

How to change the color of shirts and pants using Photoshop

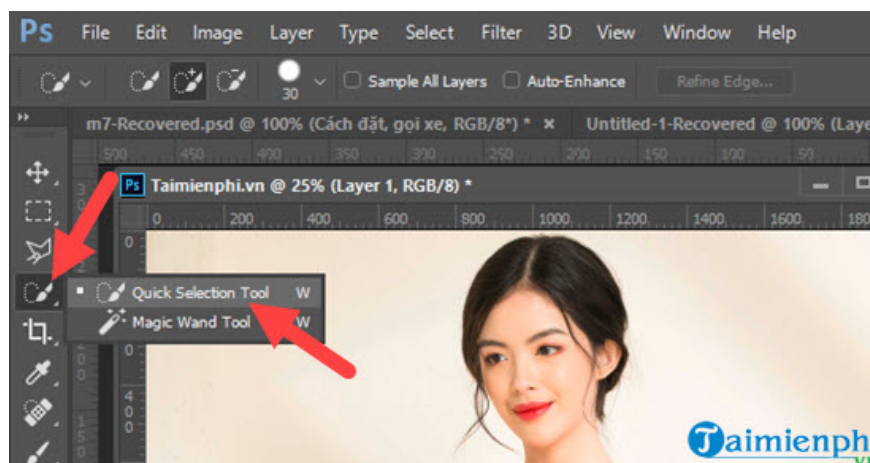

Let's assume we have the picture of the girl below. First, let's change the color of her shirt using Photoshop.



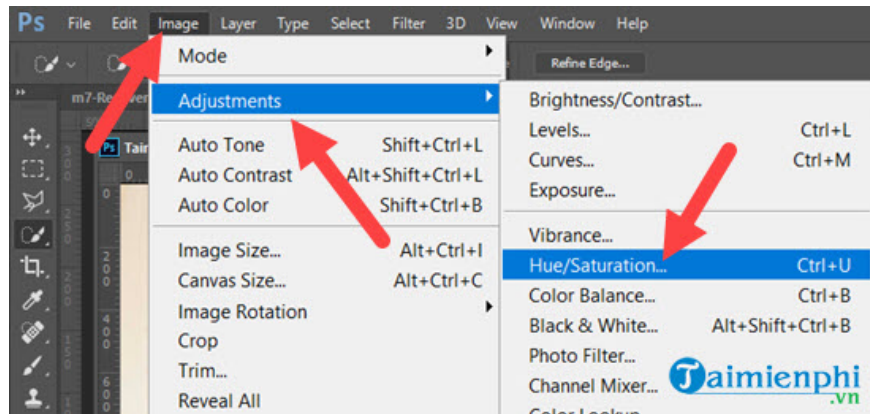
Step 1: To change the color of the shirt in Photoshop as shown in this article, we need to select the area of the shirt to prevent other parts from changing color. Specifically, you select the **Quick Selection Tool**.



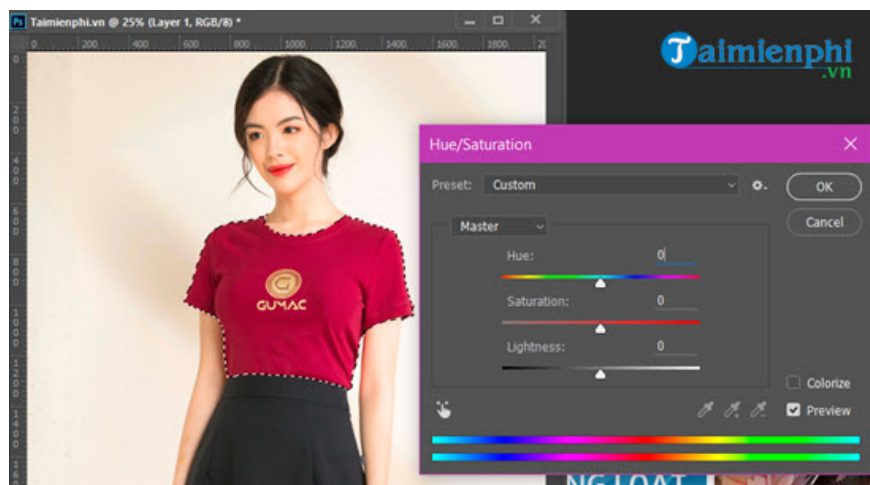
Step 2: Next, **point to several points on the shirt** and you will see a border around them; this means we have successfully selected the areas to change color.



