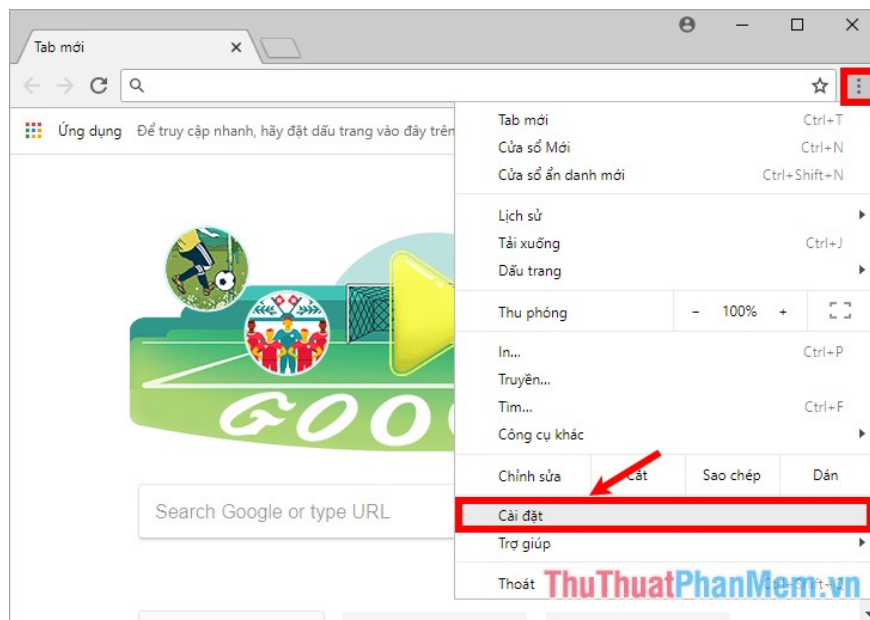

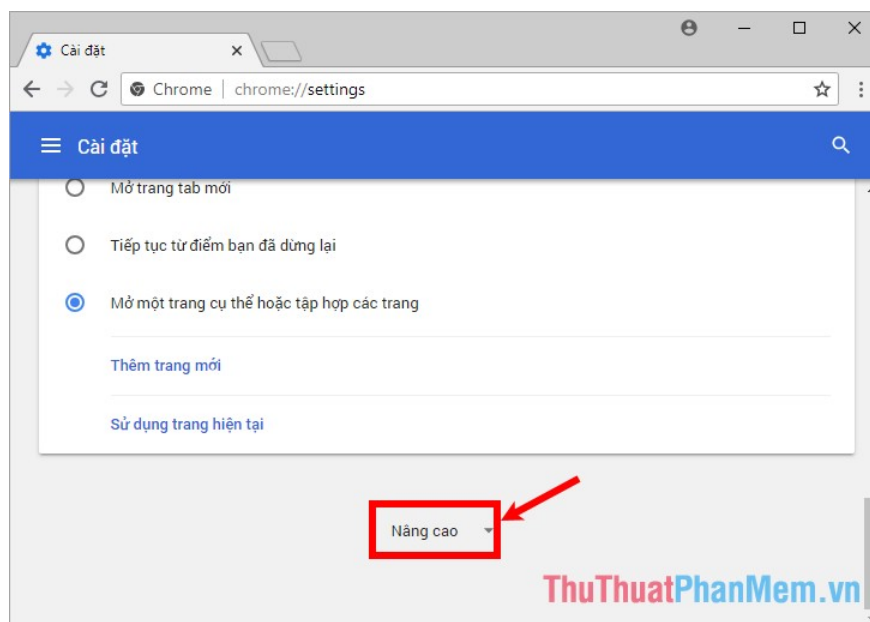
The following article shows how to change the default download folder in Chrome, Coc Coc, Edge, Firefox.

