

How to change the default zoom level in Firefox

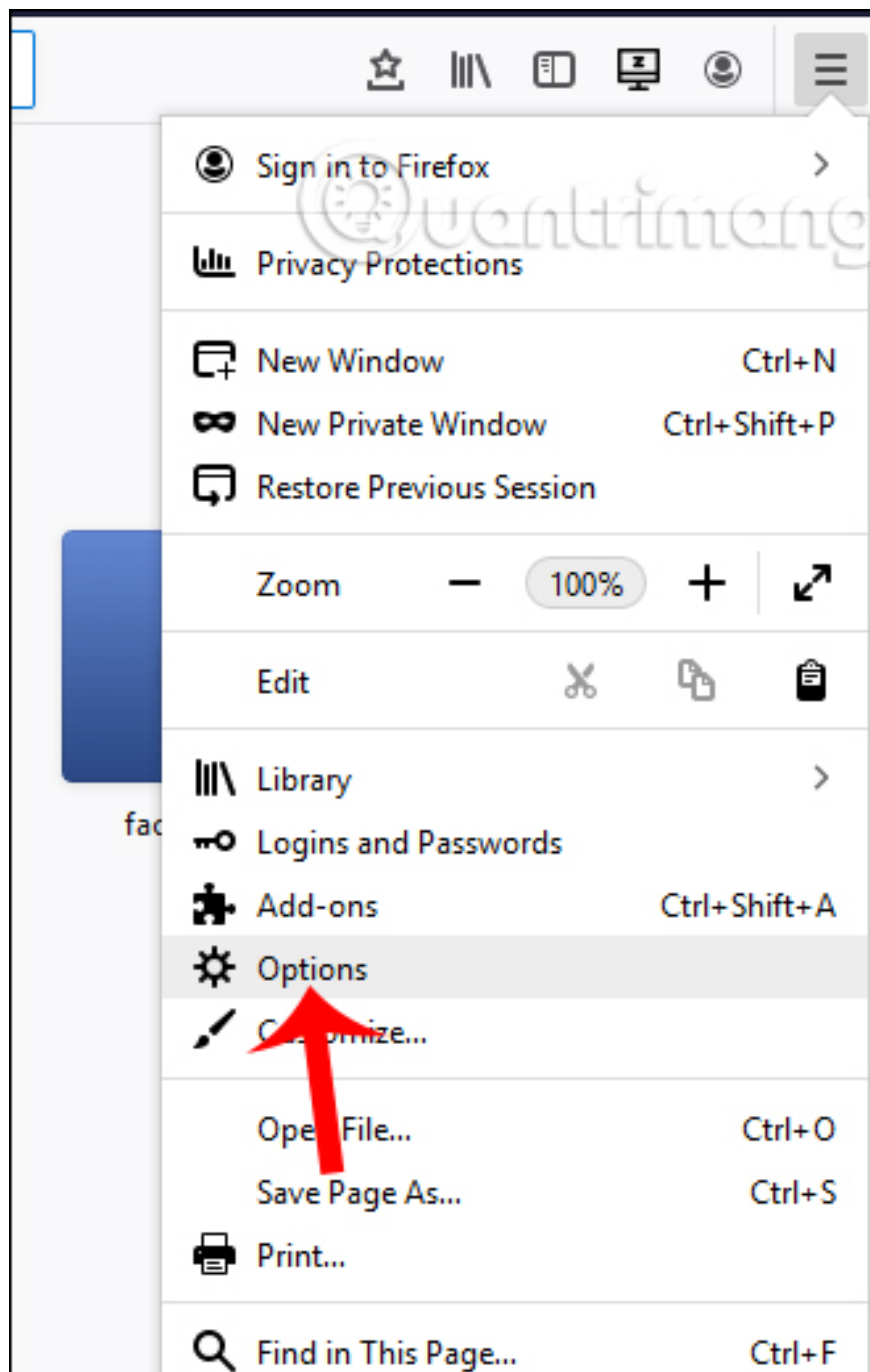
Firefox 73 has the option to change the browser default zoom level with a simple step.

