

How to change the laser pointer color on PowerPoint

Using laser mouse effects in PowerPoint will help viewers focus on the content of the presentation.

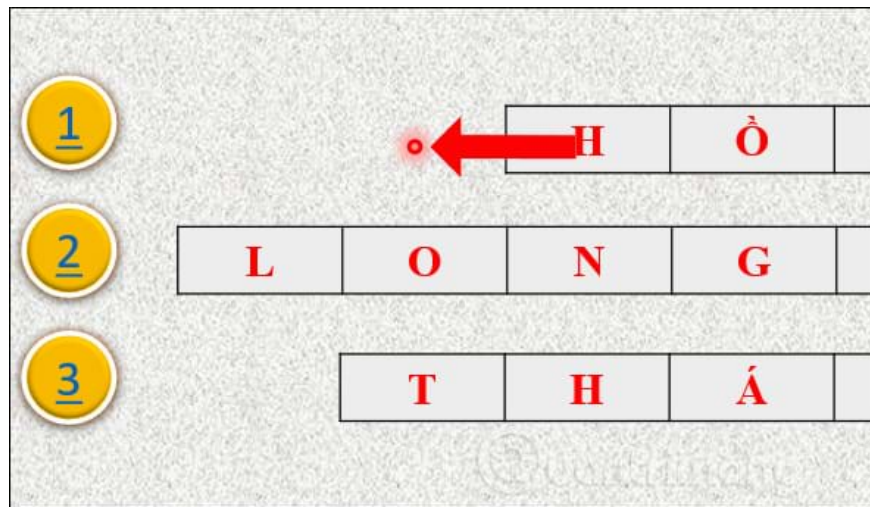
When the slide show is on PowerPoint, we can use the laser effect for the mouse, by pressing and holding the Ctrl key and clicking the mouse will show the laser effect, in addition to using the PowerPoint effects available for the slide show. mat. With the cursor laser effect, viewers will focus more on a specific part that you are presenting. And follow the default laser mouse pointer on PowerPoint to stay in red mode. If you want to change the color of the laser pointer on PowerPoint, it is very simple and easy. The following article will guide you how to turn on the laser mouse pointer and how to change PowerPoint laser mouse color.

Instructions for using PowerPoint laser pointer

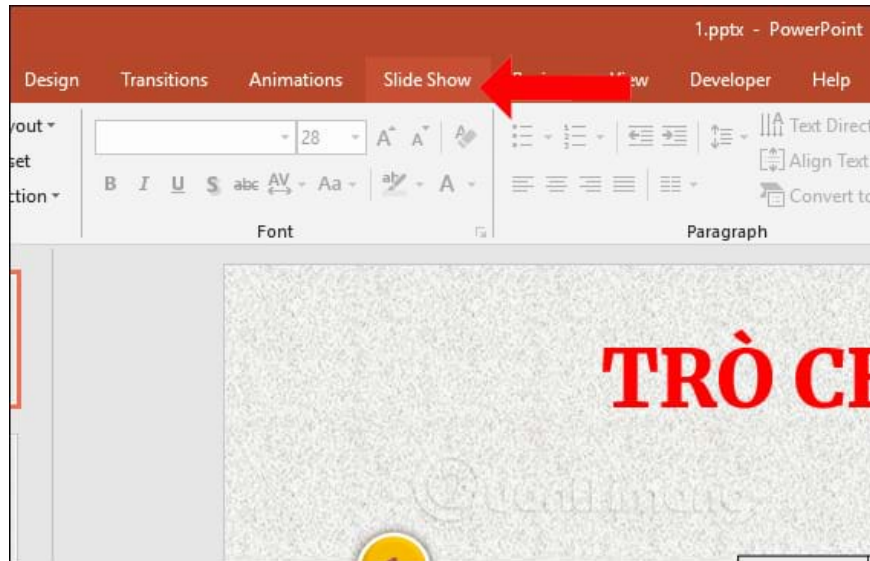
Starting with PowerPoint 2010, Microsoft added the option of laser pointer effects during presentations. To switch from a normal mouse pointer to a laser, press and hold the Ctrl key and click the left mouse button. The effect will disappear when we release the mouse.

When you hover this laser on a specific slide area, viewers will pay more attention.



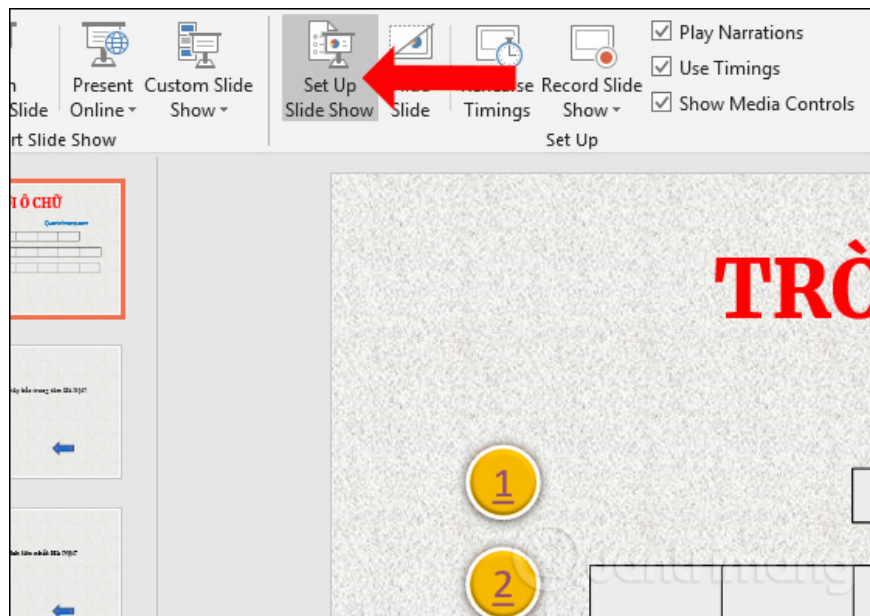
Step 1:

Click the **Slide Show** section on the ribbon bar in the PowerPoint interface.



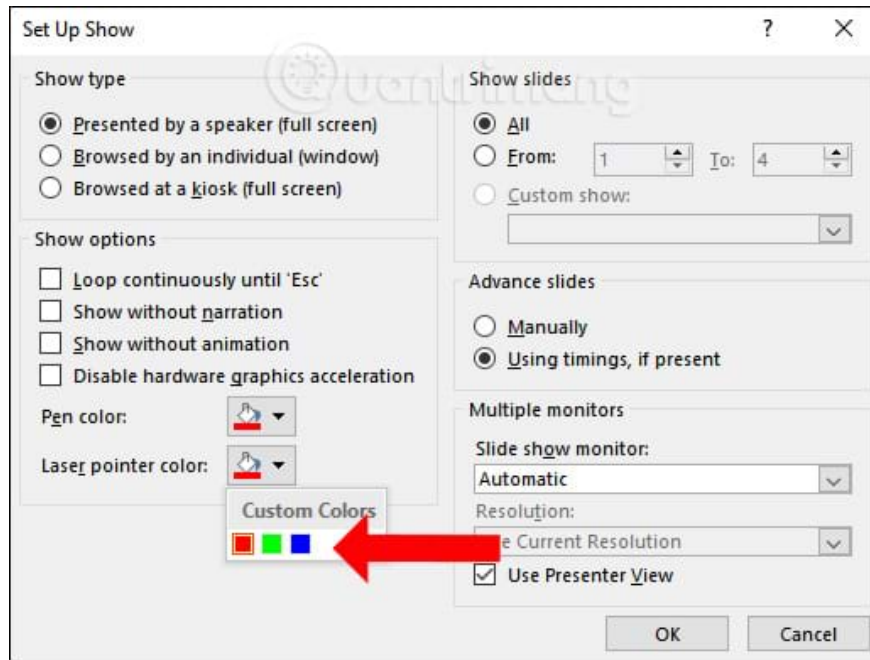
Step 2:

Show more tools below, users click on **Set Up Slide Show** .

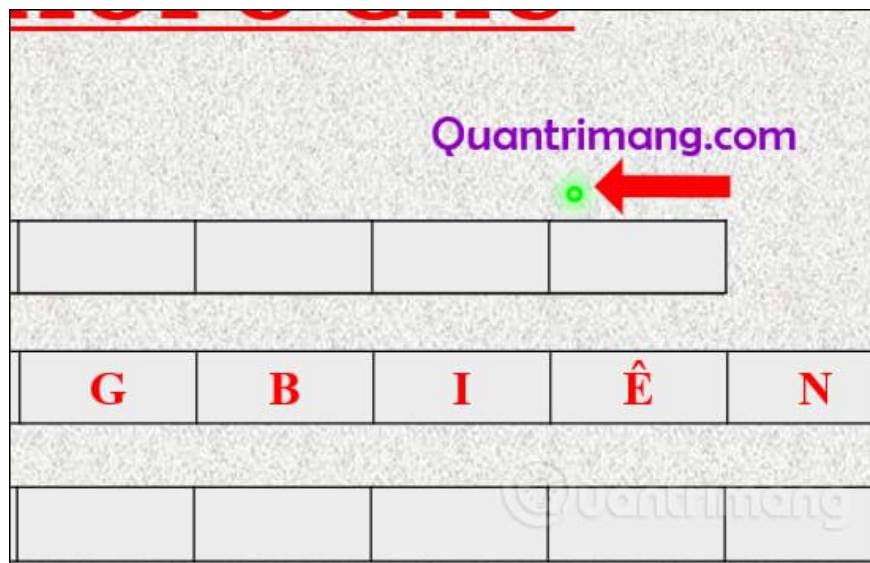


Step 3:

The Set Up Show dialog box appears. At the lower part, select **Laser pointer color** and click on the **color you want to change for the laser pointer** . There will only be 3 colors to use for laser pointer. Click **OK** to save the changes to the mouse.



The new color result of the laser pointer in PowerPoint when the slide show has been changed as shown below.



Another way to make your PowerPoint presentation stand out for important content. However, in order to prevent the viewer from seeing the laser pointer while you are playing, choose a background that is not too colorful, a lot of messy details when hovering over the content area to highlight.