How to change the default download folder in Chrome

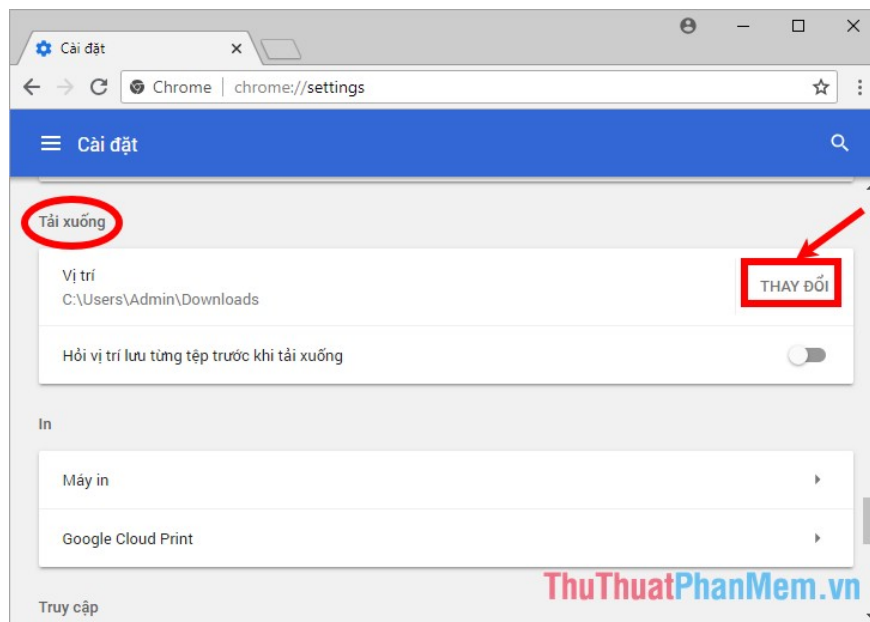
Step 1: Open Google Chrome browser, on the browser you select the three-dot icon (**customize and control Google Chrome**) -> **Settings**.



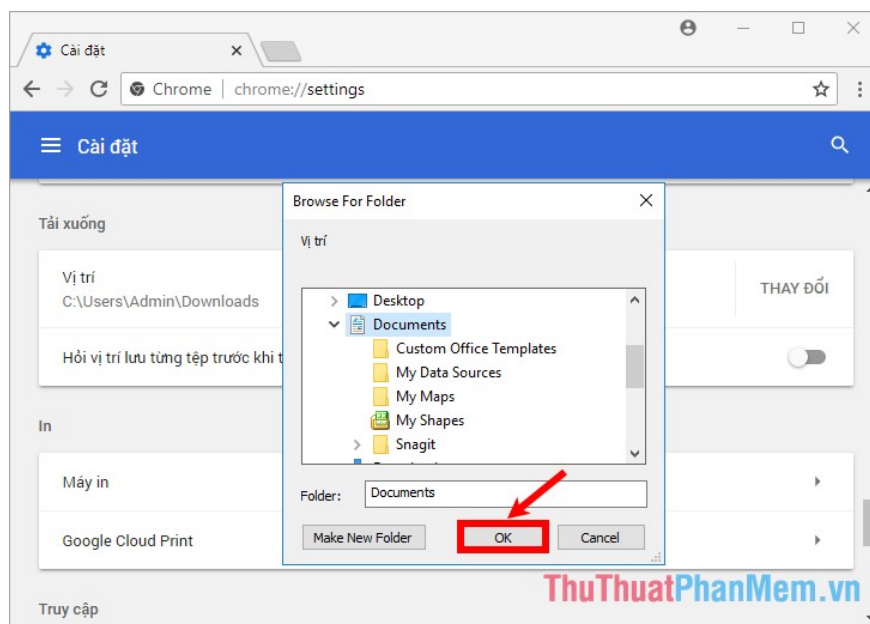
Step 2 : In the **Settings** section, drag the slider to the bottom of the page and select **Advanced** .



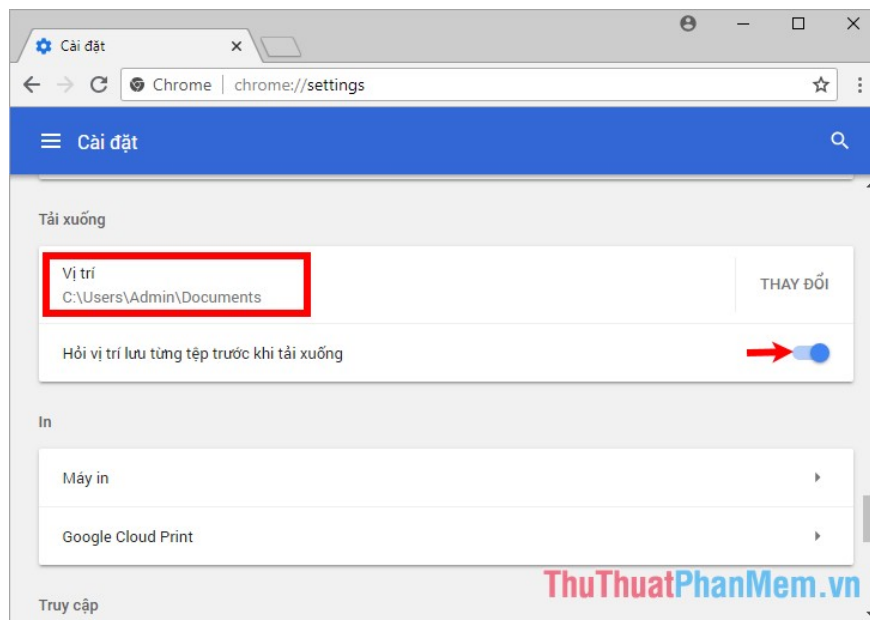
Step 3 : Scroll down to the **Download** section , select **Change** on the **Location** line .