By default, all browsers have a zoom level of 100% and if users want to zoom in or out, they have to do it manually. The new Firefox 73 has the option to change the default zoom level in the browser, for all webpages, or to adjust other zoom levels for each web page. This helps users do not need to perform additional editing operations that already have the zoom level you need. The following article will guide readers to change the default zoom level in Firefox.

Instructions to change the default zoom level in Firefox

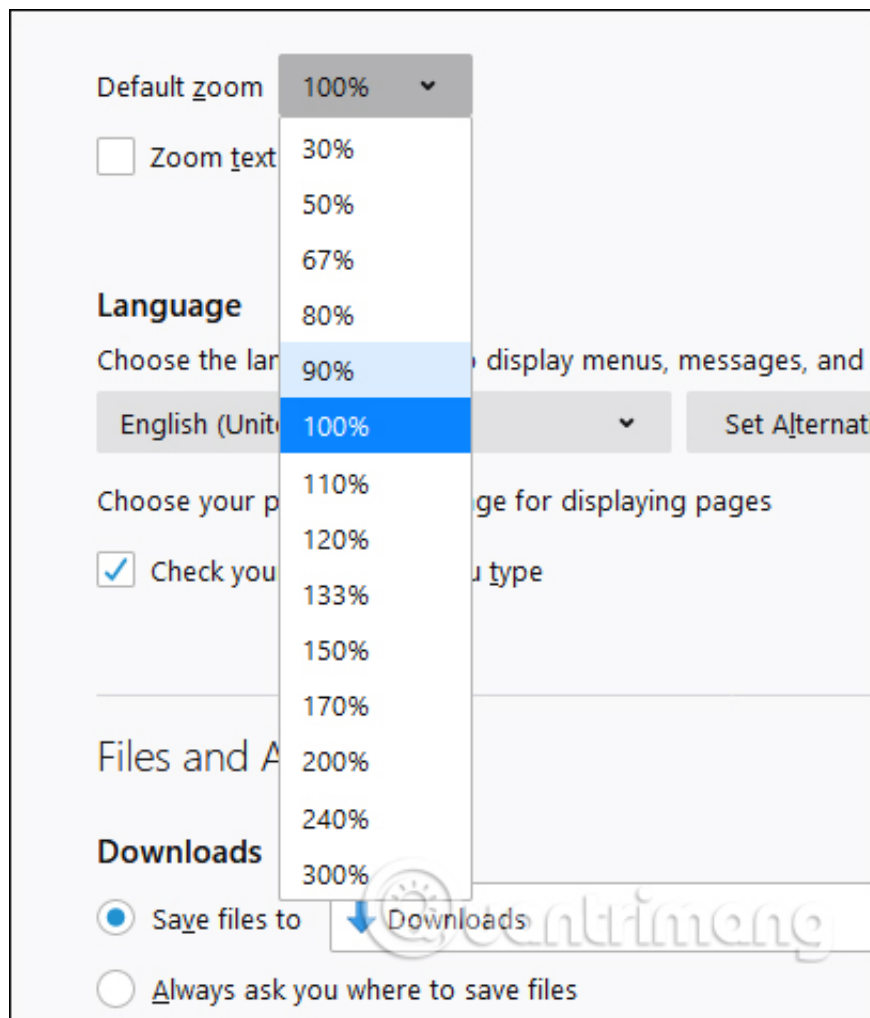
Step 1:

After upgrading Firefox to the latest version 73, click on **the 3 dashes icon** and select **Options** .

