

How to bring Windows 10 Timeline to Chrome, Firefox

We can bring Windows 10 Timeline feature to Chrome, Firefox via Windows Timeline Support utility. Websites that are open in Chrome or Firefox will appear on the Timeline.

The Timeline feature on Windows 10 allows users to quickly open web pages on Microsoft Edge or other operations performed. And users can use the Timeline feature on Chrome, Firefox via the Windows Timeline Support utility.

The utility will sync browser browsing history to the Timeline on Windows 10, reopening web pages quickly. In particular we can view webpages that are open at other devices via Microsoft account. See how to bring Timeline to Chrome and Firefox.

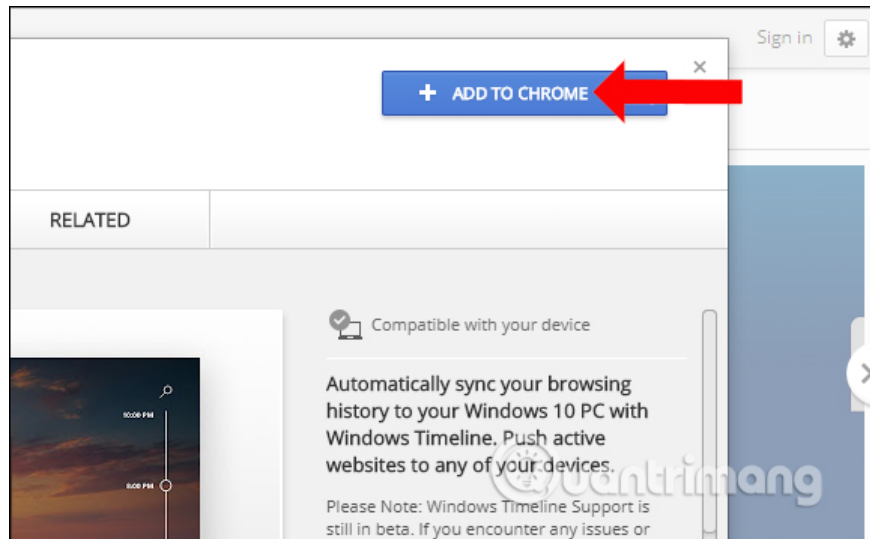

How to use Windows Timeline Support on Chrome

Step 1:

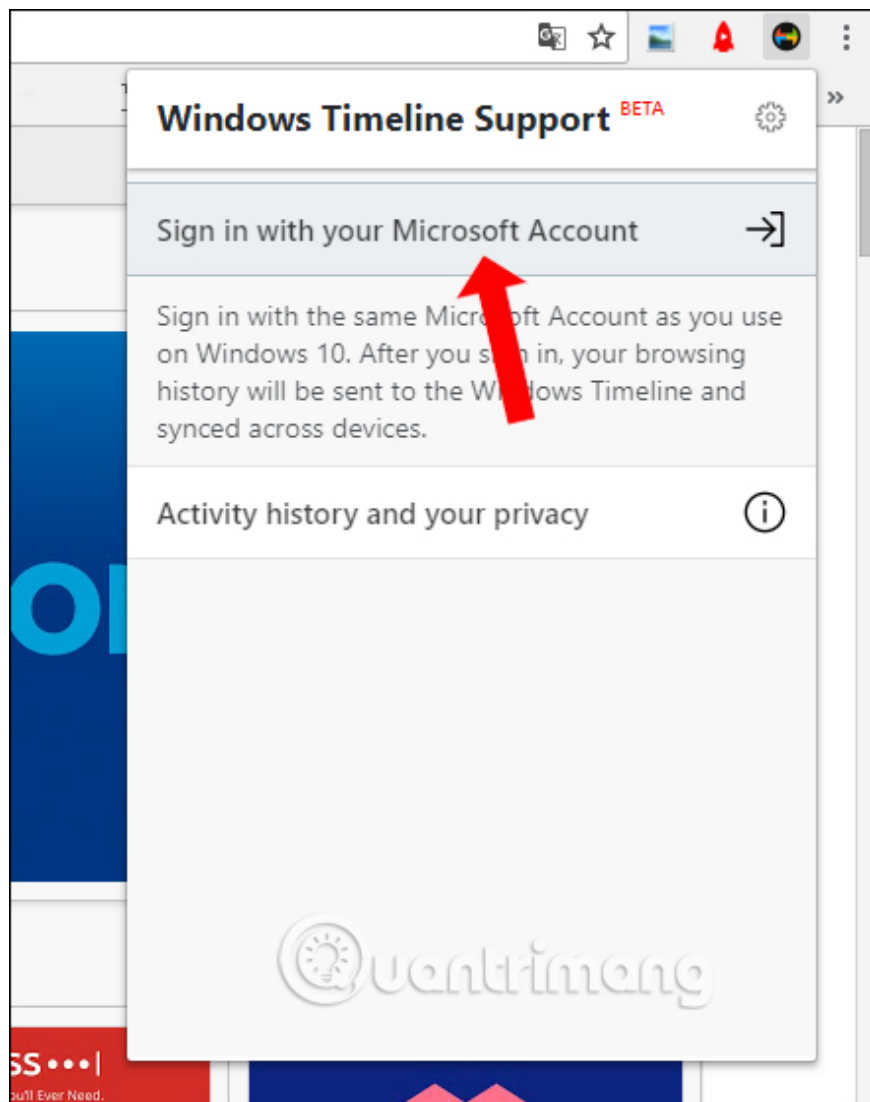
Click on the link below to download the Windows Timeline Support utility for Chrome, Firefox or Vivaldi. Click **Add to Chrome** to install the utility. Other browsers do the same.

