

How to change display density on Android phone

If you feel that the icons on your Android phone screen are too large or too small, you can adjust the display density on the screen.

If you find that the icons on your Android phone's screen are too big or too small, you can adjust the display density. Display density determines the number of pixels per inch of screen. Adjusting this setting changes the way your phone processes those pixels, making icons, text, and menus look right to you. Here's how to change the display density on Android.

How to change display density on Android

Step 1:

Go to **Settings** then select **About phone** , then click **Software information** to view system information.
