

How to change video quality in Camera app on iPhone 11 and 11 Pro

In October 2019, Apple released iOS 13.2, adding another camera app function to the iPhone 11, iPhone 11 Pro and iPhone 11 Pro Max: The ability to change video resolution and frame rate instantly.

For iPhone 11, iPhone 11 Pro and iPhone 11 Pro Max, Apple has redesigned the Camera app and added new ways to record videos.

Just like the usual Video mode selection method from the menu strip below the viewfinder, iPhone 11 users just need to press and hold the shutter button, then release it to stop recording.

In October 2019, Apple released iOS 13.2, adding another camera app function to the iPhone 11, iPhone 11 Pro and iPhone 11 Pro Max: The ability to change video resolution and frame rate instantly.

The next time you record a video using the Video mode found in the menu strip below the viewfinder, pay attention to the video resolution and frame rate separated by a dot in the top corner of the screen.



If the video quality is set to **1080p** in **Settings> Camera** , you can tap the resolution in the Camera interface to change between **HD (1080p)** and **4K quality** . If it is set to **720p** in **Settings** , tap the conversion format between **720p** and **4K** .

When shooting in 4K quality, you can press the frame rate to switch between **24** (for low light), **30** and **60** fps. If you're recording in **HD (1080p)** format, you can vary between **30** and **60** frames per second, and when recording in **720p** , the frame rate is limited to **30** frames per second.

Previously, users could only change these video settings by going to **Settings> Camera** , so the ability to adjust them from the Camera app is a useful thing, especially when you want to capture a moment. someday immediately.