Step 4 : A small **Browse For Folder** dialog box appears, select the download folder and click **OK** to agree to the changes.

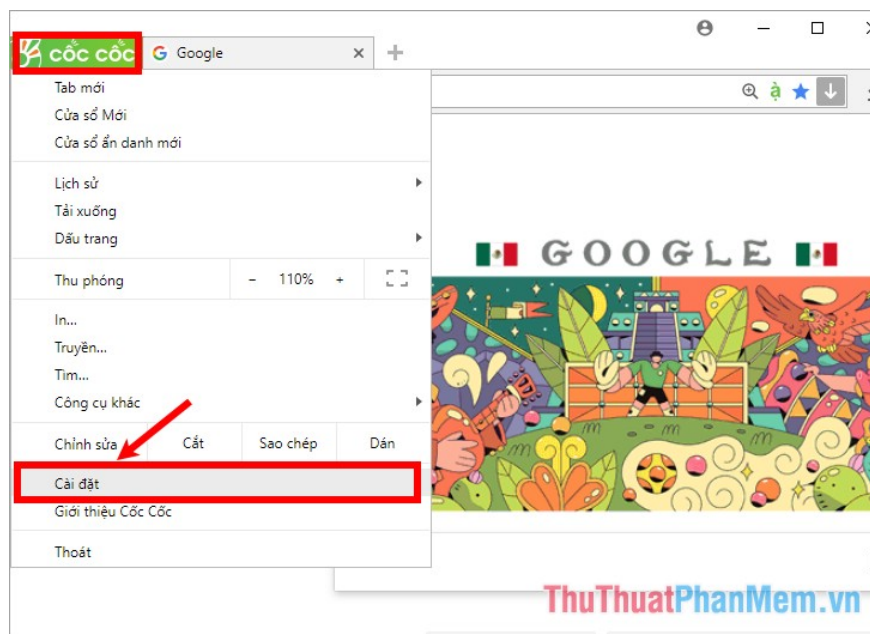


Now you will see the path under **Location** has changed, to ask where to save each file before downloading, on the line **Ask where to save each file before downloading**, drag the slider to the right to turn on the feature this.