1. Download Windows Timeline Support Chrome, Vivaldi
2. Download Windows Timeline Support Firefox



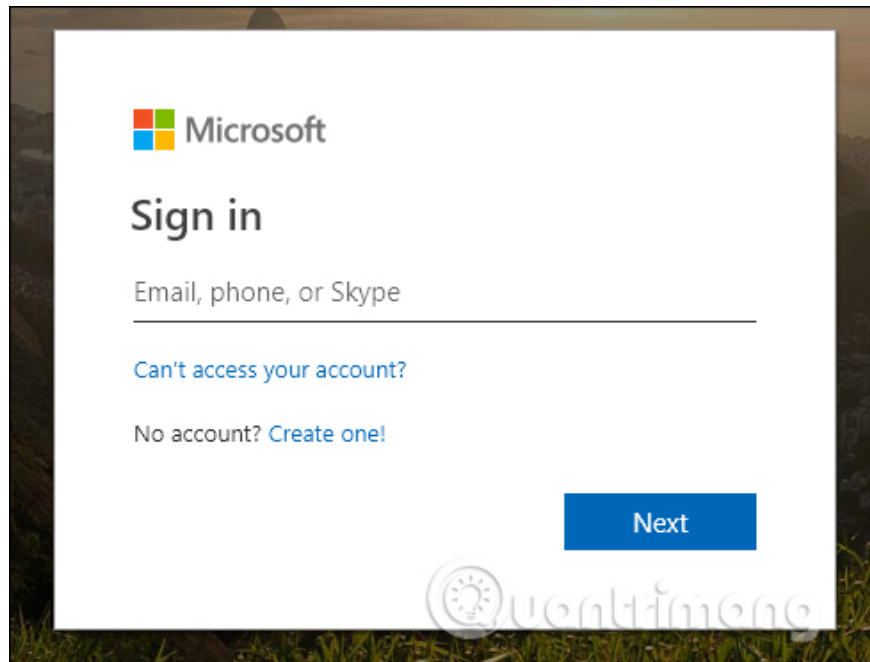
Step 2:

After successful installation click on the utility icon at the end of the address bar. Click **Sign in with your Microsoft Account** and log in.




Step 3:


A new interface appears for users to enter a Microsoft account if available, or create a Microsoft account. Fill in the account information into the interface and then **click Sign in** to login.





Step 4:

The interface of terms of use appears from Microsoft, click **Yes** to agree.

 **Read and write app activity to your activity feed**
Windows Timeline Support (Chrome Based) will be able to read and report your activities in the app to your activity feed.

 **See your list of devices**
Windows Timeline Support (Chrome Based) will be able to see your list of devices.

 **Communicate with your other devices**
Windows Timeline Support (Chrome Based) will be able to launch an app on another device, and communicate with an app on a remote device.

