

# How to check the warranty of SSD drives from all manufacturers.

Besides the traditional method of checking SSD warranty information on paper, users can now easily look up accurate warranty information with just a few simple steps using a computer or phone with an internet connection, without needing any purchase information or documents.

In fact, **checking SSD warranty** online has long been supported by manufacturers. However, not all users know how to do it. In this article, Taimienphi will guide you on how to check the warranty of SSDs from the most popular brands currently available.



How to check the warranty of your SSD drive

## **Preparation required:**

- Detailed information, product name, model number, and especially the **serial number** are printed on the product or its packaging. If you have lost the packaging, the purchase receipt, or the numbers are illegible, please refer to the guide **on how to find your hard drive serial number** on Windows here.
- Major manufacturers and technology companies will have their own Customer Service page, allowing users to access and check the warranty status of their purchased SSDs. Below is a list of **Customer Service pages** for some popular SSD brands currently available.

Depending on the manufacturer, the method for checking SSD warranty may vary slightly. However, the steps are generally similar to the instructions below.

**Step 1: Access the Customer Support page.**

First, access the product warranty check link for the brand of SSD you purchased from the list provided above by Taimienphi. In this example of checking SSD warranty, Taimienphi illustrates using an **Intel** product .

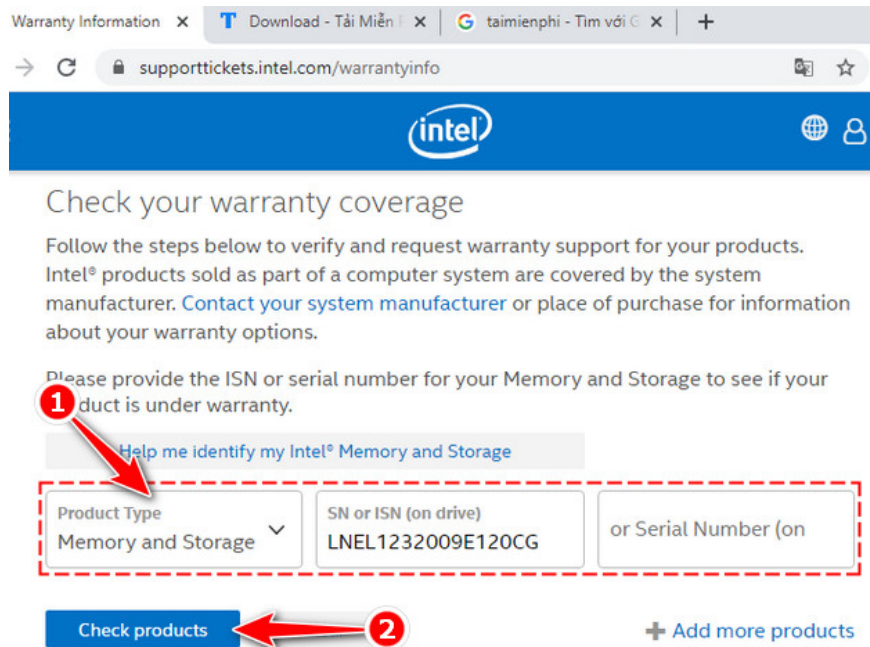
**Step 2: Enter product information.**

In the product warranty check screen, enter the information requested by the system. This is usually **the product type and serial number** .

In the image, the ISN code for the SSD used by Taimienphi is: **LNEL1232009E120CGN**

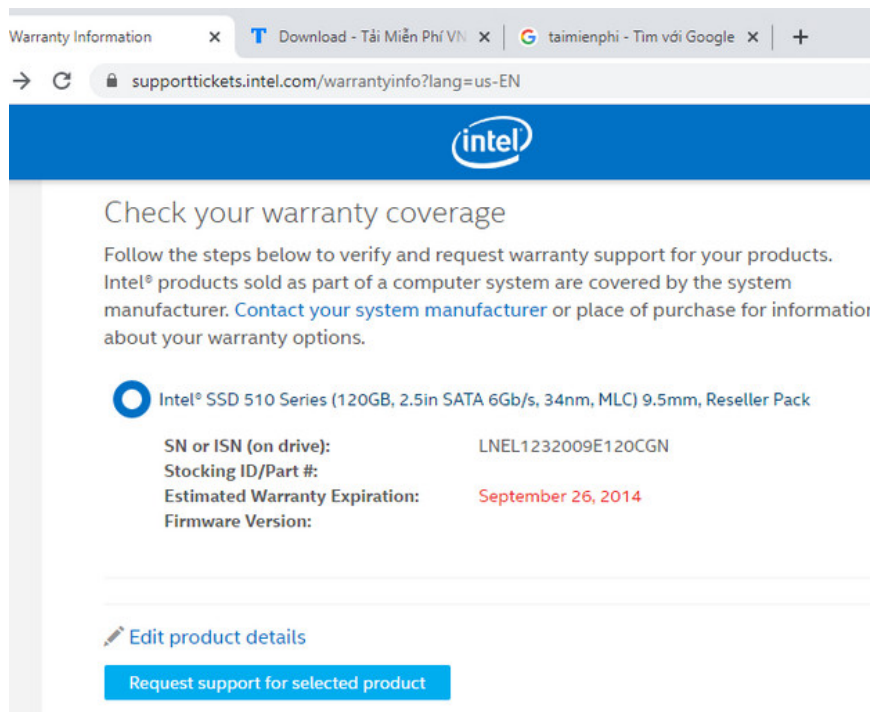


After entering the information, click **Check Product** .



### Step 3: Check the results.

If the information entered is correct, the system will automatically return information about the product and warranty period, as illustrated below.



With the SSD warranty check method that Taimienphi just introduced, users can be more proactive in detecting product problems and getting them repaired. Or, in the case of buying a used hard drive, you can easily find out whether the product you are using is new or used, and how much warranty time is left.
