

How to change X (Twitter) settings to view hidden, sensitive content

Twitter is a famous social networking platform that allows users to access most content, images and videos. However, violent or nude tweets will be hidden, you will need to enable the Twitter setting to view hidden content if you want to access them.

1. What is hidden content on Twitter?

Hidden content on Twitter (now known as X) is content marked as sensitive by the platform, which may include images, videos, and other media that users may consider inappropriate. fit. These contents often include:

- Images and acts of violence
- Adult content
- Images of blood and nudity
- Objectionable images

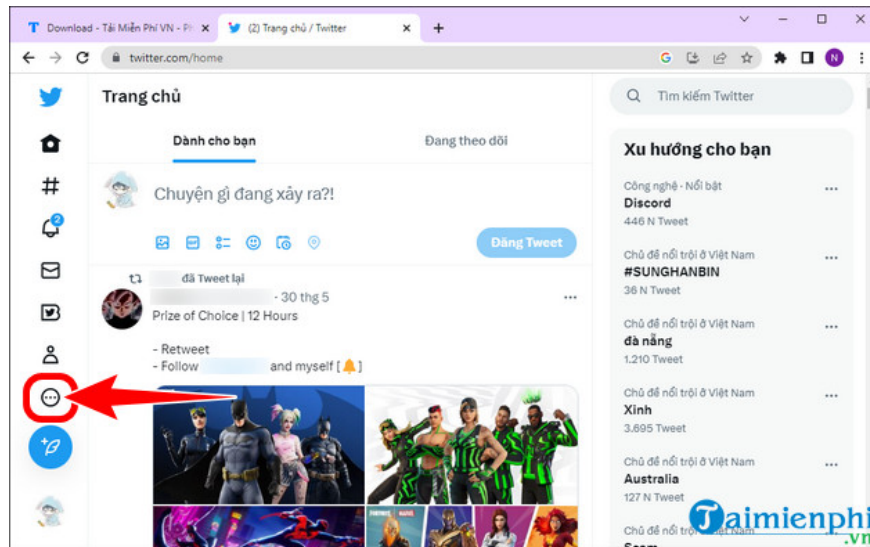
1. Quick guide

First, log in to Twitter Web, go to **More** => select **Settings and Support** => **Settings and privacy** => **Privacy and safety** => **Content you see** => uncheck **Show multimedia information in That contains sensitive content** .

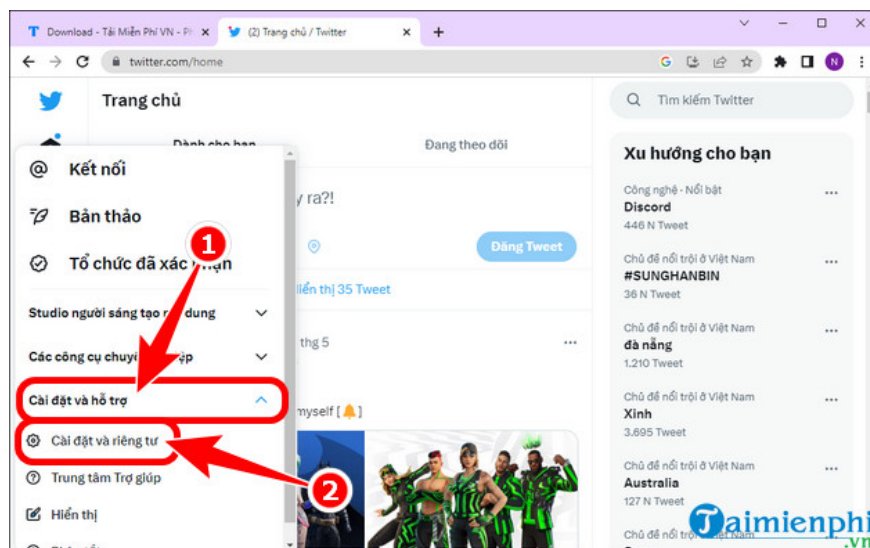
2. Detailed instructions

Step 1: Open Twitter Web and **log in to Twitter** on your computer web browser.

