

How to block phone numbers or messages on Galaxy S9 / S9 +

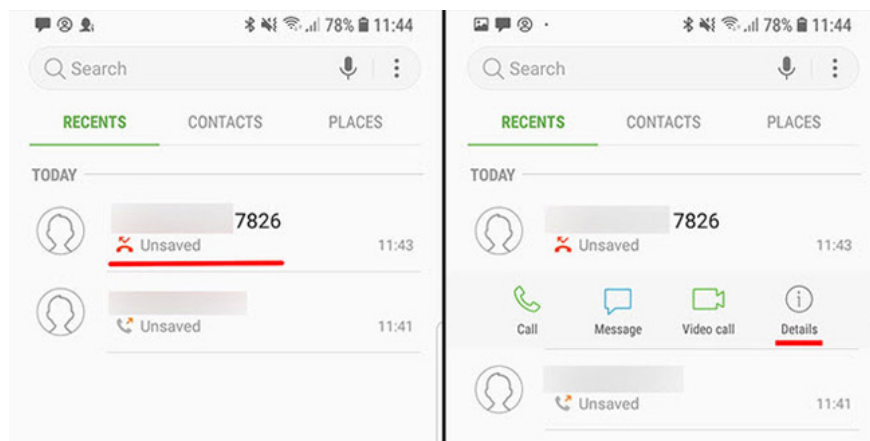

Method 1: Block the phone number from the call log

If you do not want to receive calls or messages from a certain phone number, you can block that phone number. When this number tries to call you, your phone will automatically reject the call.

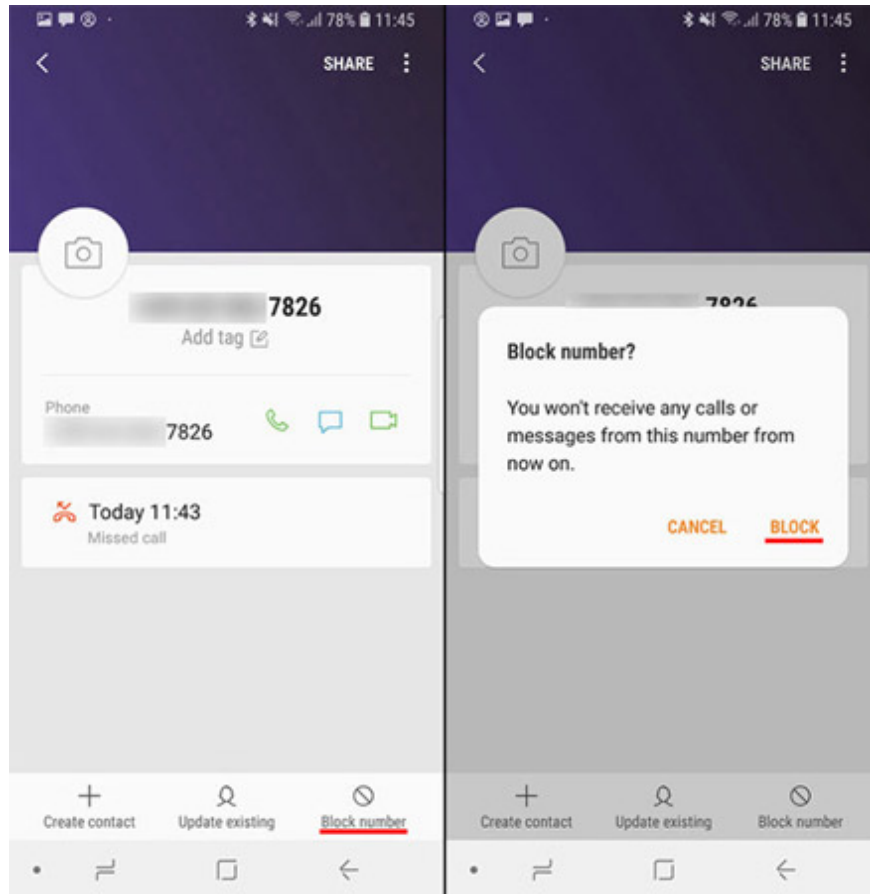
Step 1:

Open the phone application on the device and scroll to the Call log icon - which stores all incoming and outgoing calls. Here, click on the phone number you want to block and click *Details* in the menu that appears right below.



Step 2:

A new window will appear showing that you are on the contact details page, now click the *Block number* button in the bottom right corner of the screen. Continue, click *Block* , the phone number will no longer be able to contact you, including calls and text messages.