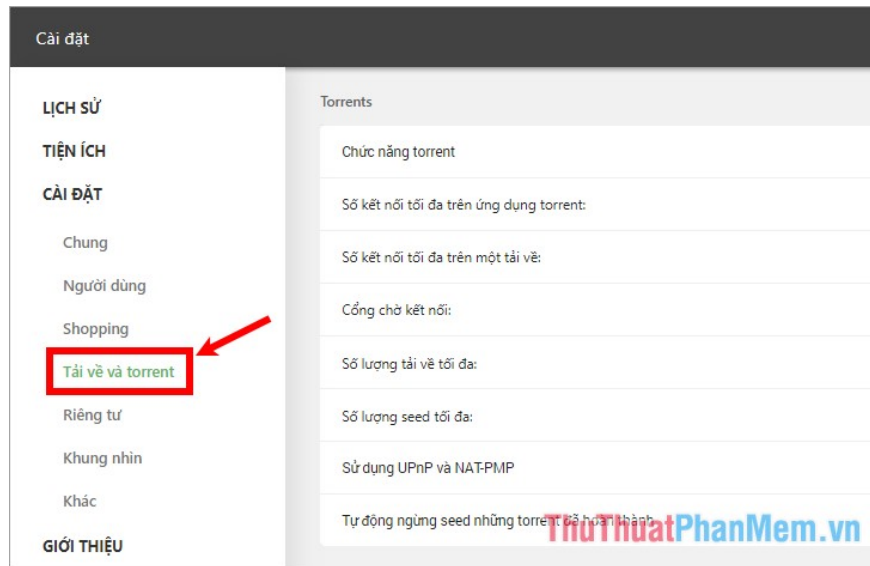


How to change the default download folder in Coc Coc

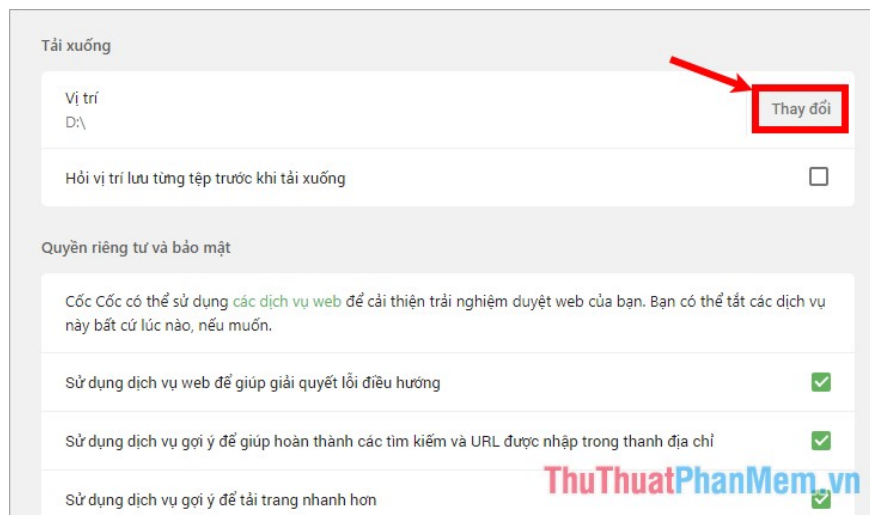
Step 1: On the Coc Coc browser, select the custom icon and control Coc Coc -> Settings.



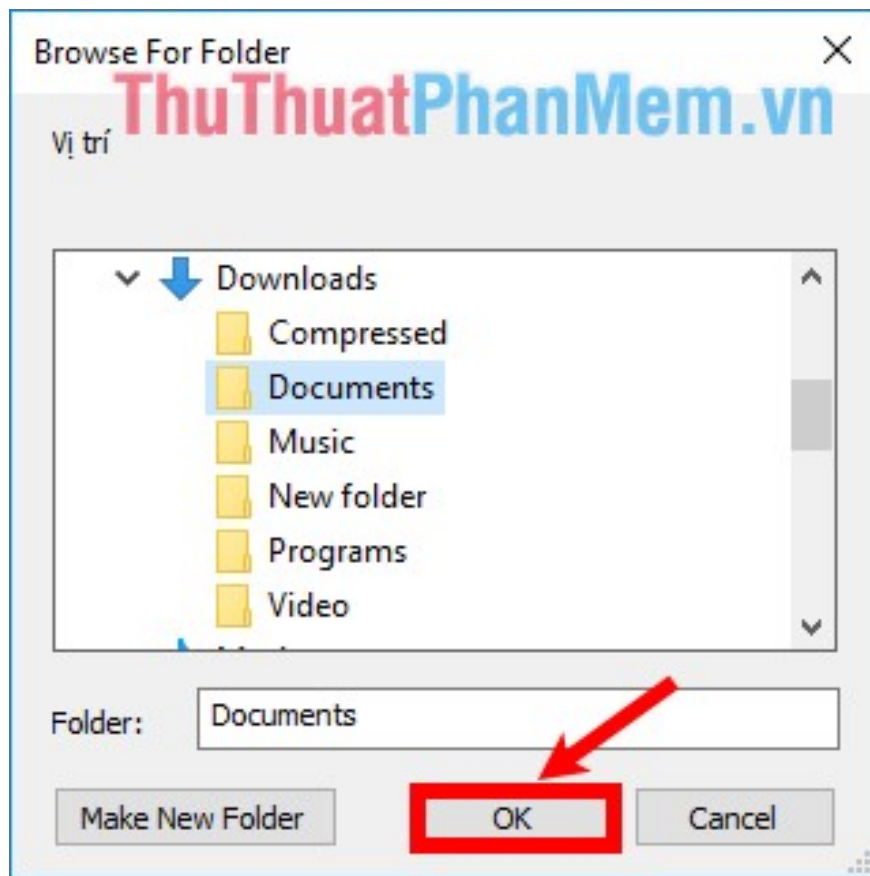
Step 2: Select the **Download and torrent** section on the left.



