updates:

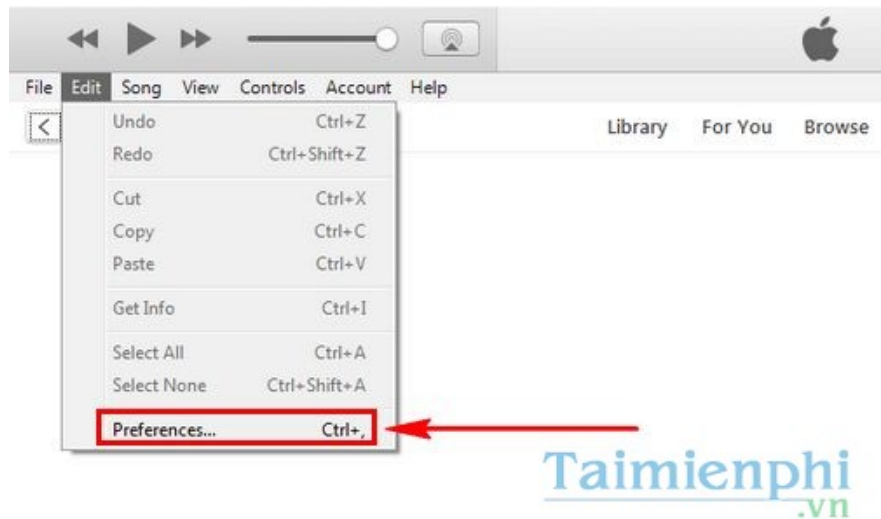
Method 1: Block iTunes from asking for updates by clicking "Do not ask me again."

Every time you open iTunes, if the version is outdated, the software will often ask if you want to update. There are two options: **Download iTunes** to accept the download or **Don't Download** to avoid downloading. Having to click Don't Download every time is really annoying. Therefore, check the box next to "**Do not ask me again**" to prevent this message from appearing again.

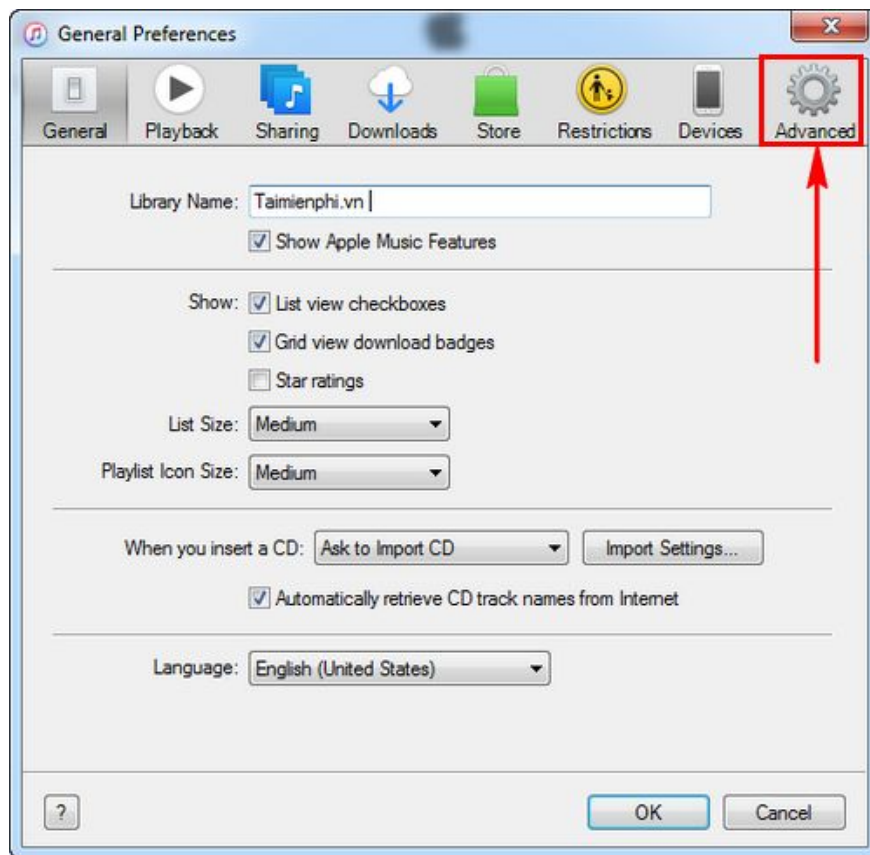


Method 2: Block iTunes from asking for updates in Settings.

