

How to change DNS Google IPv4 and IPv6 on Windows 10 Fall Creators

Leave DNS on Windows 10 Fall Creators you have to go to Settings. So how to set up Google IPv4 and IPv6 DNS on Windows 10 Fall Creators?

One of the ways to increase Internet speed is to change DNS on the computer. Currently there are many DNS to help you access the network stably and quickly like DNS Singapore, DNS VNPT, DNS OpenDNS, . but most commonly still is Google DNS. Google DNS will ensure faster and more stable network access speed on your computer. Not to mention some errors related to Google services, Google DNS will also fix that error.

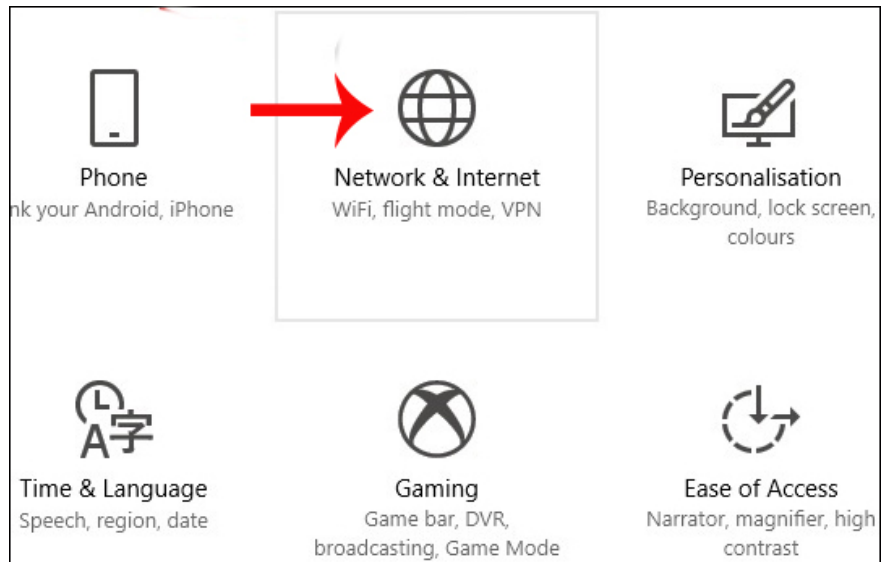
However, some users after upgrading to Windows 10 Fall Creators could not find DNS settings in the traditional way of implementing previous versions of Windows. In fact, DNS settings have been moved by Microsoft to the Settings group on the computer, in the Network & Internet section. The following article will guide you how to change DNS Google IPv4 and IPv6 on Windows 10 Fall Creators. We can also apply the way to do with other DNS.

Google DNS 8888 for IPv4

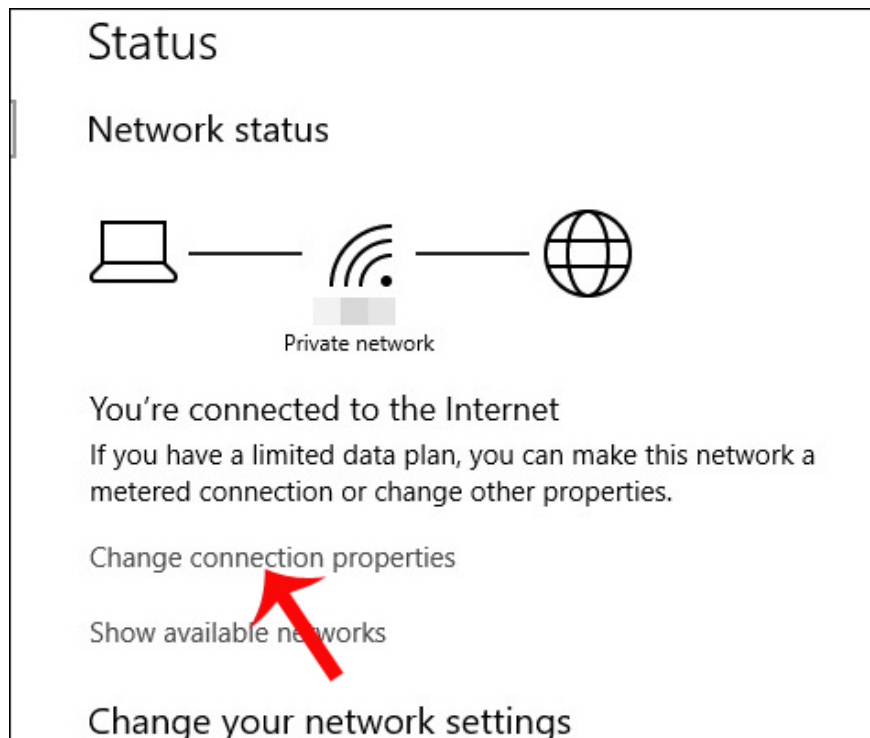
Step 1:

First, press the Windows + I key combination to open **the Windows Settings interface** on the system. Then click on the **Network & Internet** setup group.



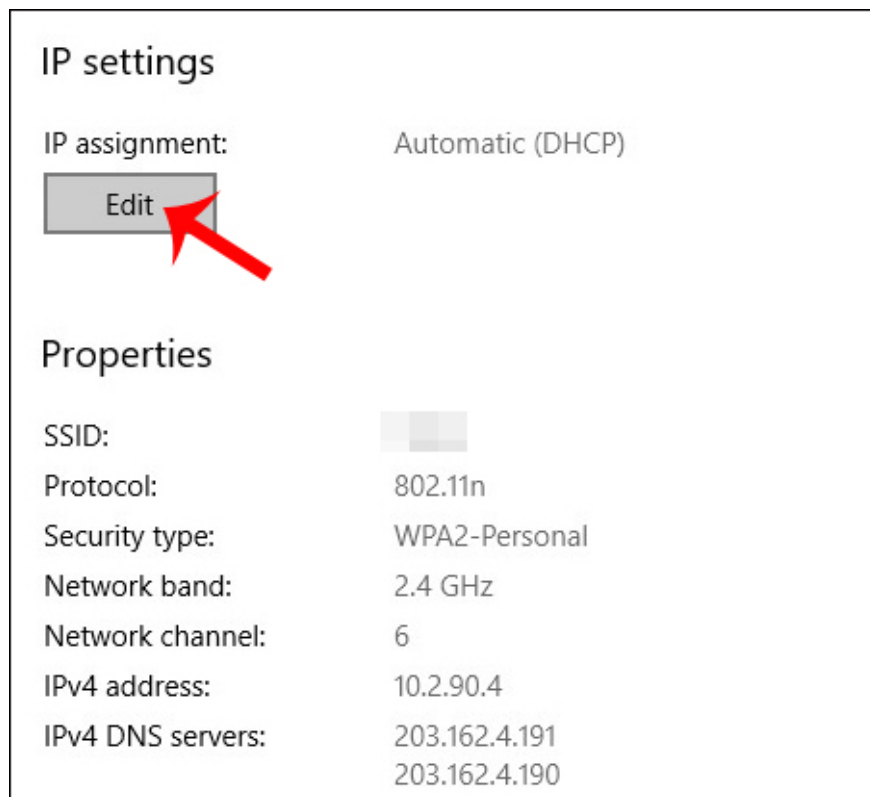
Step 2:

Next, click **Status settings** in the left menu bar outside the same interface. Users will look to the right content and click on **Change connection properties**.