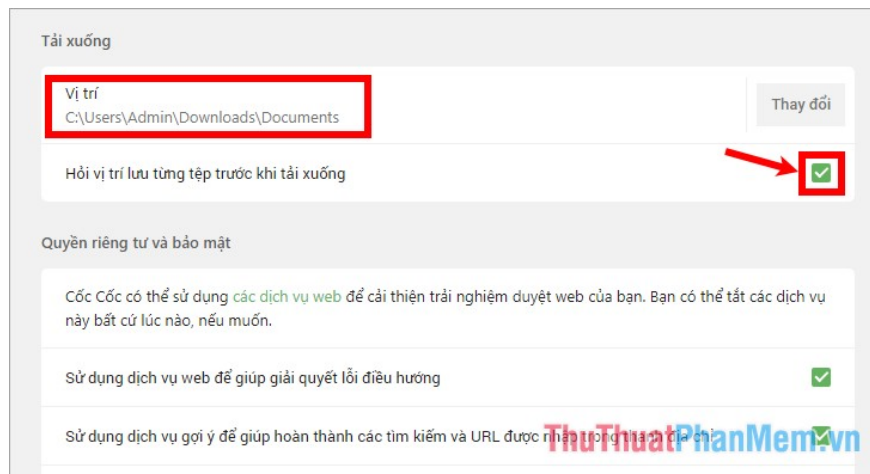
Step 3: In the **Download** section, select **Change** next to the **Location** link.



Step 4: In **Browse For Folder**, select the folder you want to store the downloaded data, then click **OK** to agree.

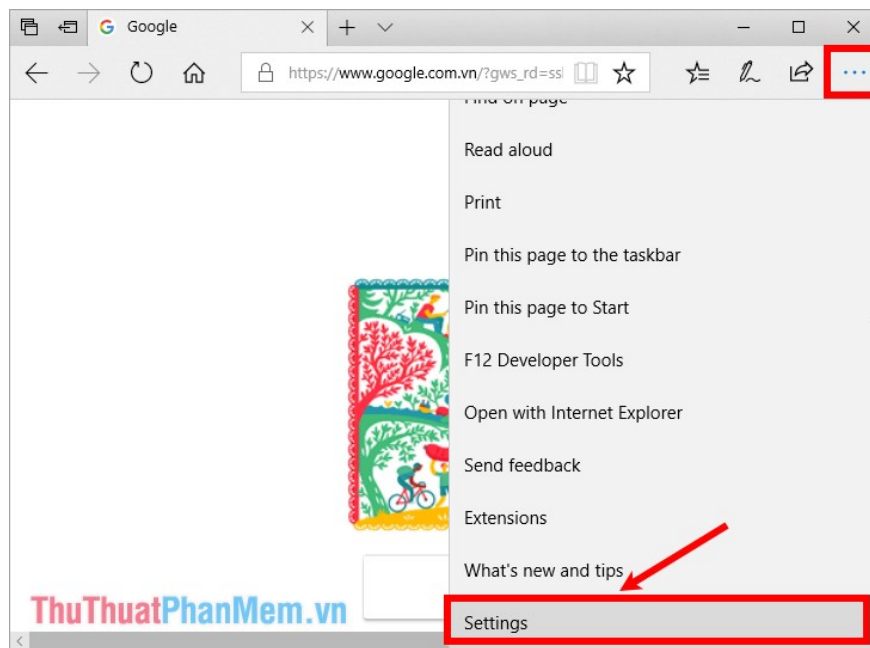


So you will see the download location will change according to the path you choose. Also, if you want Coc Coc to ask where to save files before downloading, you tick the box before asking where to **save each file before downloading**.