Step 3: Next, look at the menu bar and select **Image > Adjustments > choose Hue/Saturation** . This feature allows you to change the color of the shirt using Photoshop.



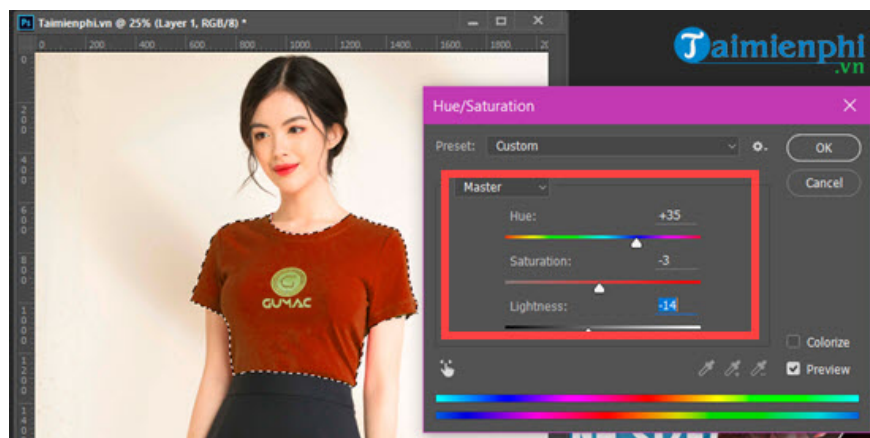
Step 4: Here you will see a table with many color options; we just need to set the parameters here to change the color.



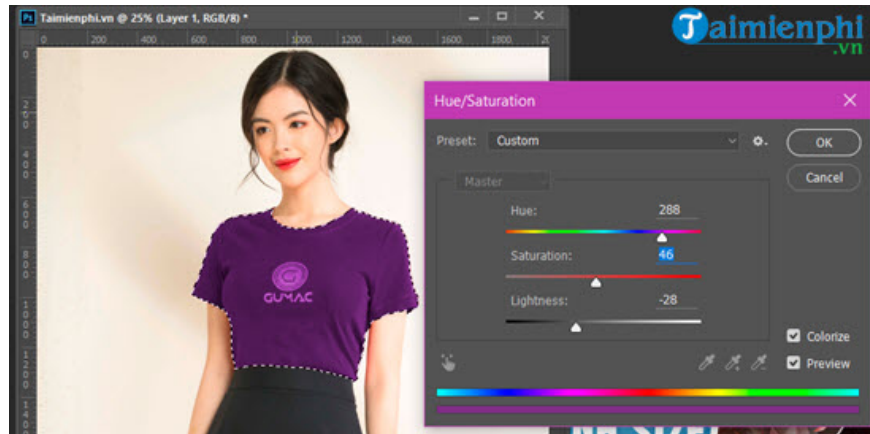
+ **Hue** : Changes the color of the selected image.

+ **Saturation** : Changes the intensity of the image's colors (affects HUE).

+ **Lightness** : Changes the brightness or darkness of the image (affects HUE).



Step 5: And as you can see, with just a few drags, the color of the shirt has completely changed. You can click on **Colorize** to fine-tune the color more specifically.



So, after changing the shirt color using Photoshop, we will get the result shown below, where the colors look quite harmonious.