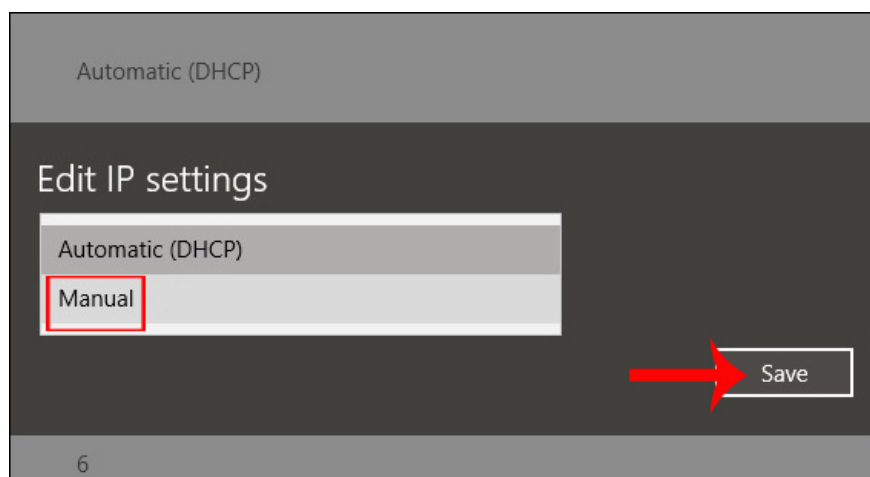
Step 3:

This is the interface that will provide all network connection information on the computer, click **the Edit button** under **IP assignment**.



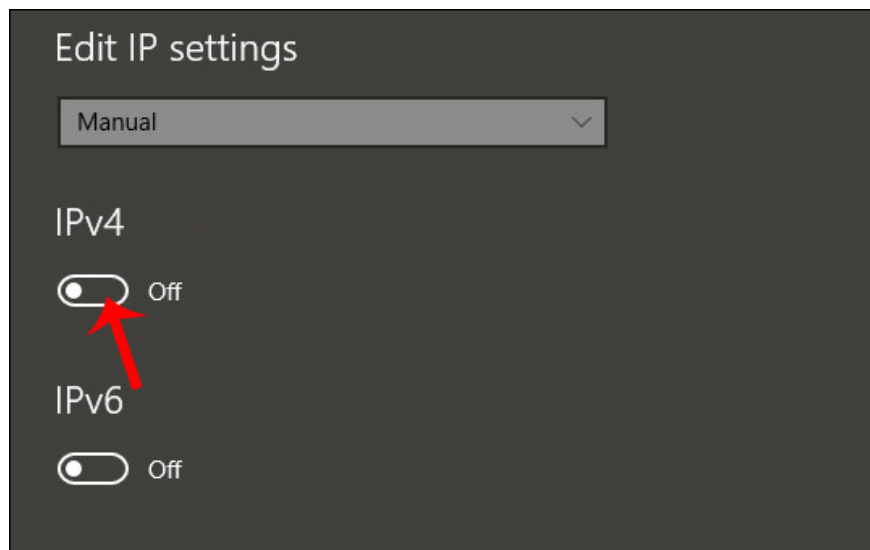
Step 4:

The Edit IP Settings dialog box appears so users can change their IP address, click on **Manual**, then click **Save** below.



Step 5:

Then at **IPv4**, push the horizontal bar to the right to switch to On mode.



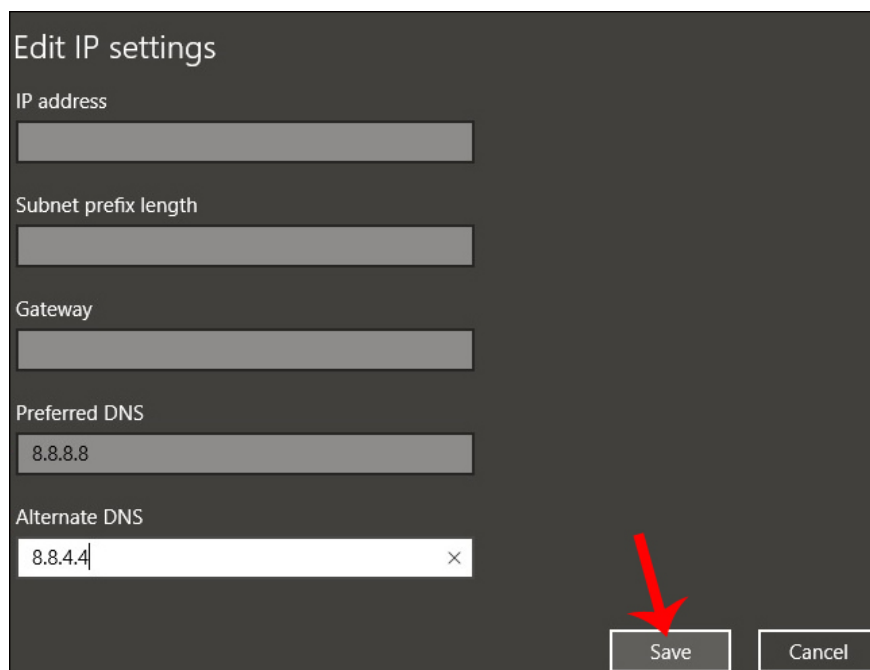
Step 6:

IPv4 options appear in the new interface. Drag the interface down to 2 **Preferred DNS** and **Alternate DNS lines**, then enter the Google DNS address information as shown. When done, you need to **press Save** to save the new changes.

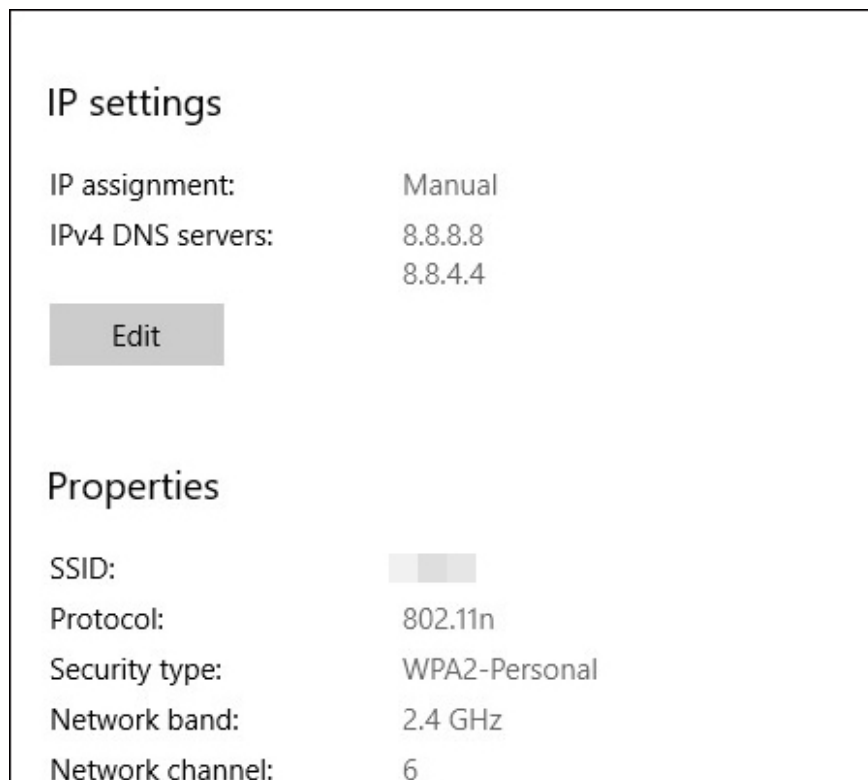
Google DNS:

Immediately network connection information on the computer will be changed and supplemented with Google DNS as shown below.



Google DNS for IPv6

If the operator already supports IPv6, then in step 5, you just need to turn on IPv6, and enter this DNS Google IPv6:

1. **2001: 4860: 4860 :: 8888**
2. **2001: 4860: 4860 :: 8844**

Some devices use separate fields for all eight IPv6 address sections and do not accept abbreviated syntax :: of IPv6. For such schools, enter:

1. **2001: 4860: 4860: 0: 0: 0: 0: 8888**
2. **2001: 4860: 4860: 0: 0: 0: 0: 8844**

Replace 0 items with 0000 if four hex digits are required.

Compared to previous versions of Windows, the operation of changing DNS on Windows 10 Fall Creators is completely different. You need to access the Network & Internet setup group in the Settings interface on the system. From there, you can take steps to change Google DNS or any DNS on Windows.