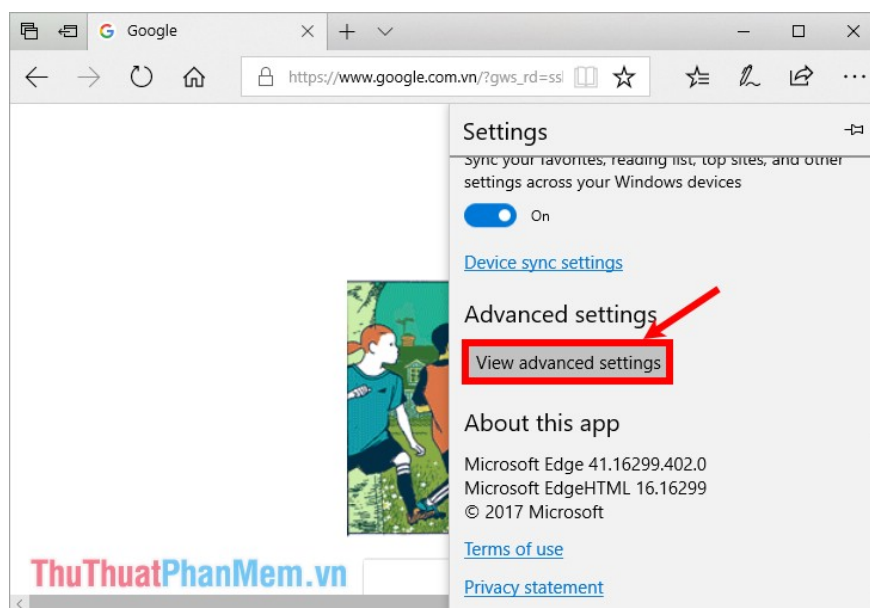


How to change the default download folder in Edge

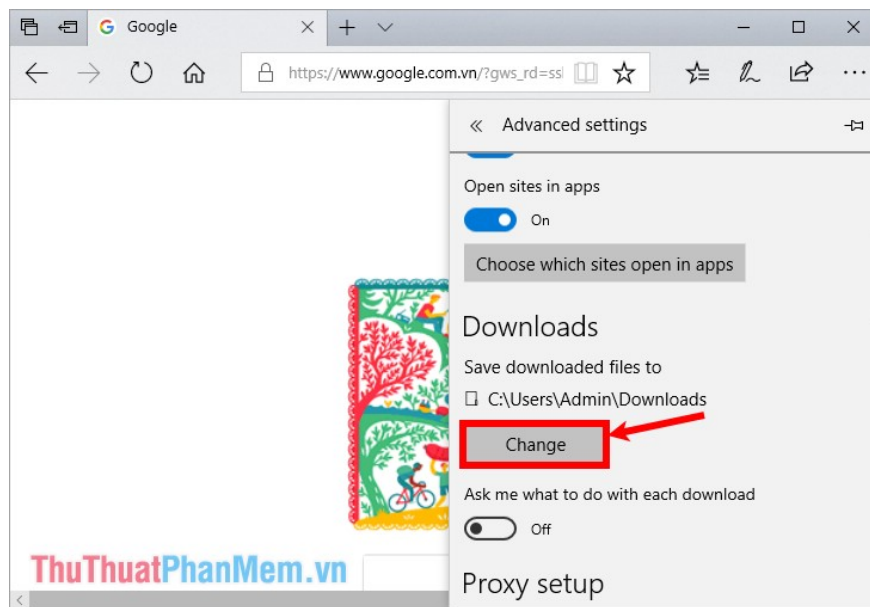
Step 1: On the Microsoft Edge interface, select the dot icon (**Settings and More**) -> **Settings** .



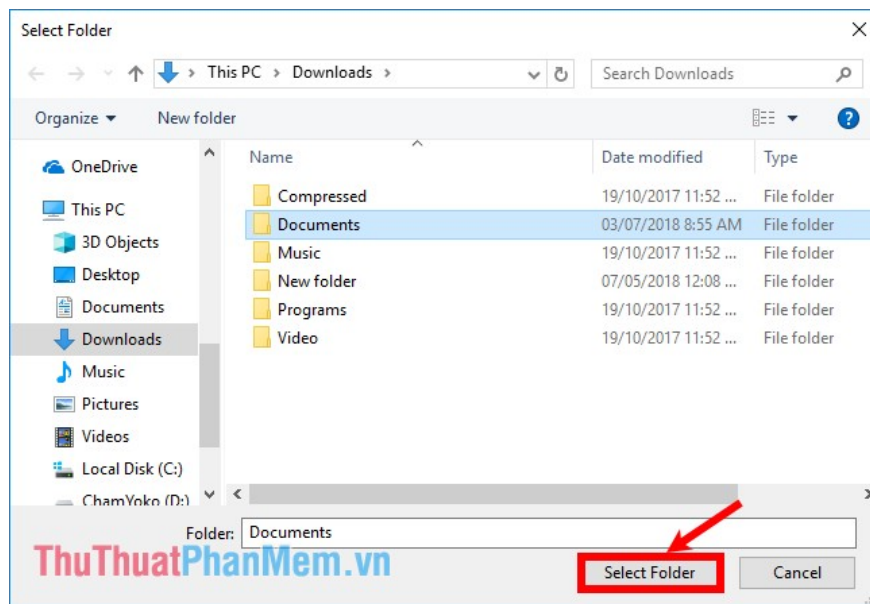
Step 2 : Drag the vertical slider down to the **Advanced settings** section and select **View advanced settings**.



