

How to change language on Windows 10 computer

See now how to change the language on your Windows 10 computer. Helps you proactively change the language quickly during your study and work process.

If you find that the default English language on your computer hinders the use and operation process, delays the work and study process, then set the language on your computer to Vietnamese. When do you need to change the language on your computer?

When you see the default language on your current computer hindering operations on your computer. Since then, if the progress of completing work or studying is much slower than the expected speed, adjust the language on the computer.

There are many **ways to adjust the language on the computer** . If you are proficient in using any language, adjust it to that language with the 4 ways below.

Install Vietnamese for your computer from Windows Settings

To install **Vietnamese for Windows 10** from **Windows Setting** , you must be sure that your personal computer does not use the Windows 10 Home Single Language version.

Step 1: Go to the **Start Menu** icon located in the lower left corner of the screen and then click on **Settings** to open the working window.

Step 2: In the new window that appears on the screen, click on **Time & Language** .

Step 3: Switch to the **Language** tab on the left and select **Add a language**.

Step 4: Here, you choose the language you commonly use to install. Then click **Next** to go to the next step.

Step 5: Check the **Set as my Windows display language** box with a green tick and then select **Install**.

Step 6: Continue clicking **Yes, sign out now** to log out of the system and then log back into your Microsoft account. Besides, you can also turn off the computer and then restart it to check if the language on the computer has been reinstalled or not.

Step 1: Visit Microsoft's website to download the Vietnamese installation application for Windows 10.

Step 2: To download the application, continue to tick **Set as my Windows display language** with a green tick and then click **Install** .

Step 3: Wait a few minutes for the application download process to complete. After the application has been downloaded to your computer, to check whether **the Vietnamese installation for Windows 10** has been successful, click **Yes, sign out now** to log out of your current account and log in again or turn off the computer and start it again. again.

Instructions on how to change the language on the computer with keyboard shortcuts

In addition, there is also **a way to install Vietnamese for your computer** using keyboard shortcuts that is faster and simpler than the two **ways to change the language on your computer** that TipsMake has instructed above.

To switch between languages ??on your computer, just press the key combination **Ctrl + Shift** or **Windows + Space** to open a new dialog box that appears on the screen, then click to select the appropriate language.

Instructions on how to install Vietnamese percussion for Windows

Using UniKey Vietnamese percussion is the most popular **way to change language on computers** today on Windows, chosen by many people because of its simplicity and ease of use. To install this percussion on your computer, follow the steps below:

Step 1: First you must download UniKey Vietnamese percussion to your computer.

Step 2: Scroll down, select **Download** and wait a few minutes to download the file to your computer.

Step 3: After the file has been successfully downloaded to your computer, proceed to unzip the folder in the following 2 steps:

Click on the arrow mark to the left of the file and then click on **Show in folder** .

Continue to right-click and select **Extract to unikey43RC5-200929-win64/** and wait about 2 - 3 seconds for the decompression process to be successful.

Step 4: Click on the successfully extracted file to open the dialog box.

Step 5: In the folders displayed in the dialog box, click to select the **UniKeyNT.exe** file .

Step 6: Click and select **Run** to launch the Vietnamese percussion tool UniKey.

Questions related to how to change the language on the computer

Here are some questions that users are often interested in **how to adjust Vietnamese on the computer** :

Installed Vietnamese but some places display English?

This situation often happens when you have just updated Windows, and the reason may be because the computer system has not yet optimized the entire language back to Vietnamese, so there will be some 'leftover' items that are still displayed in English.

So please wait a few days for the system to have a more complete Vietnamese update!

How to install Vietnamese for Google Chrome?

To change Chrome browser language to **Vietnamese on Windows 10** on your computer, follow these steps:

Step 1: Access the Chrome browser, then click on the 3-dot icon in the upper right corner of the screen and select Settings .

Step 2: On the new screen that appears, select Advanced **then** continue to select **Languages** , click **Add languages**.

Step 3: To change the language to Vietnamese, search for Vietnamese language and click **Add**.

Step 4: In the **Vietnamese** section , to switch the browser language, continue to click on the 3 dots icon and select **Display Google Chrome in this language** .

Step 5: Click **Relaunch** , turn off the browser and then restart Chrome browser to check if the browser has been reinstalled in Vietnamese or not.