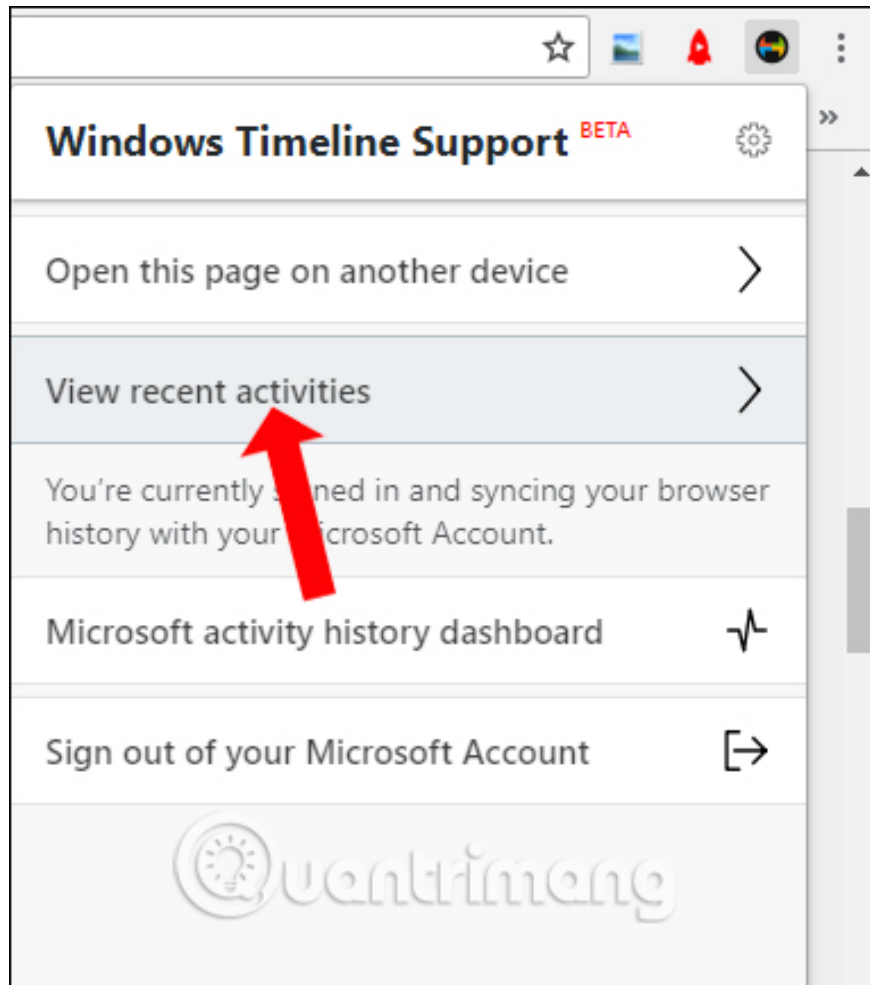
 **Access your info anytime**
Windows Timeline Support (Chrome Based) will be able to see and update your info, even when you're not using this app.

Step 5:

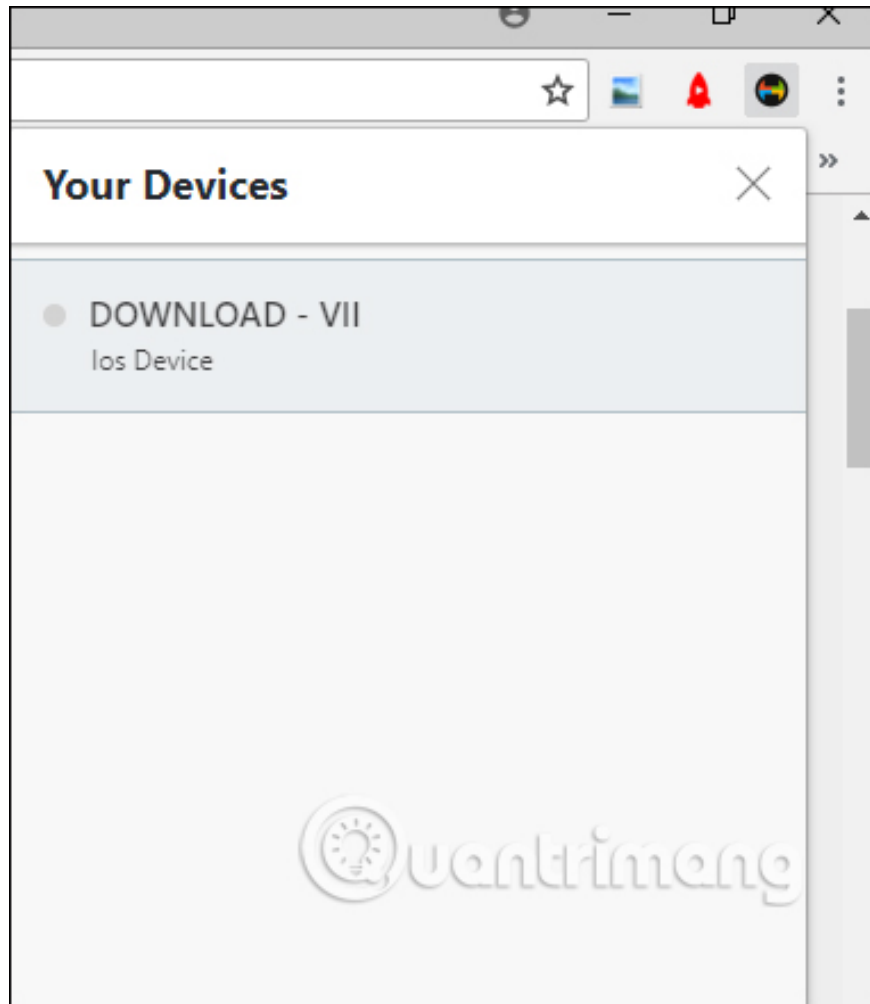
Now when you browse the web on Chrome, Firefox is in the normal mode, the utility will automatically save and sync to the Timeline on the computer. When opening Timeline, they will appear. In addition, Windows Timeline Support also has the option of managing opened web pages on the Timeline when clicking on the **View recent activities** .