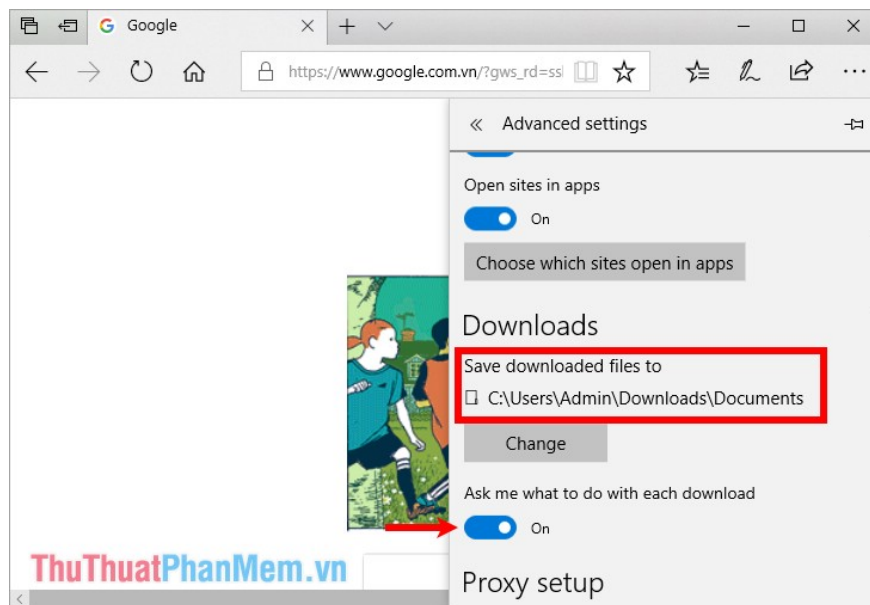
Step 3 : In the **Downloads** section , in the section **Download downloaded files to you** select **Change** .



Step 4 : The **Select Folder** window appears, select the folder you want to save the downloaded files and click **Select Folder**.

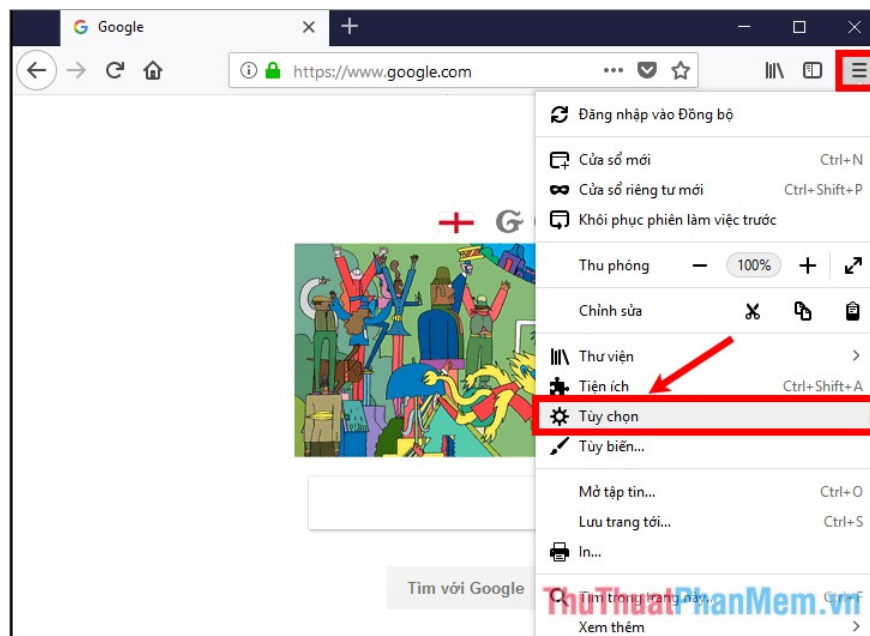


Thus, in the section **Download** downloaded files to the **download file** path will be changed, to ask the browser to ask for the location of the file before downloading, in the **Ask me what to do with each download** section, you drag the circle to the right to appear **On** as shown below.