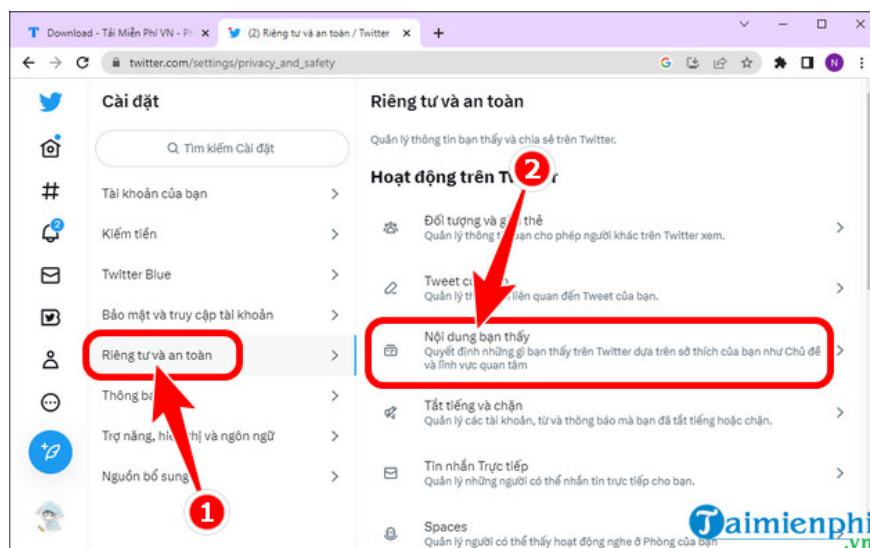
Step 2: At the main interface click on **the 3-dot icon** .



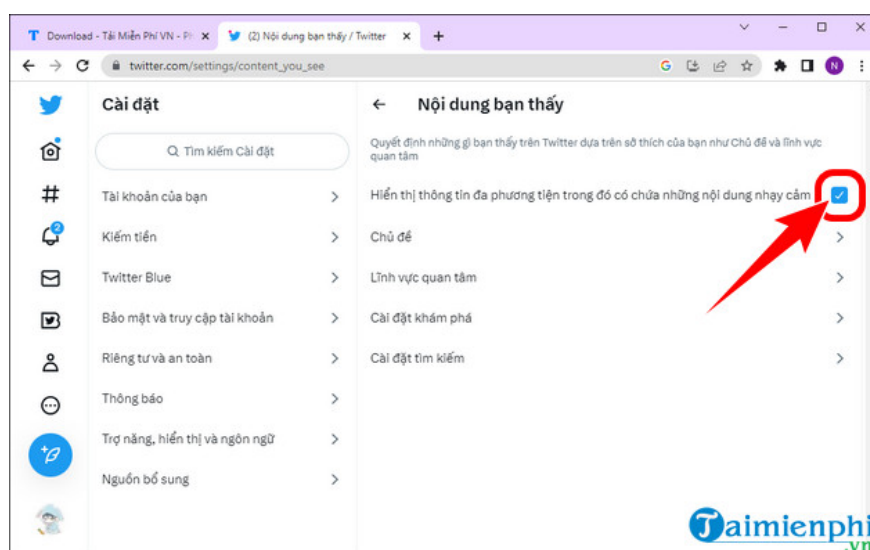
- Select **Settings and support** => press **Settings and privacy** .



Step 3: Click **Privacy and safety** => click **Content you see** .



- Uncheck **Show multimedia information that contains sensitive content** .

III. How to install Twitter to view hidden content on Android and iOS

This feature is currently only applied to Android, but is not available on iOS operating systems. You need to update or download Twitter to the latest version using the download link below:

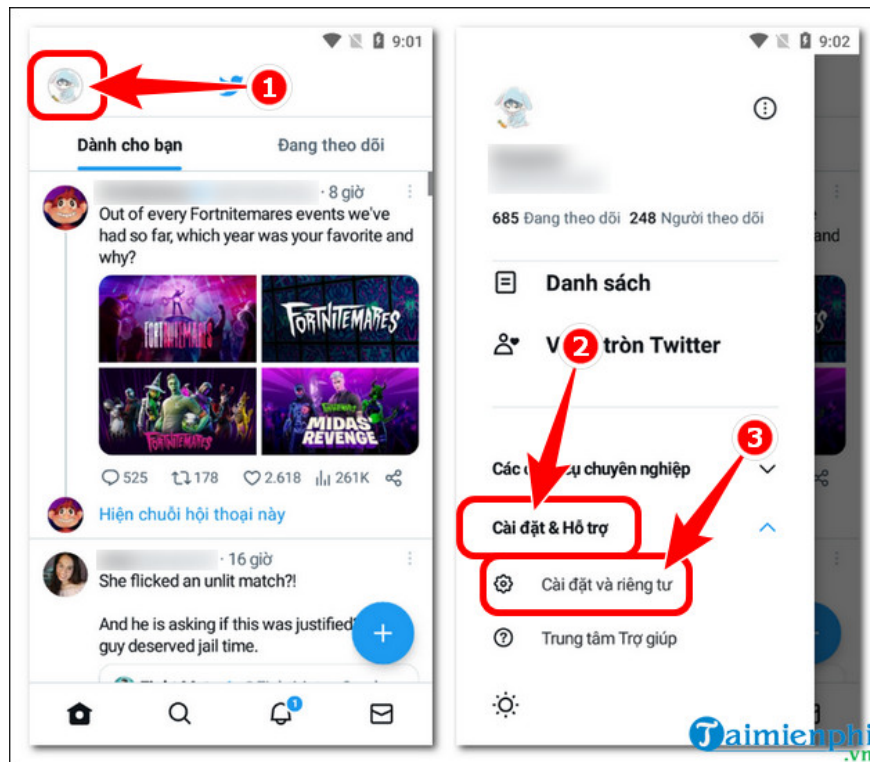

1. Quick guide

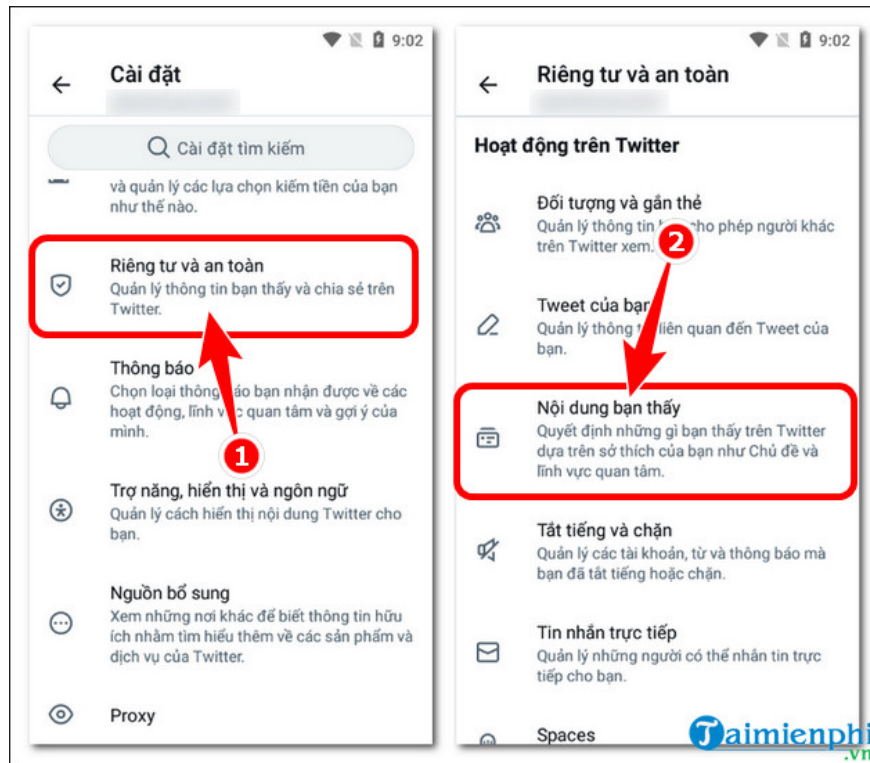
Open the Twitter app on your Android or iOS phone, go to User **Avatar** (avatar) select **Settings & support** => **Settings and privacy** => **Privacy and safety** => **Content you see** => turn off **Display multimedia information that contains sensitive content**

