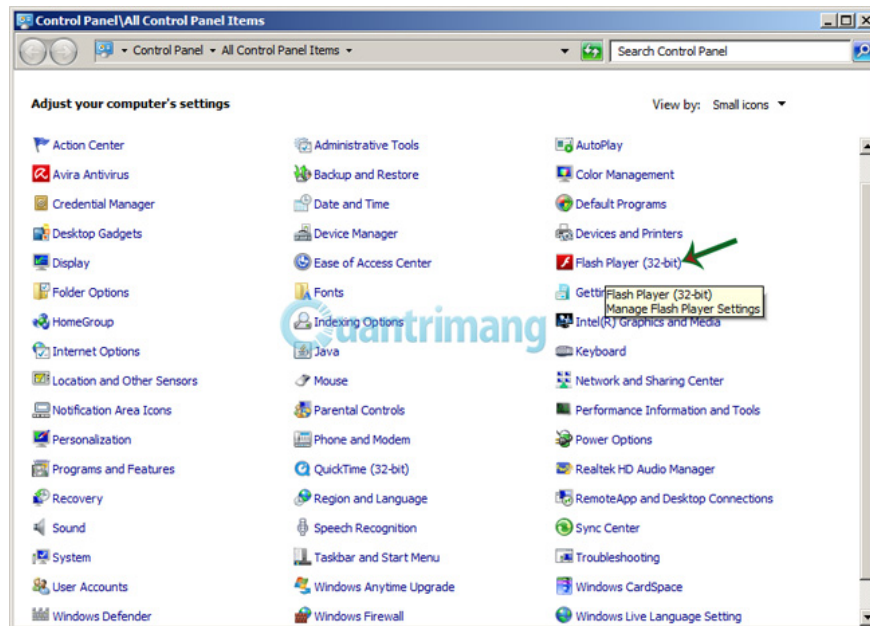
After a series of recent security issues, the future of Adobe Flash Player is very fragile as the user community is slowly turning away from this utility software after years of attachment. Coming from the popular producer **Macromedia** (founded in **1992**), the latter was acquired by **Adobe Systems** Corporation (in **2005**), Flash Player had a very "glorious" time when it was almost alone dominates the market for Flash games and videos. 5. Download Coc Coc browser for free

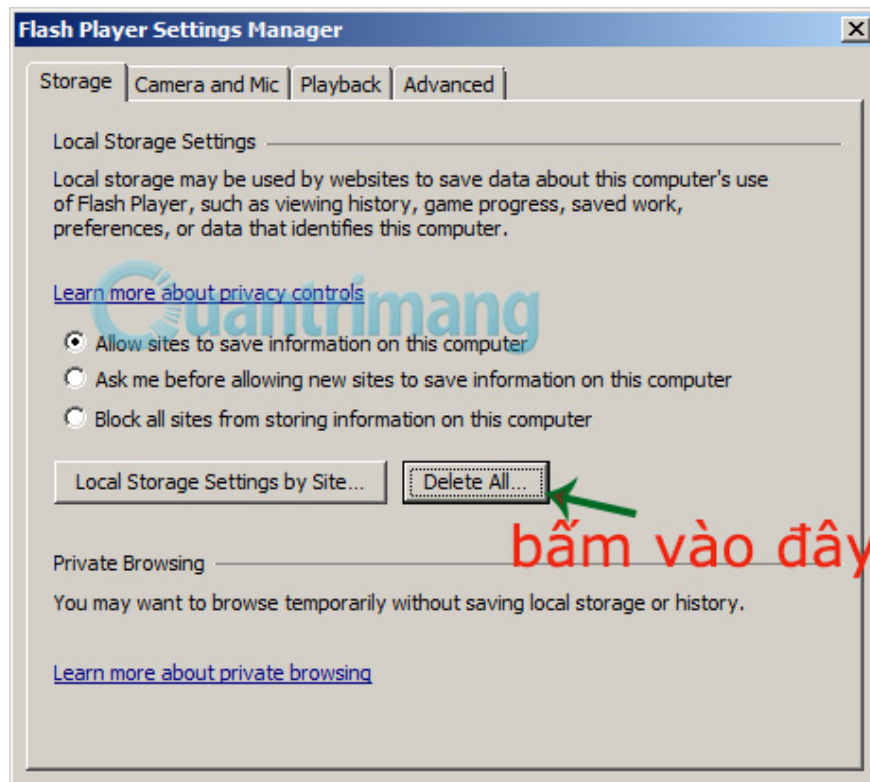
Steps to proceed:

1. Close all open browser windows.
2. Open **Control Panel**> **Flash Player** :

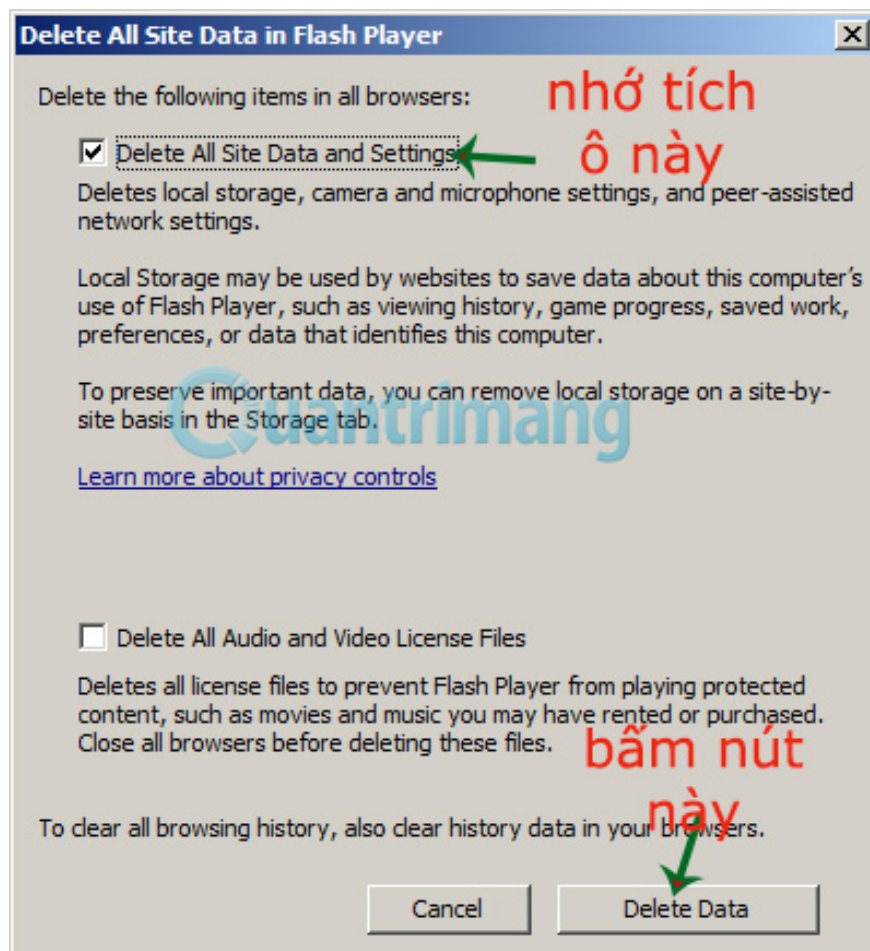


3. The **Flash Player** setup window displays:

We select the **Storage** tab > click the **Delete All** button:



The next window appears, remember to select the **Delete All Site Data and Settings** box as shown below, then click the **Delete Data** button:
