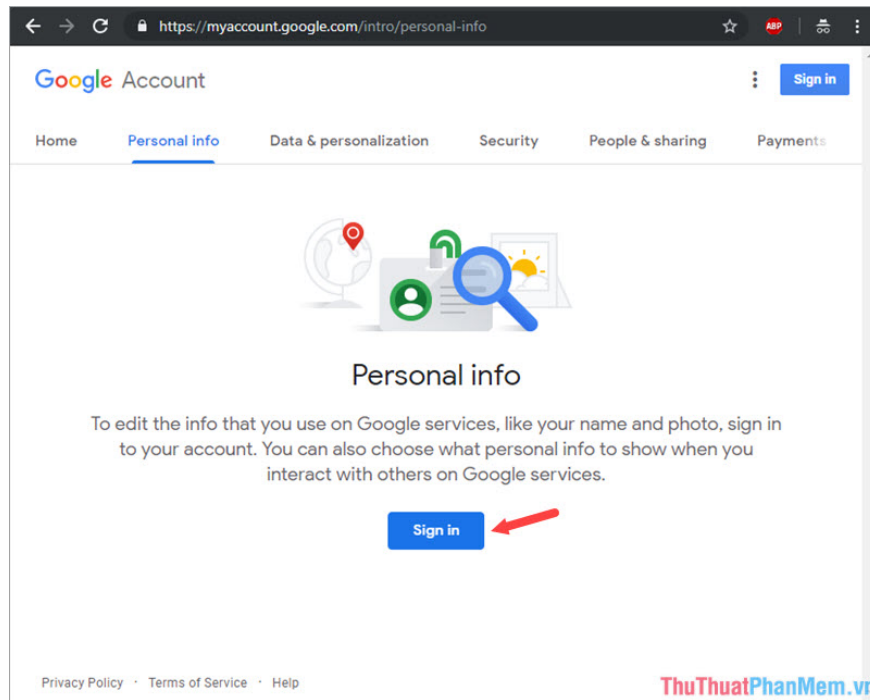

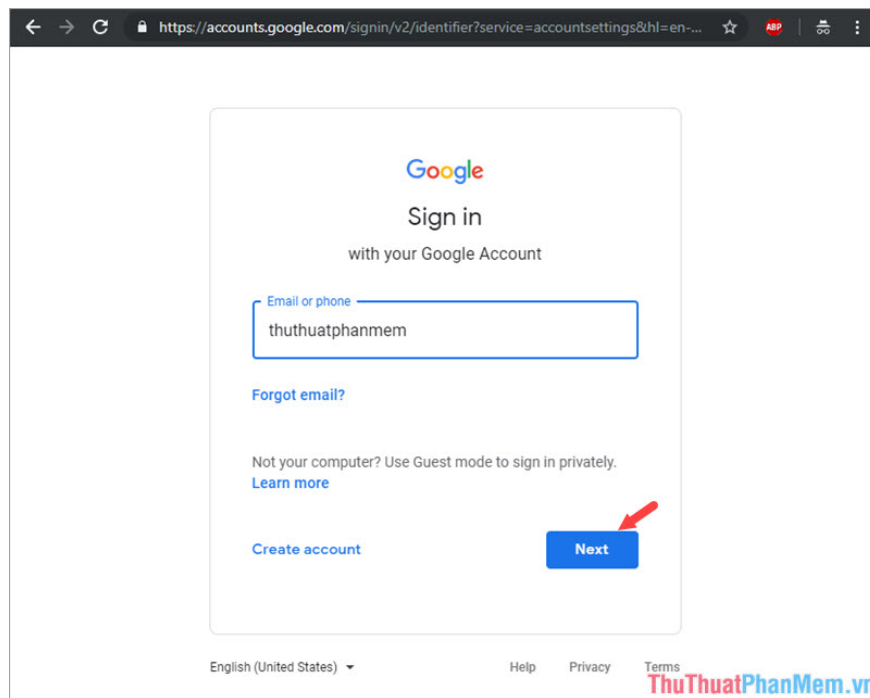
Step 1: You access the following address:

<https://myaccount.google.com/personal-info>

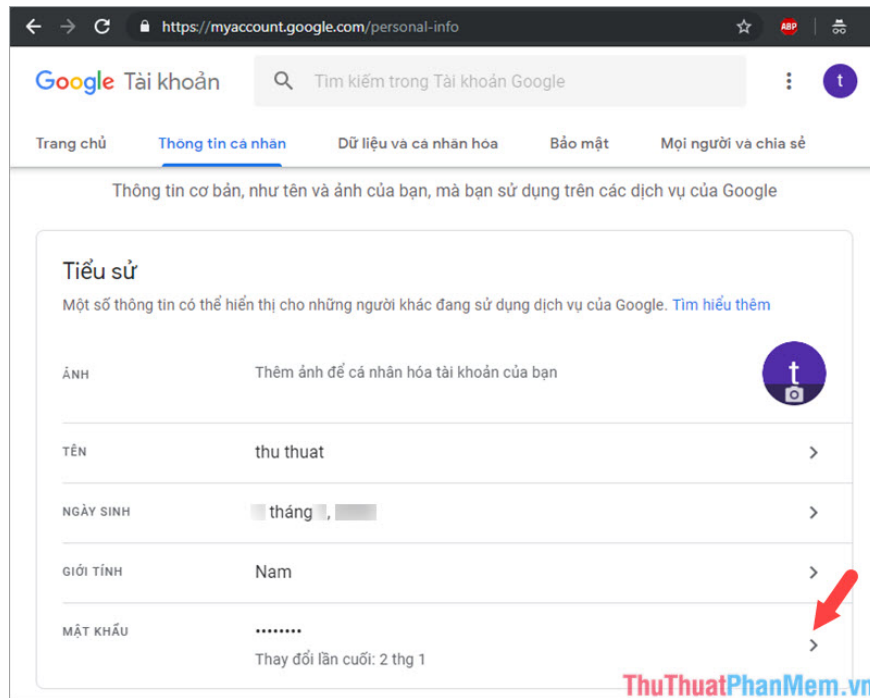
Click **Sign in** to proceed to login.



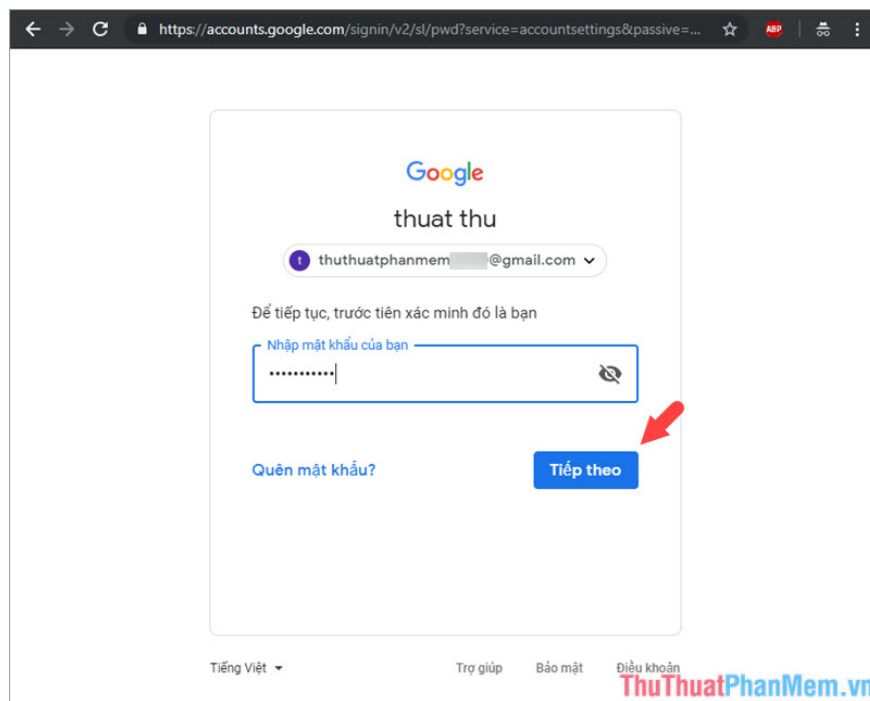
Step 2: Log in to your Gmail account and click **Next** to continue.



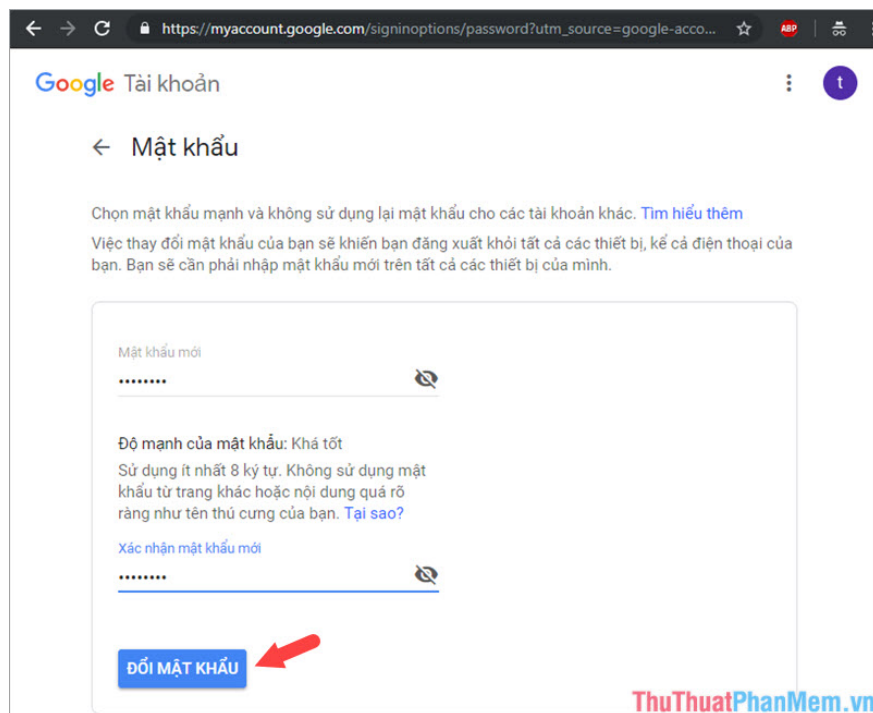
Step 3: After logging in, click on the **Password** to change the password.



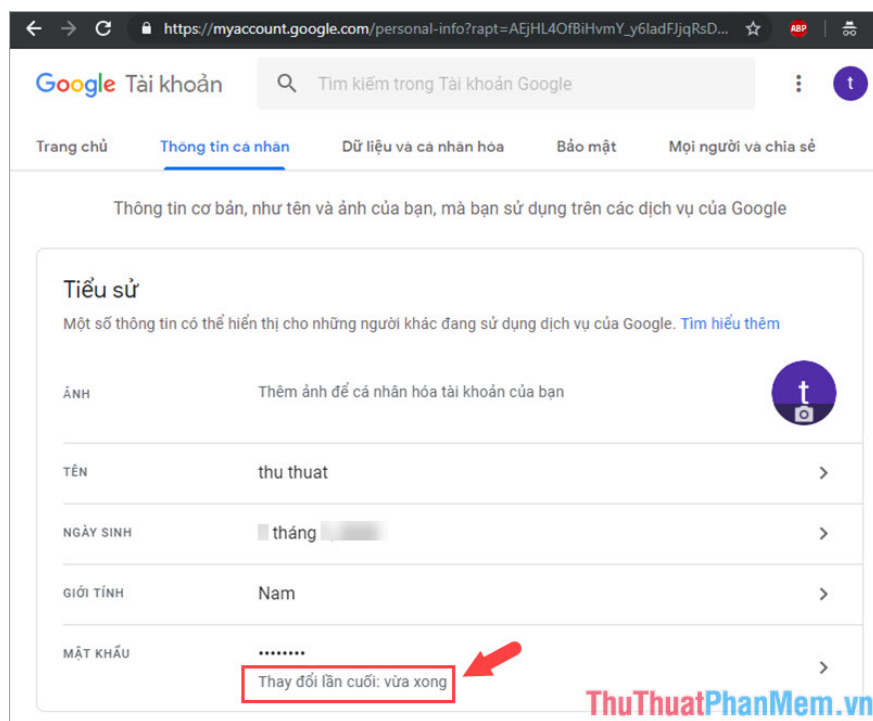
Step 4: Google will ask you to re-enter the password you are using to confirm, enter your current password and click **Next** .
