## How to check your Android 8.0 phone to support Project Treble

### Step 1:

1. Download Termux software for Android

To know if your Android 8.0 device has a quick software update (Project Treble), first download and install the Termux software to your Android device by clicking on the link above. Then proceed to enter "*getprop ro.treble.enabled*".

### Step 2:

Use the Adb command line (make sure you have Adb installed) and enter:

```
adb shell  
getprop ro.treble.abled
```

If the result is **True** , congratulations, because this means that your Android 8.0 phone is definitely supported by Project Treble. On the contrary, if it produces **false** results, unfortunately your device will not support Project Treble.