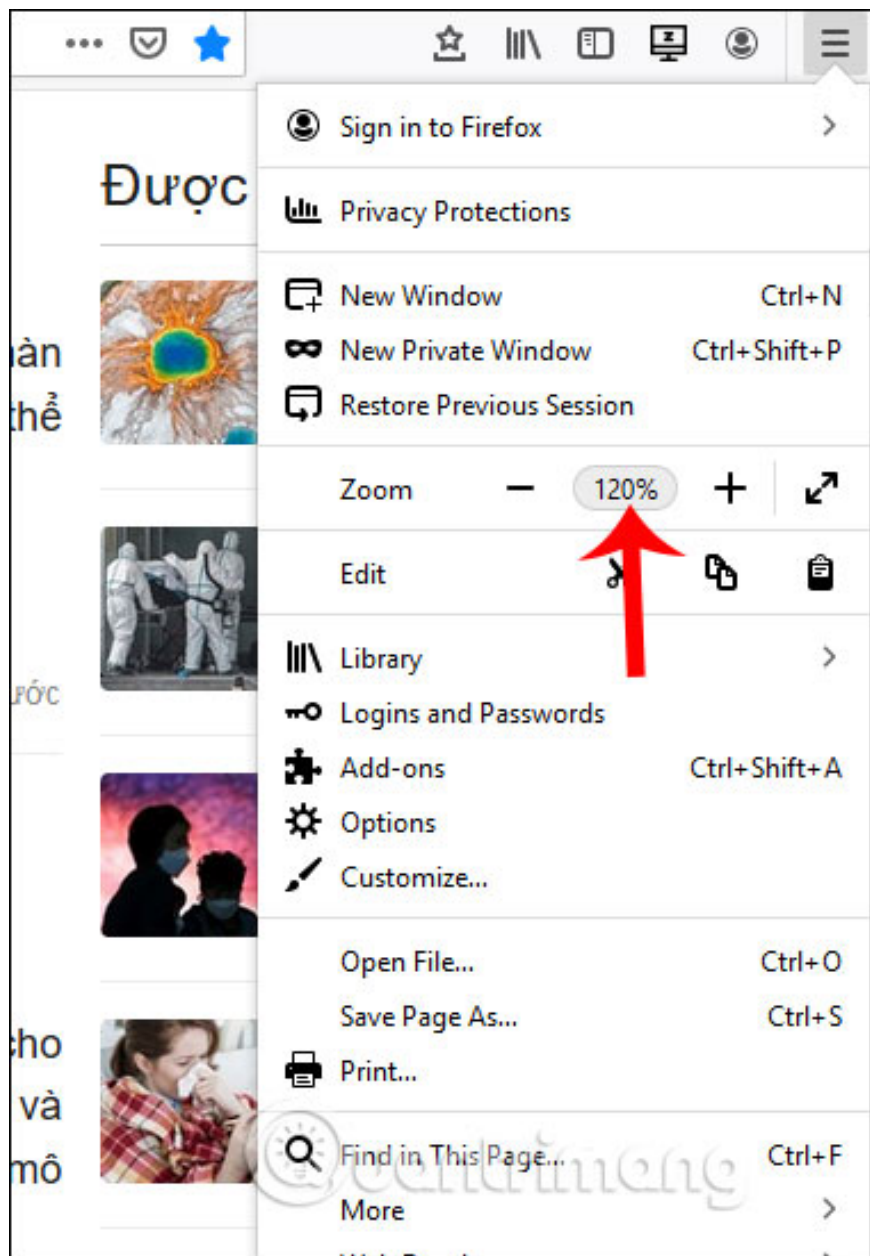


Step 2:

Switch to the General interface you find the **item Zoom** and at **Default Zoom** we proceed to **select the new default zoom level** for Firefox.