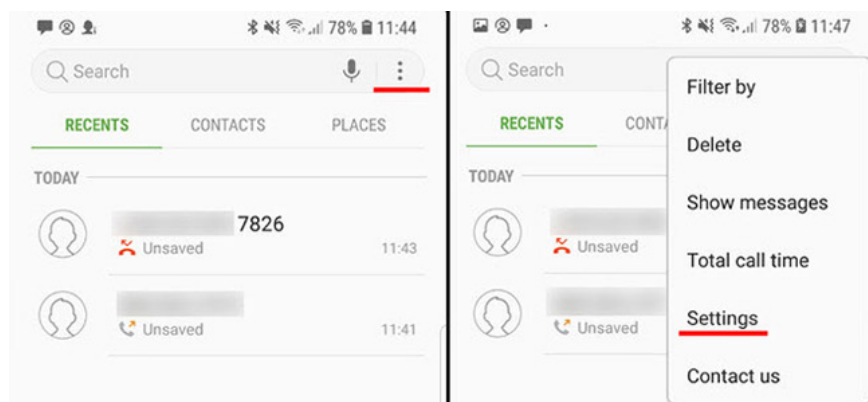


Method 2: Block phone numbers by manually entering

If the number wants to block you from calling or texting, you can apply this second method to deal with it before blocking it through the built-in blacklist.

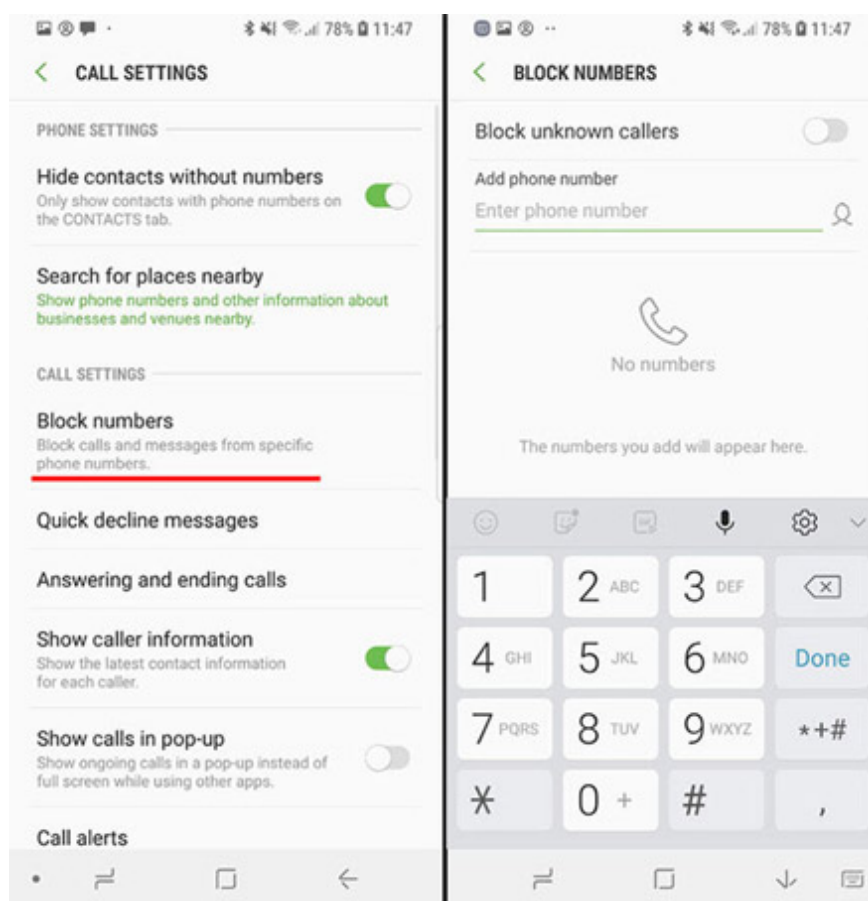
Step 1:

To block this phone number manually, go back to the phone application and go to the internal menu by tapping the 3 dots icon in the upper right corner.



Step 2:

In the menu that appears, search for the *Block numbers* section in the *Call settings* section . Click it and enter any phone number you want to block on Galaxy S9 / S9 +. Here you can also unblock the phone number that you blocked at the beginning of the tutorial.



In addition, you can also block phone numbers that are not on your contact list, but this is not recommended because you may miss many important phone calls. Normally, we should only block phone numbers that we can identify and can do that are not in the directory.