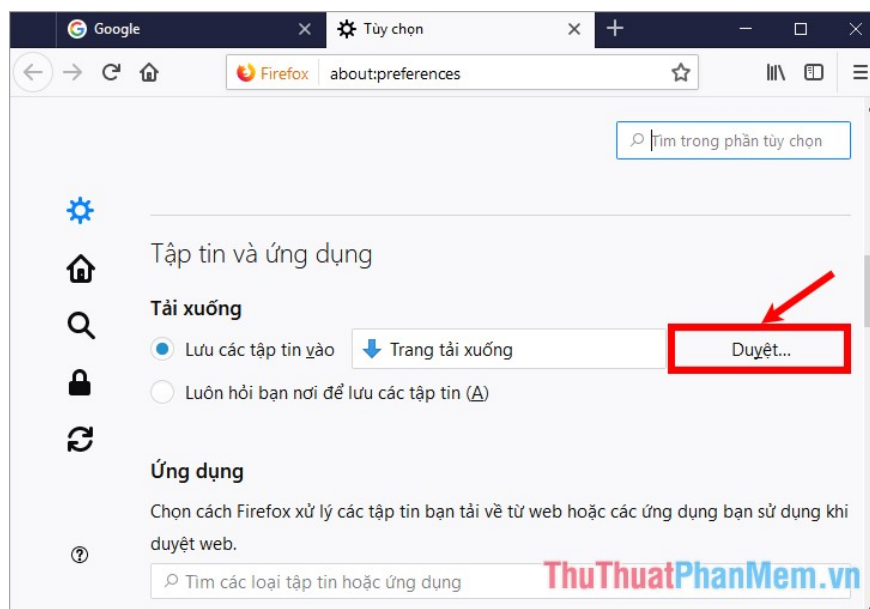


How to change the default download folder in Firefox

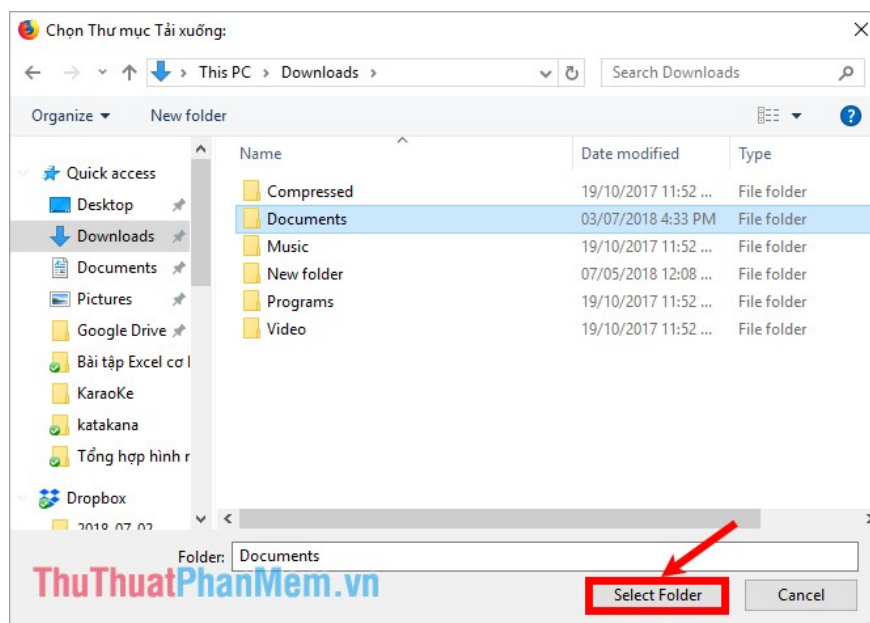
Step 1: On the Firefox browser interface, select the three dashes icon -> **Options**.



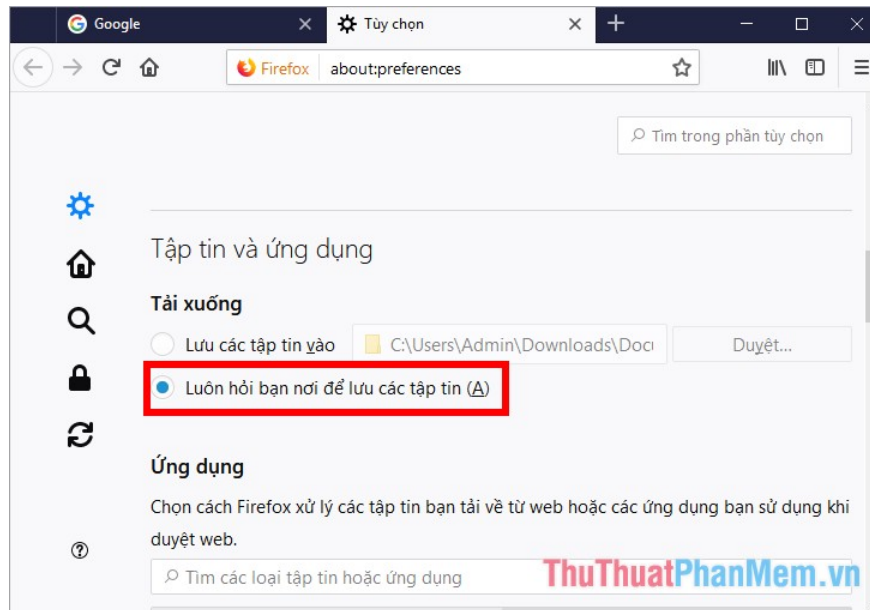
Step 2 : Drag the vertical slider down to the **Files and applications** section, in the **Downloads** section , select **Browse** on the **Save files** line .



Step 3 : Next, select the folder to save the downloaded file and click **Select Folder**.



So you've changed the default download directory of Firefox, if you want to ask where to save the file before downloading, then select **Always ask you where to save the file (A)**.