Step 6:

In addition, users will have additional options in the utility interface. With the **Open this page on another device option** , we can open the website on another device via a Microsoft account.

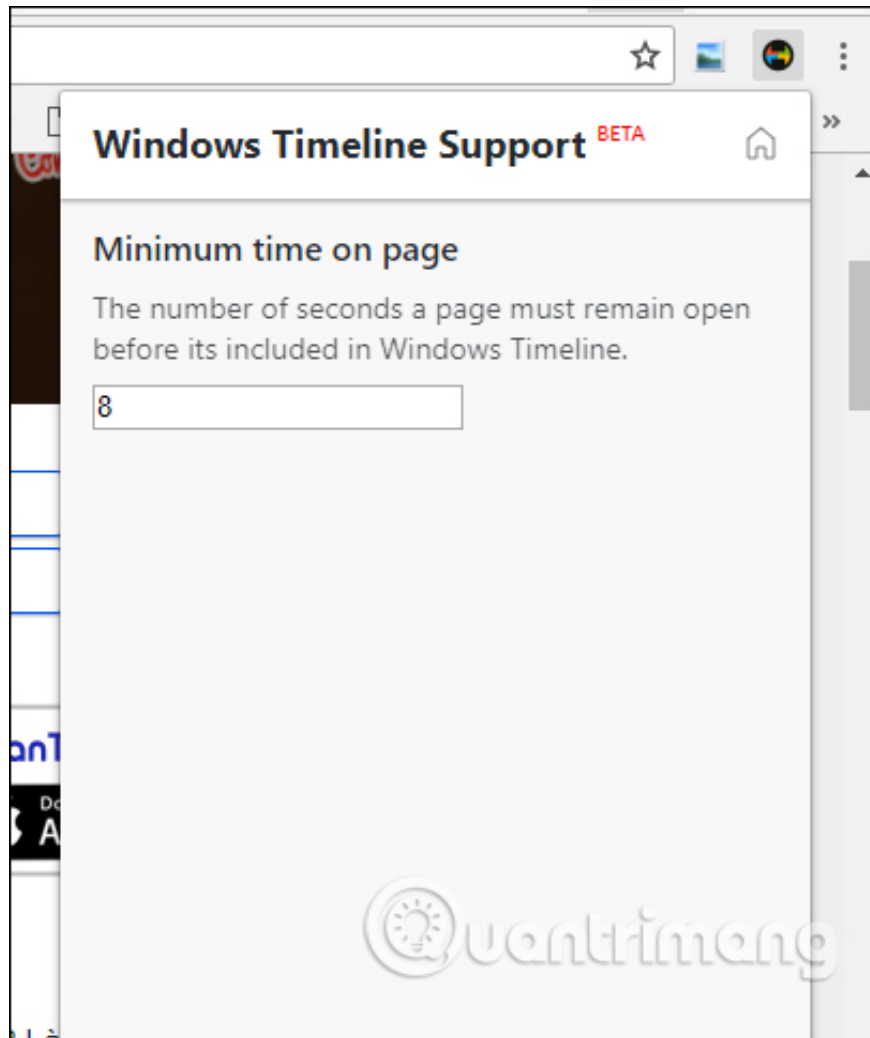
The list of used devices will be displayed for user management. Can log in accounts on applications like Microsoft Launcher, Microsoft Edge, . on Android, iOS, Windows Mobile. When clicking on the device name the website will be opened in the default browser.



Step 7:

The **Microsoft activity history dashboard** will switch to a web page that saves the activity performed on Windows.

When clicking on **the gear icon** will appear the **Minimum heart on page option** is the time to browse the web to save the website and sync on the Timeline. We can change the browsing time depending on the user.



So, in addition to bringing Timeline to Chrome or Firefox, the Windows Timeline Support utility will help you access websites on many different devices, through your Microsoft account.