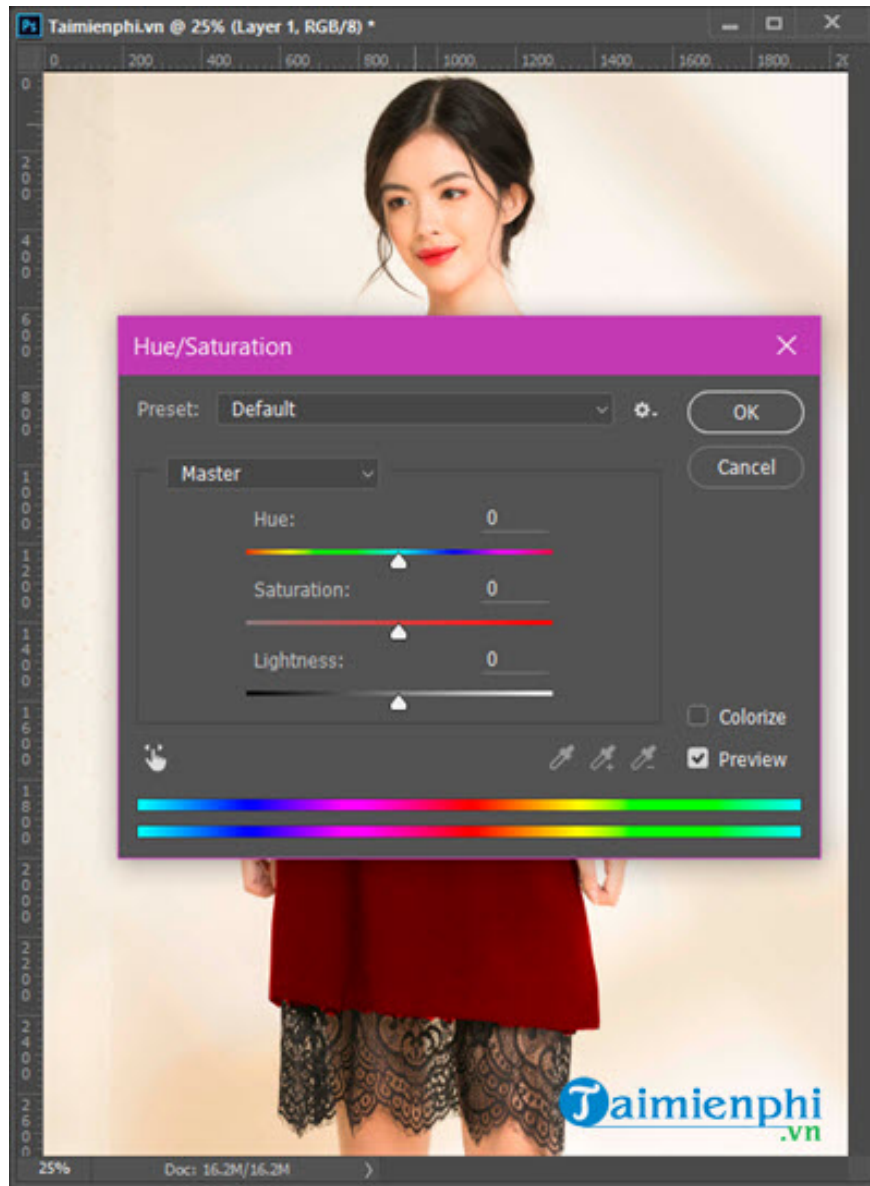
You can change colors in a snap with just a drag.



Step 6: Now that we've changed the shirt color using Photoshop, let's change the pants color. The process is similar to changing the shirt color.



Step 7: Go back to **Hue/Saturation** to adjust the color of the pants to your liking.



Ultimately, we will have a completely color-shifted image; whether this color shift is successful or not depends on the complexity of the colors and patterns on the clothing.



Through the above instructions, you can also see how versatile Photoshop is. These are just basic techniques that users can apply to Photoshop. Of course, depending on the complexity of the image, we will have different solutions. Refer to how to change hair color using Photoshop here.