2. Detailed instructions

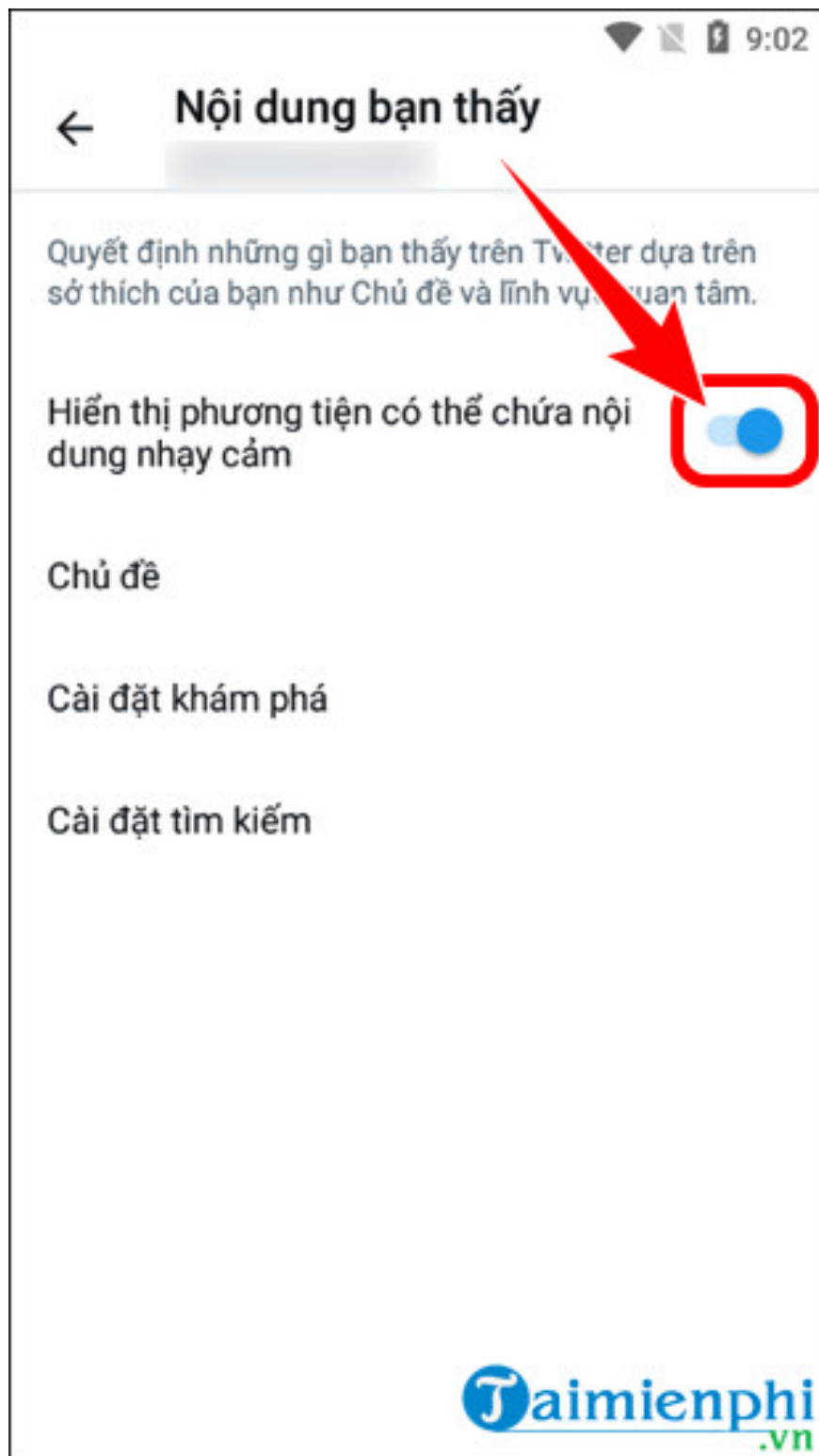
Step 1: Open the **Twitter** application , click **avatar** => click **Settings & support** => click **Settings and privacy**



Step 2: Select **Privacy and safety** => click **Content you see** .



Step 3: Turn off the **Show media that may contain sensitive content** button .