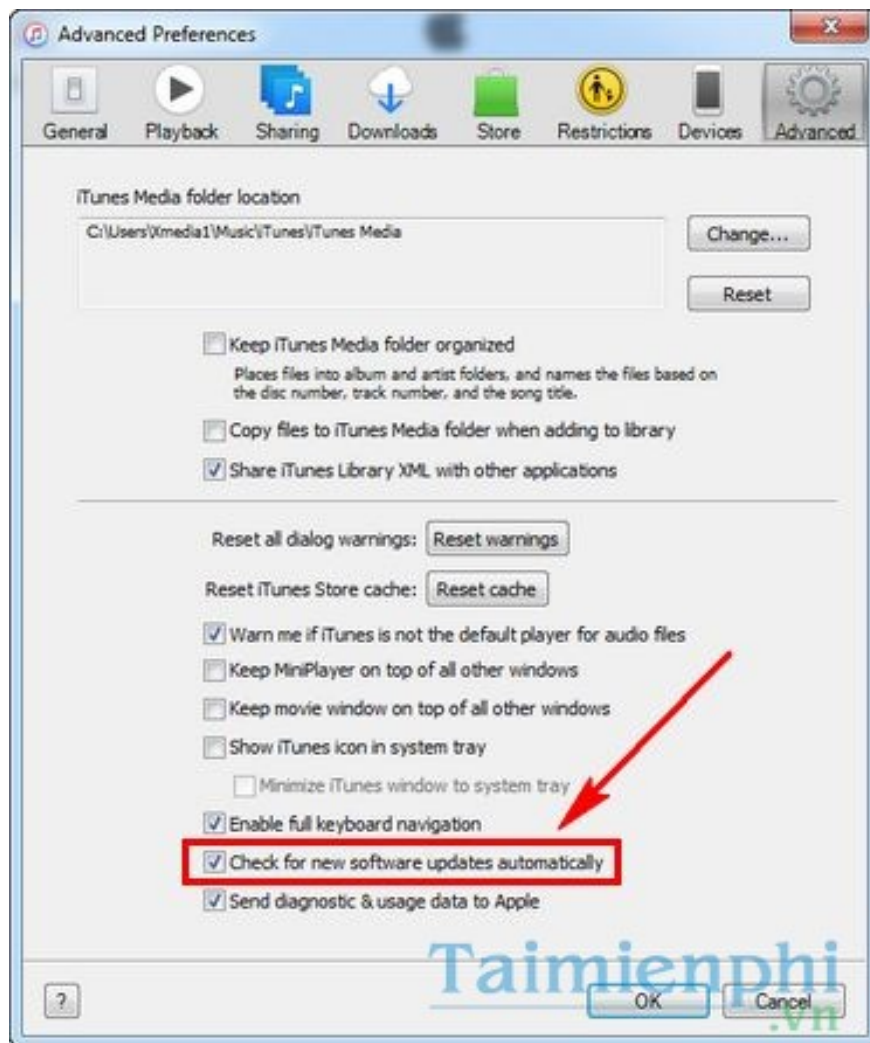
Step 1: To completely block iTunes from asking for updates, users need to click **Edit**. Select **Preferences** or press the Ctrl + key combination .



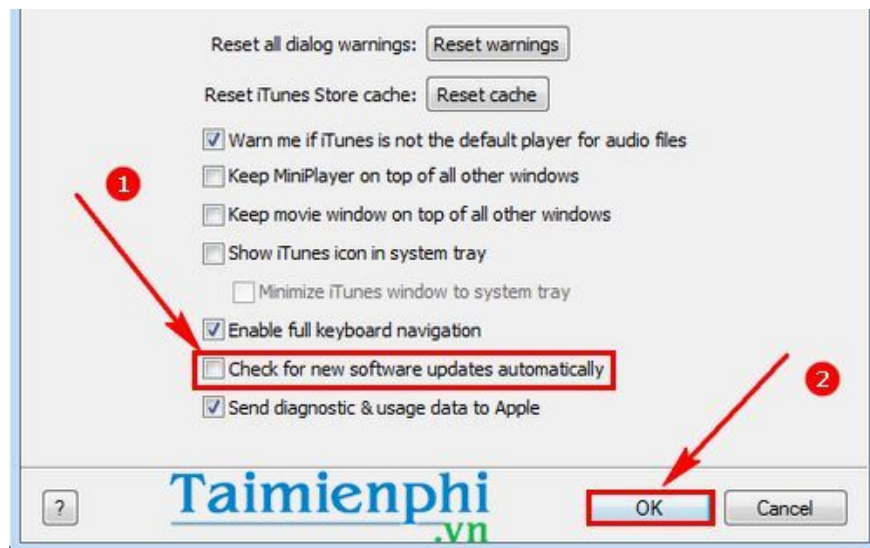
Step 2: In the **General Preferences** dialog box , the user needs to switch to the **Advanced** tab .



Step 3: Notice the checkmark "**Check for new software updates automatically**" and uncheck it.



After unchecking the box, simply press **OK** to save.



Above are two ways to block iTunes from asking for updates, preventing it from prompting you to update, which users can apply immediately. After implementing these methods, you will no longer be bothered by iTunes requesting updates.
