Look at the Games Currently Available

The collection of live dealer games on the internet is growing all the time, as we can see by looking at the options for online roulette at Paddy's , where many different games sit side by side. They cover versions with European, French, and American rules as all roulette wheels use one of these formats on them, but the differences run deeper than that.

For example, Age of the Gods Bonus Roulette has a progressive jackpot and a bonus round. On the other hand, Live Who Wants to Be a Millionaire Roulette takes its inspiration from the TV show and has a bonus round with a series of questions. Other roulette variants have multipliers added randomly to wins or introduce the concept of spread betting, which is detailed here by IG , to the game.

The differences between games aren't always clear just by looking at the name of the game. Many roulette games have very similar names and you won't know what unique aspects they offer until you join the table. Apart from the actual gameplay, some of them might excel thanks to their graphics and sound quality, the liveliness of the dealer, or some other area.

Check the Rules

The rules of roulette, as explained by Masters of Games , are very simple and the majority of live dealer games take a similar approach to them. For instance, you'll see the standard pay-outs rate on most games, starting at 1:1 for even money bets and going up to 35 to 1 if you correctly predict a single number. The base game of roulette varies very little between different online versions.

However, they tend to vary in other aspects, such as in the case of what happens if the ball lands on zero. As you'd expect, unless you've bet on this number you'll usually lose your money. Yet, some games have a helpful rule that sees you get back half your stake or get a second chance to win with your bet.

With the current explosion of live dealer games, expect to see the sense of diversity grow as more themes and ways of playing are introduced. This means that it will become even more important to check the rules and see what each game is all about. You might want to check the betting limits too, as some games let you start playing with a modest stake, while VIP titles or other exclusive games might have a higher starting point.

With so many live dealer roulette games to choose from, it's worth taking some time to look into the key differences between them. Having said that, if you just want to quickly play a basic game of roulette without delay then you can choose any game on a reputable casino without any fear.