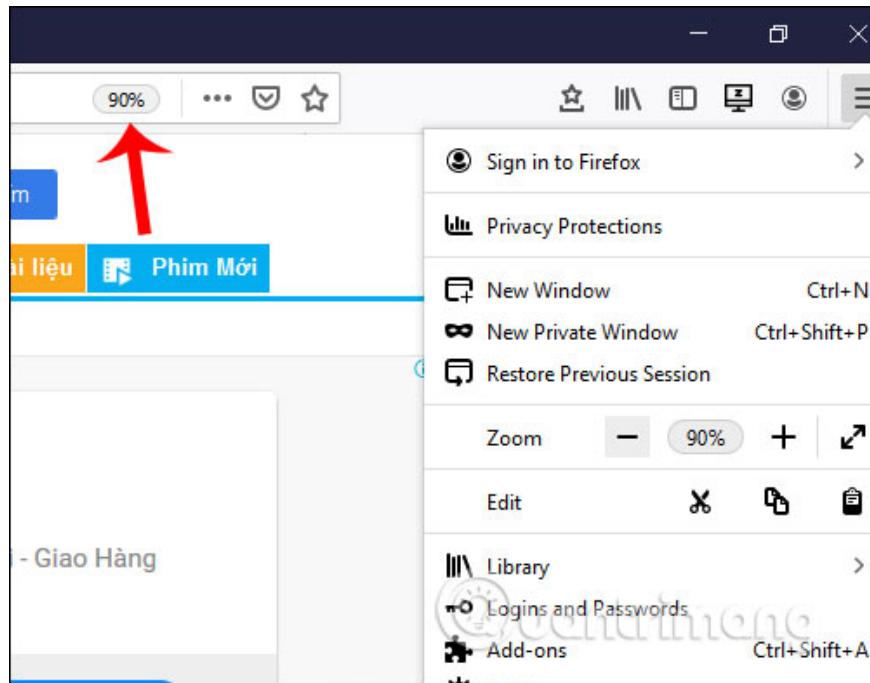


As a result, when users open any webpage in Firefox, they will see the default zoom level that you changed earlier.



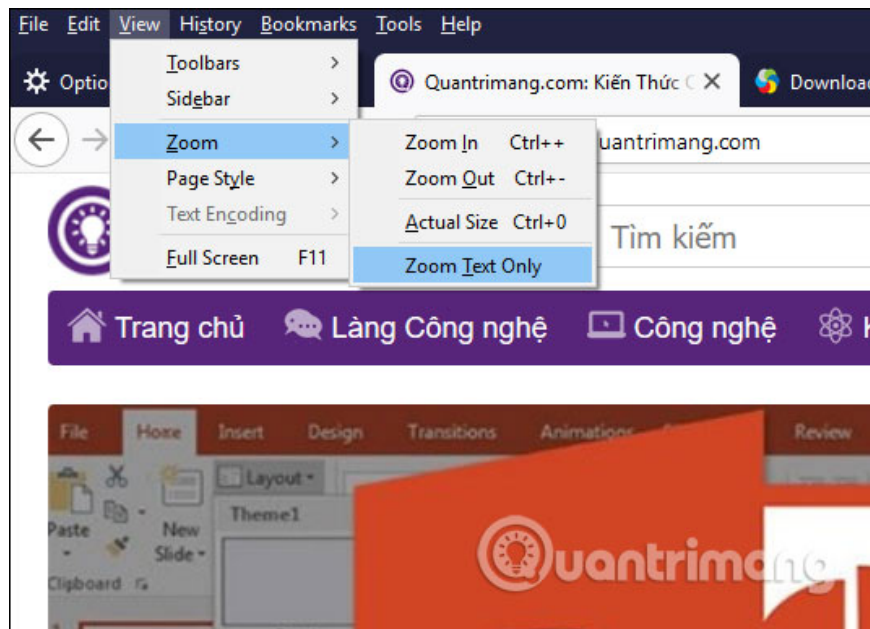
Step 3:

If you want to **set the default zoom level for a website**, we click on the icon 3 dashes and select to the zoom level you want. Firefox automatically remembers the zoom level for each web page without any further adjustment.



Step 4:

If you **just want to zoom in and out of text** , at the menu bar click **View> Zoom Text Only** and then select the zoom in and out as you like.
